Information has been received that GALT reportedly signed up for a one year dancing course in New Orleans in 1964, took dancing lessons for several weeks in Birmingham beginning in September, 1967, and took a \$499 dancing course from December, 1967 to February, 1968 at Long Beach, Calif.

ERIC STARVO GALT is described as 5'11"; 175 pounds; blue eyes; brown hair; born , place not given.

One dance instructor has stated that GALT is "crazy" about dancing but a poor dancer and difficult to teach because he does not remember instructions. He was described as an introvert who volunteers no information and replies with yes or no answers when asked; did not mingle with other students and made no efforts to make friends or converse with anyone.

Another dance instructor stated GALT is a good dancer, displayed slight southern accent, rural characteristics of language and diction, teeth straight and clean, fingernails clean and neatly trimmed; wore gold ring with dark stone; always neatly dressed with suit and shiny slip-on type black alligator shoes with thin soles, black hose and wore tie tack and cuff links. He smoked filter cigarettes and had nervous habit of occasionally pulling at ear lobe. Owner of studio states GALT spoke of Alabama, said he was a merchant seaman; spoke of being in Mexico but did not speak Spanish and spoke English badly; was socially inept, an introvert and a poor dancer because he would not loosen up. He smiled rarely and when he did it was a nervous crooked smile. He paid cash for lessons taking a wad of bills from his pocket.

He said that HARRISON and DILLON had pistol, type unknown, in apt. and that when he returned to the apt. Friday evening, March 29 last, TONY HARRISON had left. He may have gone to Philadelphia, Pa. as he and DILLON both had claimed to be from Philadelphia. THURMAN believes that they may both be from Tenn. from things that they had told him. HARRISON had previously run DILLON off from the apt. as he was always drunk. believed to have been born in Memphis.

THURMAN states HARRISON described as kinky dark brown hair, 5'10", dark complexion. Stated that he fitted desc. of KING's killer. He could give no other reasons for suspecting HARRISON of KING's murder other than his description and his statements re KING.

HOOVER, GALT'S TRAVELS IN THE MUSTANG INCLUDED TRIPS TO LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA; NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA; BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA; AND MEXICO, AS WELL AS TO MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, AND ATLANTA, GEORGIA. GALT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN IN MEMPHIS ON APRIL 3 AND 4, 1968, AND TO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THERE FOR ATLANTA. INTENSIVE INESTIGATION BY THE FBI HAS DISCLOSED THAT GALT HAS CLAIMED TO HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED AS A COOK ON MISSISSIPPI RIVER VESSELS AND AS A MERCHANT SEAMAN. HE IS SAID TO BE AN AVID DANCER AND TOOK DANCING LESSONS IN NEW ORLEANS IN 1964 AND 1965; IN BIRMINGHAM DURING SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1967; AND IN LONG BEACH CALIFURNIA, FROM DECEMBER, 1967 TO FEBRUARY, 1968. GALT LEFT LOS ANGELES UN DECEMBER 15, 1967, AND DROVE HIS WHITE MUSTANG TO NEW ORLEANS, WHERE HE CLAIMED HE CONTACTED EITHER AN ENGINEERING OR A CONTRACTING FIRM. HE LEFT NEW ORLEANS ON DECEMBER 19TH AND ARRIVED BACK IN LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 21, 1967. WHILE IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA EARLY THIS YEAR, GALT TOOK A COURSE AT A SCHOOL OF BARTENDING AND WAS GRADUATED ON MARCH 2, 1968. THE FUGITIVE IS DESCRIBED AS WHITE MALE. HE IS APPROXI-MATELY 5 FEET 8 INCHES TO 5 FEET 11 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS. BETWEEN 160 AND 175 POUNDS. HE'S SAID TO BE A NEAT DRESSER AND HAS A MEDIUM BUILD. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176
