A Federal warrant was issued April 17, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, charging the above individual with conspiring to interfere with a constitutional right of a citizen. A Federal warrant was also issued July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri, charging this individual with interstate flight to avoid confinement for the crime of robbery.

Ray's sister, Melba Harie Ryam, has advised that he enjoyed his military duty in Germany, and had a girl friend there for which reason he might attempt to return to Germany.

A review of his Army service record on April 22, 1968, disclosed that he was assigned as follows in Germany, Army Serial Number 16 163 129:

It is noted that during this assignment he was temporarily assigned to "D/S W/Brake MP School, APO 751, Bremen, Germany", February to March, 1947; Company B. 7892nd Infantry Regiment, APO 757, Frankfort, Germany, April to June, 1948; Company B, 16th Infantry, APO 757, and 696 (note APO 696 was Firth), June to December, 1948: 7749th Staging Area, APO 69, Bremerhaven, Germany, December, 1948. His description during his Army service was --, Alton, Illinois, 5'11", 145 pounds, born white, black hair, blue eyes, occupation, Military Policeman. It is requested that an attempt be made to reconstruct his background while overseas; to identify his girl friend and alert her and appropriate individuals to report any contact with him or any information that he is in Germany. SHYSER, Hanaging Editor, The Oak Ridger, Daily newspaper, Oak Ridge, Tennessee, telephonically advised that he had recieved a eall from Mrs. Wallace de Laguna, 129 Iris Vircle, Oak Ridge, Ten mersee, advising that she had had a letter from her daughter advising and reminding her that there were a number of billboards on the highways several years ago with the question in large letters "WHO IS JOHN GALT?". He advised that Mrs. de Laguna would like a call if the FBI was interested.

Mrs. de Leguma was contacted telephonically and was advised the t the FBT was interested in any information which could possibility assist in the investigation of the case. She stated that she recalls the signs and also recalls that a book written by Ayn Rand entitled "ATLAS SHRUGGED" began with the first line "Who is John Galt?". She stated that this book was the story of a group of people who were superior and would be the rulers of the world.

Mrs. de Leguna indicated that Mr. Smyser was rather interested in the group or business who would have gone to the expense of having large signboards on the highway and she recalled that someone told her that these people were "Objectivists", who based their philosophy on the writings of Ayın Rand.

This memorandum has been prepared as a matter of record due to a newspaper contact.

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, believed fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on _______. He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.

Captain Wilborn A. Ray, Instructor, Army ROTC, East Tennessee State University, Johnson City, Tennessee, advised that in about September, 1966, while stationed at Fort Eustis, Virginia, he and Army Major Henry McAden, a Negro now in Vietnam, were discussing racial problems when Dr. Martin Luther King's name came up. Ray continued he told McAden if Dr. King ever appeared in Memphis, Tennessee, he would be murdered. Captain Ray stated that he further told Major McAden that Dr. King would be shot while standing on a motel balcony, away from his friends, either looking over the area or praying. He said that he also fold Major McAden that Dr. King's assassin would be aiming at his head but would hit him in the throat or high in the chest.

Captain Ray explained that later in either January or February, 1967, he and Major McAden were drinking in a club at Fort Eustis when McAden again brought up the subject of Dr. King's possible murder in Memphis, Tennessee. He stated that Major McAden asked him if he knew who would shoot Dr. King. He said that he replied that the man who would assassinate Dr. King was Eric Starvo Galt.

Ray stated he cannot explain why he was able to come forth with the above information and especially the name Eric Starvo Galt since he never knew anyone by

that name, in fact, had never heard the name until after the assassination of Dr. King. He said, however, in the past on several occasions he had been able to predict future events.

Captain Ray requested that the information furnished in this matter be kept confidential since he is aware that it makes him appear a mental case, but he wants the information a matter of record since he feels that when Major McAden receives the details of Dr. King's death, he will recall their previous conversation concerning Dr. King's assassination in Memphis and will report it to military authorities.

On April 17, 1968, Agent Jerry Thurlow, Military Intelligence, Johnson City, Tennessee, advised that Captain Wilborn A. Ray, ROTC Instructor, East Tennessee State University, has an above average IQ, an excellent Army record, and is considered an above average instructor at East Tennessee State University. Thurlow added that Colonel Richard Krueger, Captain Ray's Commanding Officer at East Tennessee State University, has advised that at the time of Dr. King's death in Memphis, Tennessee, he and Captain Ray with other members of a bowling team were bowling in Johnson City, Tennessee.
