REVIEW OF FILES IN MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. ASSASSINATION (MURKIN) REVEALED ONLY DESTRUCTION WAS MADE ON 3/14/74 OF TWO BULKY EXHIBITS, (1) A "VIBRO-GRAVER", MODEL B-73, IN USE IN THE INMATE CANTEEN, MISSOURI STATE PRISON, AT THE TIME OF JAMES EARL RAY'S ESCAPE. THIS ENGRAVER WAS USED AT THE PRISON TO ENGRAVE RAY'S PRISON NUMBER ON THE TRANSISTER RADIO CASE HE BOUGHT THE DAY BEFORE HIS ESCAPE AND WAS FOUND IN MEMPHIS AT THE SITE OF THE ASSASSINATION OF KENNEDY.

On 6/15/77 SL 3495-C provided the following information to SA IVIAN C. SMITH:

He stated that he was in Missouri State Penitentiary in Jefferson City, Missouri, shortly after JAMES EARL RAY had escaped. In the time following the escape, source stated he became close to a BOBBY ASH, a Kansas City safe burglar, who was serving time for robbing a card game. ASH had been the cellmate of RAY prior to RAY's escape.

Source stated that ASH told him, after accounts of RAY's escape became public, that RAY had not actually gone out in a bread truck as reported.

He stated that RAY was working in the kitchen and when his shift quit at 4:30, RAY had hid in the lower part of the kitchen. At this same time, the guard in that area would be pulled off, leaving, according to source, a "blind spot" in the wall, and RAY who had a hook and rope simply went over the 12 foot wall from the area of the loading dock.

Source stated that ASH told him that a "Dummy" had been put in RAY's cell and ASH had carried on a conversation with the dummy.

He also advised that he thought there had likely been a delay in missing RAY as normally it would take two to three hours to come up with a head count that was valid as prisoners deliberately caused errors to "get at the man". Source advised that guards would not be alarmed if the count was not correct the first time or so.

Source stated that prison officials did not actually know how RAY escaped and had been told of the bread truck ruse by an uninformed or lying prisoner or had theorized the incident without proof.

Source further advised that ASH told him that "the Feds" had interviewed him regarding RAY but that ASH told him he told them nothing. Later when RAY was accused of the MARTIN LUTHER KING killing source stated ASH told him he did not think RAY had done it as RAY was not especially prejudiced and not a "fanatic".

Source stated he did not know RAY but did know RAY's brother, JACK RAY, who source described as being a "sharp thief".



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

Enclosed for the information of the Bureau, are two Xerox copies of a letter written by GENE R. BARNES which is self-explanatory. One Xerox copy of this letter is being furnished Alexandria, Knoxville, Memphis and St. Louis Offices for their information.

This letter was furnished to the FBI in Trenton, N.J., by Investigator DONALD V. POWELL, Burlington County Prosecutor's Office, Mt. Holly, N.J., who obtained the letter during an interview with BARNES at Stafford County, Virginia.

Copies of BARNES' letter are being furnished to Memphis and Knoxville who were office of origin in the MURKIN and JAMES EARL RAY case, respectively. Information copy also being furnished St. Louis, Missouri, inasmuch as BRADLEY referred to in BARNES' letter claimed he spent time in Missouri State Prison.

Newark files disclose that BARNES was subject of a Newark ITSP investigation in February, 1977, and subsequently arrested by Virginia State Police during a high-speed chase on 2/8/77, and incarcerated in the Stafford County Jail in Stafford, Virginia.

Newark indices failed to contain any identifiable information concerning JAMES BRADLEY mentioned in BARNES' letter.

from Bradley & myself in telling him how
to escape or thru by the window in the
kitchen back and saying he was in the bread
box.

Also the paper says claiming that Ray told
his cellmate he would sell him for \$100,000.
This is a lie. As far as any word going
around for things selling and a reward for it.

After cell mate told them that the F.B.I.
because they thought by doing as their own
sentence would be cut or they would get
a parole. This cell mate did not give
him he was going to escape because they
did not trust them nor did they know they were
killed & Ray wanted to do it, it was outside papers.
The story got out only because the F.B.I.
asked the F.B.I. wanted to talk to
Ray. Ray was with out a escape.

after King was killed, the F.B.I. came
to the prison to talk to me & to
Orndley.

I was in solitary at this time for
breaking into the prison cloth factory & stealing
a bunch of clothes.

The F.B.I. ask me if I knew where
Ray was hiding out at, if I

At this time I was under a 25 yr. sentence
& I told them I didn't know nothing about nothing,
cause I could have been tried for aiding in the
escape.

Orndley who was under sentence of 4 life terms,
& two yr sentences and a 4 yr. term, also told
them no.

I did in answer to their question tell them
that I did not believe Ray killed King.

I said he was set up to look like it
cause he was in escape & no one would believe
his story.

I know Ray well & he could not
kill a stray cat or dog much less take a
human life.

I told the F.B.I. 10 yrs. ago
that & also that I believe Ray did not
do the room, & did put the gun in it, his
prints were on the gun, but he couldn't
pull the trigger, some one else had to
cause knowing Ray, Ray wouldn't have the
nerve or heart to do so. He just did
what he was paid for & that was it.

sent the room + leave the gun in it.

The F.B.I did not release any of the facts they found out at the prison, just what would make Ray look bad.

Before I could not say anything because I was in Mr. doing time, & could be prosecuted for aiding. The same for Bradley.

Over now, Bradley is dead, he was killed by St. Louis, Police after he made a parole a few years ago. so he is the only one left that knows besides Ray that he did have help to get out of prison but it was from the prison itself, he got the help, not outside.

What happened out side after the escape I do not know.

FOR INFO OF KANSAS CITY, ON AUG. 18, 1978, GENE BARKSDALE, SHERIFF, SHELBY COUNTY, TENN., ADVISED THAT ON NIGHT OF AUG. 17, 1978, HE RECEIVED TWO TELEPHONE CALLS FROM BURGESS AUDIE WILSON. WILSON, WHO WAS FORMERLY IN THE TENNESSEE AIR NATIONAL GUARD UNIT AT MEMPHIS, TENN., WITH BARKSDALE, INFORMED THE SHERIFF HE KILLED DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING IN 1968 AT MEMPHIS AND HIS DAUGHTER DROVE A WHITE MUSTANG FROM KANSAS CITY, MO., TO MEMPHIS THREE DAYS PRIOR TO KING'S DEATH. HE WANTED TO MEET BARKSDALE AT THE HOLIDAY INN, GULFPORT, MISS., ON AUG. 18, 1978, AND SURRENDER. ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE FOR WILSON TO MAKE AN APPEARANCE AT THE HOLIDAY INN, GULFPORT, WHERE HE WAS CONTACTED BY SPECIAL AGENTS OF THE JACKSON OFFICE; .

WILSON WAS BORN AUG. 28, 1931, FULTON, MISS. HE RESIDED WITH HIS FAMILY AT GOLDEN, MISS., UNTIL 1936 WHEN THEY MOVED TO ELDRIDGE, ALA. HE RESIDED AT ELDRIDGE UNTIL MAY 2, 1947, WHEN HE ENTERED THE U. S. AIR FORCE. HE WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM THE AIR FORCE IN FEB., 1950. HE AND HIS WIFE BETTY LOU MOVED TO MEMPHIS IN 1950. HE LEFT MEMPHIS, YEAR NOT FURNISHED, AND MOVED TO GRANDVIEW, MO., WHERE HE BECAME A CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE IN THE AIR FORCE RESERVE AND OPERATED A JEWELRY STORE. HE STAYED IN THE AIR FORCE UNTIL 1970. HE OPERATED A JEWELRY STORE IN THE KANSAS CITY AREA FROM 1966 UNTIL 1970. WHEN INTERVIEWED BY BUAGENTS AUG. 19, 1978, WILSON FURNISHED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

IN THE COURSE OF HIS JEWELRY STORE BUSINESS, HE MET A WHITE MALE ITALIAN IN LATE 1960'S WHO OPERATED A JEWELRY TRADE SHOP ON WALNUT STREET IN KANSAS CITY. THIS MALE LATER INTRODUCED HIM TO ANOTHER ITALIAN BY THE NAME OF MITCH (LNU) WHO WAS APPROXIMATELY 5'10" TALL, 190 LBS., BLACK WAVY HAIR,

AND HAD SOME BUSINESS CONNECTION WITH A BONDING COMPANY. MITCH DELIVERED JEWELRY TO HIM FOR THE PURPOSE OF HAVING STONES REMOVED FROM THE FITTINGS. DUE TO THE VOLUME OF JEWELRY MITCH WAS BRINGING TO HIM, HE ASKED MITCH ABOUT IT AND MITCH TOLD HIM IT WAS STOLEN JEWELRY. MITCH INFORMED HIM THAT HE, WILSON, WAS AS DEEPLY INVOLVED IN THE HANDLING OF THE STOLEN JEWELRY AS HE, MITCH, WAS AND THIS RELATIONSHIP CONTINUED WITH MITCH UNTIL 1970. MITCH BROUGHT UP THE IDEA OF KILLING MARTIN LUTHER KING, INFORMING WILSON THERE WAS A \$50,000 CONTRACT FOR KING AND THAT HE COULD GET THE MONEY FOR WILSON IF HE KILLED KING. MITCH WAS WELL AWARE OF WILSON'S THOUGHTS REGARDING KING AND THE BLACK CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT. APPROXIMATELY FIVE OR SIX MONTHS BEFORE KING'S DEATH, WILSON COMMENCED GATHERING INFO RE HIS MOVEMENTS UTILIZING A RED AND WHITE BOWANZA AIRPLANE, REGISTRY NO. 34L, AND A CESSNA 310, TWIN ENGINE, BLUE AND WHITE AIRCRAFT.

MITCH FURNISHED WILSON A JAPANESE SNIPER RIFLE WHICH WILSON GAVE TO HIS OLDER SON, STEVEN WAYNE WILSON, IN 1975.

DURING THE TIME A GARBAGE STRIKE WAS IN PROGRESS IN MEMPHIS, TENN., MITCH CALLED WILSON AT HIS STORE IN GRANDVIEW, MO., AND INFORMED HIM KING WAS COMING TO MEMPHIS FOR A RALLY AND

INSTRUCTED WILSON TO GO TO MEMPHIS WHERE HE WAS TO MEET TWO MEN AT THE WONDER BAR AT THE CORNER OF SUMMER AVENUE AND WHITE STATION ROAD. WILSON FLEW TO MEMPHIS IN THE BONANZA AIRCRAFT AND LANDED AT AN AIRPORT JUST NORTH OF RALEIGH, TENN. HIS DAUGHTER, DEBRA, PICKED HIM UP AT THE AIRPORT IN HER 1965 WHITE MUSTANG WHICH WILSON HAD PREVIOUSLY BOUGHT FOR HER AND WHICH WAS REGISTERED IN HIS NAME IN MO. DEBRA WILSON AND HER MOTHER, BETTY LOU, WERE AT THE RESIDENCE OF WILSON'S FATHER-IN-LAW, 3095 RUSKIN ROAD, MEMPHIS, DUE TO A HEART ATTACK SUFFERED BY WILSON'S FATHER-IN-LAW.

WILSON WENT TO THE WONDER BAR WHERE HE WAS APPROACHED BY TWO WHITE MEN, ONE HAVING AN ACCENT SIMILAR TO PUERTO RICAN. THE TWO MEN FURNISHED HIM WITH FBI CREDENTIAL WHICH HAD A BLACK AND WHITE PHOTO OF WILSON ON IT AND TOOK HIM TO WHERE KING WAS TO HOLD A RALLY. THEY TOLD HIM HE WAS TO BE IN THE CROWD AT THE RALLY AND A DECOY SHOT WAS TO BE FIRED AND THEN HE WAS TO SHOOT. THEY TOLD HIM KING HAD A HABIT OF RAISING HIS ARMS OVER HIS HEAD WHEN HE WAS MAKING A SPEECH AND THE SECOND TIME HE DID SO THE SHOTS WERE TO BE FIRED.

MARTIN LUTHER KING IN 1968 AT MEMPHIS AND HIS DAUGHTER DROVE A WHITE MUSTANG FROM KANSAS CITY, MO., TO MEMPHIS THREE DAYS PRIOR TO KING'S DEATH. HE WANTED TO MEET BARKSDALE AT THE HOLIDAY INN, GULFPORT, MISS., ON AUG. 18, 1978, AND SURRENDER. ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE FOR WILSON TO MAKE AN APPEARANCE AT THE HOLIDAY INN, GULFPORT, WHERE HE WAS CONTACTED BY SPECIAL AGENTS OF THE JACKSON OFFICE; .

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WILSON WAS BORN AUG. 28, 1931, FULTON, MISS. HE RESIDED WITH HIS FAMILY AT GOLDEN, MISS., UNTIL 1936 WHEN THEY MOVED TO ELDRIDGE, ALA. HE RESIDED AT ELDRIDGE UNTIL MAY 2, 1947, WHEN HE ENTERED THE U. S. AIR FORCE. HE WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM THE AIR FORCE IN FEB., 1950. HE AND HIS WIFE BETTY LOU MOVED TO MEMPHIS IN 1950. APPROXIMATELY FIVE OR SIX MONTHS BEFORE KING'S DEATH, WILSON COMMENCED GATHERING INFO RE HIS MOVEMENTS UTILIZING A RED AND WHITE BONANZA AIRPLANE, REGISTRY NO. 34L, AND A CESSNA 310, TWIN ENGINE, BLUE AND WHITE AIRCRAFT.

MITCH FURNISHED WILSON A JAPANESE SNIPER RIFLE WHICH WILSON GAVE TO HIS OLDER SON, STEVEN WAYNE WILSON, IN 1975.

DURING THE TIME A GARBAGE STRIKE WAS IN PROGRESS IN MEMPHIS, TENN., MITCH CALLED WILSON AT HIS STORE IN GRANDVIEW, MO., AND INFORMED HIM KING WAS COMING TO MEMPHIS FOR A RALLY AND

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INSTRUCTED WILSON TO GO TO MEMPHIS WHERE HE WAS TO MEET TWO MEN AT THE WONDER BAR AT THE CORNER OF SUMMER AVENUE AND WHITE STATION ROAD. WILSON FLEW TO MEMPHIS IN THE BONANZA AIRCRAFT AND LANDED AT AN AIRPORT JUST NORTH OF RALEIGH, TENN. HIS DAUGHTER, DEBRA, PICKED HIM UP AT THE AIRPORT IN HER 1965 WHITE MUSTANG WHICH WILSON HAD PREVIOUSLY BOUGHT FOR HER AND WHICH WAS REGISTERED IN HIS NAME IN MO. DEBRA WILSON AND HER MOTHER, BETTY LOU, WERE AT THE RESIDENCE OF WILSON'S FATHER-IN-LAW, 3095 BUSKIN ROAD, MEMPHIS, DUE TO A HEART ATTACK SUFFERED BY WILSON'S FATHER-IN-LAW.

WILSON WENT TO THE WONDER BAR WHERE HE WAS APPROACHED BY TWO WHITE MEN, ONE HAVING AN ACCENT SIMILAR TO PUERTO RICAN. THE TWO MEN FURNISHED HIM WITH FBI CREDENTIAL WHICH HAD A BLACK AND WHITE PHOTO OF WILSON ON IT AND TOOK HIM TO WHERE KING WAS TO HOLD A RALLY. THEY TOLD HIM HE WAS TO BE IN THE CROWD AT THE RALLY AND A DECOY SHOT WAS TO BE FIRED AND THEN HE WAS TO SHOOT. THEY TOLD HIM KING HAD A HABIT OF RAISING HIS ARMS OVER HIS HEAD WHEN HE WAS MAKING A SPEECH AND THE SECOND TIME HE DID SO THE SHOTS WERE TO BE FIRED.

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ON THE DAY KING WAS KILLED, WILSON WAS IN THE CROWD STANDING NEAR A WOOD FENCE APPROXIMATELY SIXTY FEET FROM WHERE KING WAS STANDING. WHEN KING RAISED HIS ARMS THE SECOND TIME HE SHOT HIM.

WILSON HAD THE RIFLE STRAPPED TO HIS BELT UNDER A SUIT COAT AND ATTACHED TO HIS BELT ON A SWIVEL. THE BARREL PROTRUDED FROM BELOW HIS COAT BUT NO ONE QUESTIONED HIM CONCERNING IT. AFTER THE SHOOTING, HE WAS STOPPED BY THE MEMPHIS POLICE. UPON SHOWING THEM THE CREDENTIAL THEY LET HIM GO. HE WALKED ON DOWN THE STREET APPROXIMATELY TWO BLOCKS WHERE HE HAD LEFT THE MUSTANG AND PROCEEDED TO HIS FATHER-IN-LAW'S RESIDENCE. HIS DAUGHTER, DEBRA, THEN TOOK HIM TO THE AIRPORT AND HE FLEW BACK TO KANSAS CITY, LANDING AT AN AIRPORT ON THE KANSAS SIDE ON THE ROAD TO OLATHE, KANSAS. THIS AIRPORT WAS OPERATED BY (FNU) FISHER, FROM WHOM WILSON HAD PURCHASED THE BONANZA AIRCRAFT.

At 9:30 am, 8/21/78, the office was telephonically contacted by SA BURL F. JOHNSON, Memphis FBI Office and he related the following:

BURGESS AUDIE WILSON, also known as BILL WILSON, white male, date of birth [redacted] place of birth Mississippi, 5'11" tall, brown eyes, brown hair, FBI #879421E, surrendered to local authorities, Gulfport, Mississippi, 8/18/78. WILSON stated he killed MARTIN LUTHER KING, 4/19/68, in Memphis, Tennessee. WILSON wanted on local warrants New Brandfield, Texas, and presently en route New Brandfield.

WILSON allegedly owned two airplanes which he used to follow KING: (1) a Bonanza, he allegedly purchased on 1968 from (First Name Unknown) FISHER, who operates an airport on the Kansas side of the main highway between Kansas City and Olathe, Kansas.

WILSON alleged he was in Air Force Reserves, Richards Gebaur Air Force Base, 1968, as a Civilian Employee and resided at 13125 Herrick Avenue, Grandview, Missouri, with wife BETTY LOU, maiden name HOOTEN, daughter DEBRA ANN and two sons STEVEN and MARK ANTHONY. One of WILSON's relatives advised that WILSON was a Flight Engineer aboard a C124 rather than a Civilian Employee.

Information also developed WILSON owned or operated a jewelry store in 1968, located in Katz Drug Center, Grandview or Belton, Missouri. Jewelry store later moved when Katz sold out and now possibly known as Wilburs Jewelers, Belton, Missouri.

WILSON alleged he was paid \$50,000 to kill KING. SA JOHNSON advised the Director has given this matter priority and all leads to be handled immediately. JOHNSON advised Kansas City will receive teletype as soon as possible.

CARL D. FORTNA, ROUTE 6, BOX 387, OCEAN SPRINGS, MISSISSIPPI, STATED THAT HE MET BILL WILSON IN BELTON, MISSOURI, IN 1966 OR 1967. FORTNA WAS IN THE AIR FORCE AT THIS TIME STATIONED AT RICHARDS-GEBAUER AIR FORCE BASE IN BELTON, MISSOURI. FORTNA STATED THAT WILSON AND WILSON'S WIFE OWNED A JEWELRY STORE IN BELTON, MISSOURI, AND THAT WILSON WAS A MEMBER OF THE 442ND AIR FORCE RESERVE UNIT STATIONED AT RICHARDS-GEBAUER AIR FORCE BASE. FORTNA STATED HE KNEW WILSON THROUGH THEIR ASSOCIATION IN THE VFW IN BELTON, MISSOURI. FORTNA STATED THAT HE, FORTNA, RETIRED FROM THE AIR FORCE IN 1969.

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AND DID NOT SEE WILSON AGAIN EXCEPT FOR ONE BRIEF MOMENT IN 1972 UNTIL APPROXIMATELY TWO MONTHS AGO. WILSON CAME TO OCEAN SPRINGS, MISSISSIPPI, FROM LAFAYETTE, LOUISIANA, ABOUT TWO MONTHS AGO AND LIVED IN THE TWIN PINES MOTEL ON HIGHWAY 90, OCEAN SPRINGS, MISSISSIPPI. ON JULY 23, 1978, WILSON MOVED INTO A HOUSE OWNED BY FORTNA LOCATED NEXT DOOR TO FORTNA'S PRESENT RESIDENCE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 4:15 PM ON AUGUST 18, 1978, WILSON ASKED FORTNA TO COME INTO WILSON'S HOUSE, THAT HE HAD SOMETHING VERY IMPORTANT TO TELL HIM. WILSON TOLD FORTNA, "I KILLED THAT BLACK SON-OF-A-BITCH." FORTNA ASKED WILSON WHO HE WAS TALKING ABOUT, AND WILSON REPLIED MARTIN LUTHER KING. FORTNA STATED THAT HE TOLD WILSON HE DID NOT BELIEVE HIM, AND WILSON SAID, "I AM TELLING YOU THE TRUTH. I ACTUALLY KILLED HIM. I'VE BEEN LIVING WITH IT FOR TEN YEARS, AND I CAN'T TAKE IT ANYMORE." WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT MARTIN LUTHER KING WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR WILSON'S FATHER'S DEATH. WILSON DID NOT ELABORATE FURTHER ON THIS. WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT THIS KILLING WAS "ENGINEERED" BY LOU CRUZ (PHONETIC). FORTNA STATED THAT HE KNOWS LOU CRUZ AND THAT LOU CRUZ OWNED OR STILL OWNS LOU CRUZ JEWELRY, 1505 MAIN STREET, GRANDVIEW, MISSOURI. WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT HE DROVE TO THE STATE LINE AIRPORT IN KANSAS CITY,

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MISSOURI, DRIVING A NEW FORD THUNDERBIRD. WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT CRUZ ALSO OWNED AN IDENTICAL FORD THUNDERBIRD. WILSON LEFT HIS THUNDERBIRD AT THE AIRPORT AND FLEW TO MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE. CRUZ CAME TO THE AIRPORT AND PICKED UP WILSON'S THUNDERBIRD AND TOOK IT FROM THE AIRPORT SO IT WOULD NOT BE NOTICED. WHEN WILSON ARRIVED IN MEMPHIS, HE BORROWED A WHITE FORD MUSTANG THAT HE HAD PURCHASED FOR HIS DAUGHTER, DEBORAH. DEBORAH HAD DRIVEN FROM KANSAS CITY TO MEMPHIS IN THE MUSTANG. WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT HE WENT TO THE MOTEL WHERE MARTIN LUTHER KING WAS STAYING AND THAT HE USED A JAPANESE SNIPER RIFLE AND SHOT KING HOLDING THE RIFLE ON HIS HIP. HE STATED THAT THIS RIFLE IS NOW IN THE POSSESSION OF WILSON'S SON, STEVE. WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT HE WAS DRIVING AWAY FROM THE SCENE IN THE MUSTANG, AND HE WAS STOPPED BY THE MEMPHIS POLICE, BUT HE TALKED HIMSELF OUT OF A TICKET, AND THE CAR WAS NOT SEARCHED. HE STATED THAT THE RIFLE WAS IN THE TRUNK OF THE CAR AT THIS TIME. WILSON TOLD FORTNA THAT HE THEN FLEW HIS AIRPLANE BACK TO KANSAS CITY, AND CRUZ PICKED HIM UP AT THE AIRPORT AND TOOK HIM HOME.

FORTNA STATED THAT WHEN WILSON TOLD HIM THE ABOVE INFORMATION, HE, FORTNA, BELIEVED THAT WILSON THOUGHT HE WAS TELLING THE TRUTH AND THAT HE SWORE ON HIS MOTHER'S GRAVE IN FRONT OF A PRIEST THAT IT

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WAS THE TRUTH. FORTNA STATED THAT WILSON HAD NEVER MENTIONED THIS SUBJECT PRIOR TO THIS INSTANCE. FORTNA STATED THAT WILSON HAS BEEN DRINKING HEAVILY FOR THE PAST TWO MONTHS AND HAS LIED TO HIM SEVERAL TIMES IN THE PAST TWO MONTHS. WILSON, ON OCCASION, WOULD TELL FORTNA THAT HE HAD BEEN MARRIED THREE OR FOUR TIMES SINCE DIVORCING HIS FIRST WIFE AND THEN COME BACK AT A LATER DATE AND SAY THAT HE HAD NOT BEEN MARRIED AFTER DIVORCING HIS FIRST WIFE.

FORTNA STATED THAT WILSON IS AN EXCELLENT PILOT, THAT HE, FORTNA, HAS FLOWN WITH WILSON THROUGH BAD WEATHER, AND WILSON HAD NO PROBLEMS FLYING THE AIRCRAFT.
