Mr. Bill Hensley, 81 Outer Dr., Oak Ridge, Tenn., phone 483-8767, an ex AEC Policeman, advised at 12:40 AM today the following information.

Last Friday April 12th. at about 4:00 PM Mr. Hensley and his wife were stopped at the "THREE BEARS TRADING POST" near Ducktown, Tenn. where they observed an individual driving a late model mustang, white, black top, bearing Hamilton Co., Tenn. license C01130.

This individual came into the area from Ocoee Road and parked at the far end of the trading post parking area. He went to a phone booth and made a 3 or 4 minute phone call and then left in the direction from which he had come.

Hensley stated this man appeared nervous and kept facing the public whild making the phone call.

Hensley described the man as 5'8", 160 to 170 lbs., medium build, neatly dressed with tie but no coat, hair sandy to redish. He further stated that the man appeared to meet all of the physical requirements of the King murderer as published in the press. He said that this man was wearing sun glasses although it was foggy and raining at the time.

Hensley advised that he was an AEC patrolman at Oak Ridge for seventeen years until he was fired for drinking on the job.







ATTORNEY GENERAL RAMSEY CLARK ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FBI HAS IDENTIFIED JAMES EARL RAY, AN ESCAPEE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY, AS ERIC STARVO GALT, AGAINST WHOM A FEDERAL COMPLAINT WAS FILED LAST WEDNESDAY IN CONNECTION WITH THE FATAL SHOOTING OF THE REVEREND DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER SAID THAT A SYSTEMATIC AND EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH OF LATENT FINGERPRINTS UNCOVERED IN THE DR. KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI'S IDENTIFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.

IN SEPTEMBER, 1966, WHILE SERVING THIS SENTENCE, HE WAS CONFINED FOR A TIME IN THE MAXIMUM SECURITY WARD AT THE STATE HOSPITAL AT FULTON, MISSOURI.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, RAY HAS A KNOWN ARREST RECORD DATING BACK TO 1949. PRIOR TO THE 1960 CONVICTION FOR WHICH HE RECEIVED THE 20-YEAR TERM, RAY HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF BURGLARY IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, IN 1949; ARMED ROBBERY IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, IN 1952; AND FORGING UNITED STATES POSTAL MONEY ORDERS IN MISSOURI IN 1955.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN 1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54; AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.

RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY, 1946, TO DECEMBER, 1946, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ARREST.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT DURING HIS CRIMINAL CAREER, RAY HAS ALSO USED THE NAMES OF ~~JAMES MORRIS~~, ~~JAMES WALTON~~, ~~W. C. HERRON~~ AND ~~JAMES O'CONNOR~~. HE IS A WHITE MALE; CLAIMS TO HAVE

IN CONNECTION WITH HIS ESCAPE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY, AN FBI COMPLAINT WAS FILED IN JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, ON JULY 26, 1967, CHARGING RAY WITH UNLAWFULLY FLEEING FROM THE STATE OF MISSOURI TO AVOID CONFINEMENT. HE HAS BEEN A FEDERAL FUGITIVE SINCE THEN.

RAY SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS. ANYONE HAVING INFORMATION CONCERNING HIM SHOULD IMMEDIATELY CONTACT FBI HEADQUARTERS IN WASHINGTON, D. C., OR THE NEAREST FBI OFFICE.

On 4/18/68 Mr. GLEN E. ELLISON, 106 Townsend Road Oak Ridge, Tennessee, a postal mail carrier at Oak Ridge Tennessee, advised that JAMES C. BULL and his wife, MAROT BULL moved into a house at 240 West Tennessee Avenue, Oak Ridge, a little over two months ago, and moved away on April 7, 1968, and did not leave a forwarding address. He stated that he has never seen Mrs. BULL, but due to the fact that she had passed several bad checks in the vicinity of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, he has delivered several registered letters to this address and JAMES C. BULL has signed for the letters.

He stated that he would describe BULL as follows:

Sex:	Male
Age:	About 24 to 25
Height:	6'
Hair:	Brownish blond, combed straight back, slightly receding on each side
Complexion:	Dark skinned (looks like a tan)

He stated that sometime around the early part of April, when he brought a registered letter to the house JAMES BULL told him that his wife was in Memphis.

On another occasion when he visited the house with a registered letter, BULL had a friend with him, whom he would describe as follows:

Race:	White
Sex:	Male
Height:	5'7"
Hair:	Light brown hair with a red tint receding on both sides
Complexion:	Florid

He stated that he had no information concerning the friend he observed with JAMES BULL.

Mr. ELLISON stated that he had been thinking about this for several days and felt he should furnish this information to the FBI on the possibility that JAMES C. BULL might be ERIC GALT.

The photograph of the sketches of GALT prepared at Birmingham and Memphis were shown to him and he stated that the photograph prepared by the Bureau artist at Memphis resembled BULL, but BULL's hair appeared to be considerably lighter than that in the sketch. Photograph of GALT appearing in the "News Sentinel" was shown Mr. ELLISON and he stated it resembled BULL to some extent.

On 4/18/68 Mrs. JACKIE REA, Credit Bureau, Inc., Oak Ridge, Tennessee, advised they had a record in her file on JAMES CONLEY BULL, 240 West Tennessee Avenue, Oak Ridge, who was reportedly employed by Fidelity Printers, Knoxville. She stated that she had had a report from Knoxville Retail Credit Association dated October, 1966 which indicated that BULL was employed by Fidelity Printers, 409 Wall Avenue, S.W. Knoxville, Tennessee, and was behind on several accounts.

KX 44-696

On April 18, 1968, Identification Officer JACK PEARSON, Oak Ridge Police Department, advised he had no record of JAMES C. BULL, but did have a record for MARET BULL, for whom they were holding two warrants for bad checks. Mr. PEARSON advised that investigation had disclosed that the BULL family had moved away on April 7, 1968, reportedly going to Georgia, address unknown.

On April 18, 1968, Mr. HOWARD L. HAY, 102 East Newkirk Lane, Oak Ridge, Tennessee, owner of the building at 240 West Tennessee Avenue, advised that JAMES C. BULL and his wife had lived at 240 West Tennessee Avenue approximately two months during which time they paid their rent the first month and moved away on April 7, 1968, without paying their rent. He stated that he had some of their personal belongings which they had left in the apartment, and since he has re-rented the apartment, he is holding their property. He stated that he understands that there are approximately 20 bad checks in town passed by the BULLs. He was questioned concerning a friend with them and stated that his name was RALPH CARROLL and drove a white Thunderbird and reportedly worked for a printing company selling cards of some type, name of company unknown.

Mr. HAY was shown the newspaper photograph of ERIC GALT and he stated that this positively was not identical with JAMES BULL.

Shortly after this interview, Mr. HAY called the Oak Ridge Resident Agency and advised that he and his wife had been looking at the photograph of GALT in the Knoxville Journal and had decided that this photograph resembled RALPH CARROLL. He stated that he is positive that JAMES BULL was in the vicinity of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, during the period of the KING murder, but stated that at that time RALPH CARROLL was away on a trip with Mrs. BULL, exact whereabouts unknown.

Efforts will be made at Oak Ridge, Tennessee, to have residents in the vicinity of 240 West Tennessee Avenue look at the photograph of ERIC GALT and further attempts will be made to identify BULL and CARROLL.

It is requested that a lead be assigned to a Knoxville Agent to contact the Fidelity Printers, 409 Wall Avenue, Knoxville, in an effort to identify JAMES C. BULL and RALPH CARROLL and make check of any other pertinent sources available in an effort to positively eliminate these individuals as being identical with GALT.

Hunt Started A Week Ago

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — The mysterious Eric Starvo Galt has been charged with conspiracy and murder in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The FBI said in a fugitive warrant issued Wednesday night in Birmingham, Ala., that Galt, 36, conspired with a man "whom he alleged to be his brother" to violate King's civil rights.

The state charge of first-degree murder was filed against Galt in Memphis where King, 39, Nobel Prize winning civil rights leader, was shot to death on a motel balcony April 4 by a sniper who fled from a nearby rooming house.

First-degree murder in Tennessee carries the death penalty although the electric chair has not been used in the state since 1960.

The maximum penalty under the federal charge of conspiracy to violate a person's civil rights is a \$5,000 fine and 10-year prison sentence.

There was no further mention in the FBI statement about the alleged brother and no charge was filed against him.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover announced in Washington that the conspiracy to "injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate" King began "on or about March 30" in Birmingham.

The FBI statement said a 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight found near the rooming house shortly after King was slain, was purchased March 30 in Birmingham.

The statement did not connect Galt directly with the rifle.

The FBI released a photograph of Galt and solicited public aid in finding him. Whether this appeal meant the trail had become cold was unclear, but U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark told a reporter in Washington that he felt this was not the situation.

The FBI started hunting Galt a week ago. Agents even contacted persons named Galt in several states in an attempt to find him.

The picture—which had to have the eyes “opened” by an artist—brought uncertain responses from witnesses who were acquainted with Galt or saw the fleeing sniper.

“Unless he was wearing a wig or had had a face lift or something, it’s not the man I saw,” said Charles Q. Stevens, who

lives at the Main Street rooming house from which the fatal shot apparently was fired.

“The hair is too full and the face is too young,” he said. But Stevens said he only got a side view of the fleeing figure.

A source in Birmingham said the photograph was taken within the past three months, although the FBI did not specify when it was made. The photo has sharp contrast, making hair and features very dark.

The FBI, relying on witnesses apparently, said the fugitive had been described as a white man, 5-8 to 5-11, weighing 160 to 175 pounds, with brown hair in a brush cut, blue eyes, straight nose.

Persons who have met Galt, the FBI reported, described him as a loner with a “rural” speech and little schooling, fond of vodka, beer and hillbilly music.

The FBI statement also said, “The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his left hand. His left ear protrudes further from his head than his right ear.”

“Galt should be considered armed and dangerous,” the FBI release warned.

Galt has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmefyer, the FBI said. The assassin registered at the Memphis rooming house under the name of John Willard.

Details of the alleged conspiracy were missing from the FBI release, as were vital statistics, such as Galt’s birthplace, formal statement said Galt claimed to have been a cook on Mississippi riverboats, a merchant seaman and “is said to be an avid dancer.”

Galt, the FBI said, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang with Alabama license plates abandoned in Atlanta the day after King was shot to death. The vehicle was left in the parking lot of an apartment project near the Georgia Capitol.

Two white Mustangs were parked near the rooming house shortly before the shooting, witnesses have said, and both disappeared minutes later. Some witnesses told of a man in a black business suit, neatly dressed, walking down the steps to the street, dropping a rifle and getting into a Mustang with either Alabama or Arkansas tags.

The FBI said Galt’s car traveled more than 19,000 miles between Aug. 30, 1967, when he bought it in Birmingham and its abandonment last week in Atlanta. There were trips to Los Angeles, New Orleans and Mexico, the FBI said.

“Galt was reported to have been in Memphis April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed from there for Atlanta,” the FBI said.
