Referenced memo of FLEMING sets forth that Thermo-Seal Machine was owned by the Brainard Martinizing Company, Chattanooga. This machine was destroyed by fire.

Mr. DAVID ALLEN RUSSEL, owner of the One Hour Martinizing Service advised that he did own a Thermo-Seal Machine which he purchased in 1965. This machine was destroyed by fire February, 1966. He did use a code similar to that set forth in memo of FLEMING. The first one or two digits was a figure indicating lot number; the second was an alphabetical letter indicating the day of the week and the third designation was a figure with one or two digits indicating bundle.

Due to the fact that this machine was destroyed by fire February, 1966, no additional investigation is being conducted regarding these specific leads set forth in SA FLEMING's memo.



The referenced Civil Rights cases of 1963 and 1966 concerns allegations of JERRY LEON MARRY, Jr. to the effect his rights were violated in his being removed from Tennessee to Georgia for commitment to the Georgia State Hospital, Milledgeville, Ga., a mental institution, without the benefit of removal hearing.

On May 8, 1963, BOR ROLLIES, Ordinary, Catoosa County, Ringgold, Georgia, advised MARRY had been committed to the Georgia State Hospital almost a year previously, but had been released to his mother and stepfather, Mr. and Mrs. BEE BRIGHT, Ringgold, Ga. BEE BRIGHT on May 8, 1963, informed that his stepson, MARRY, was in need of psychiatric treatment.

JAMES C. GALT advised that the name ERIC STARVO GALT is unknown to him and he does not have any information that would assist in any way in identifying or locating this individual.
