


UNKNOWN SUBJECT, aka., Eric Starvo Galt, Harvey Lowmeyer, John Willard; MARTIN LUTHER KING -VICTIM; CIVIL RIGHTS

Captain Wilborn A. Ray, Instructor, Army ROTC, East Tennessee State University, Johnson City, Tennessee, advised that in about September, 1966, while stationed at Fort Eustis, Virginia, he and Army Major Henry McAden, a Hegro now in Vietnam, were discussing racial problems when Dr. Martin Luther King's name came up. Ray continued he told McAden if Dr. King ever appeared in Memphis, Tennessee, he would be mardered. Captain Ray stated that he further told Major McAden that Dr. King would be shot while standing on a motel balcony, away from his friends, either looking over the area or praying. He said that he also fold Major McAden that Dr. King's assassin would be aiming at his head but would hit him in the throat or high in the chest.

Captain Ray explained that later in either January or February, 1967, he and Major McAden were drinking in a club at Fort Eustis when McAden again brought up the subject of Dr. King's possible murder in Memphis, Tennessee. He stated that Major McAden asked him if he knew who would shoot Dr. King. He said that he replied that the man who would assassinate Dr. King was Eric Starvo Galt.

Ray stated he cannot explain why he was able to come forth with the above information and especially the name Eric Starvo Galt since he never knew anyone by

that name, in fact, had never heard the name until after the assassination of Dr. King. He said, however, in the past on several occasions he had been able to predict future events.

Captain Ray requested that the information furnished in this matter be kept confidential since he is aware that it makes him appear a mental case, but he wants the information a matter of record since he feels that when Major McAden receives the details of Br. King's death, he will recall their previous conversation concerning Br. King's assassination in Memphis and will report it to military authorities.

On April 17, 1968, Agent Jerry Thurlow, Military Intelligence, Johnson City, Tennessee, advised that Captain Wilborn A. Ray, ROTC Instructor, East Tennessee State University, has an above average IQ, an excellent Army record, and is considered an above average instructor at East Tennessee State University. Thurlow added that Colonel Richard Krueger, Captain Ray's Commanding Officer at East Tennessee State University, has advised that at the time of Dr. King's death in Mamphis, Tennessee, he and Captain Ray with other members of a bowling team were bowling in Johnson City, Tennessee.

A death notice in the Press-Chronicle, Johnson City, Pennessee, dated 2/2/68, reflected the death of JEAN DITE R. CRITTELDON, 502 Lee (ircle, Johnson City, Tennessee, on 2/1/68. Relatives were listed as two daughters, MCS. BUTTY MICTOLS, Placentia, California, and MRS. CUE ELLEF, Elizabethton, Tennessee; two sisters, MTS. ASTPA LAFGETT, Halls, Tennessee, and MRS. VIOLET SCOTT, Memphis, Tennessee; and, two brothers, CHORGE RINGEF and DARFELL TINGEF, both Memphis, Tennessee.

On 5/7/68, Mrs. SUE ELLEP, 516 Washington Street, Flizabethton, Tennessee, advised that her mother, JEANETTE CRITTENDOW, Johnson City, Tennessee, died 2/1/68. She stated that her sister, PETTY NICHOLS, Placentia, California, arrived at Johnson City, Tennessee, about two days prior to her mother's death and remained until her hasband, MACOLD NICHOLS, came for her.

She continued that NICUCLS and his wife and son left Elizabethton, Tennessee, either 2/29/68, or 3/1/68, enroute to their home in California. She stated that in about one week she received a letter from her sister stating that they had arrived home, in Placentia, California, on either Tuesday, 3/5/68, or Wednesday, 3/6/68, and she cannot resember just which date the letter indicated.

She added that she has the following relatives residing in Jemphis, Tennessee, but does not know if her sister and NICLOUS visited there enroute home: Uncles, GEORGE RINGER, 1905 Central Avenue and JACK RINGER, 1783 Migon Street; and, an aunt, VISTET SCOTT, 233 North Willet. The added that another aunt, ASTRA LARGETT, resides at malls, Tennessee.

On 5/3/68, Mr. GEORGE W. CRAWFORD, Custodian at the Rossville High School, advised that he resides at 808 Indian Avenue in Rossville, Ga., and has for the past 25 years. He said he knows no one named LEWIS SHEPPARD, JR. advised he has near owned a 1953 Chrysler and stated that he knows of no one named SHEPPARD who has resided in that neighborhood.

Each Special Agent in Charge and Legal Attache is instructed to promptly remind their established cooperative news sources in a discreet and tactful manner, of the existence of substantial reward money for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the killer of Dr. Martin Luther King. This money now totals at least \$100,000. The FBI should not, however, be publicized as the source of this reminder.

While the Bureau's continuing policy is to encourage the public to furnish information to law enforcement authorities as a matter of good citizenship, without expectation of financial reward, it is fully recognized that monetary rewards are often necessary to motivate some individuals. The knowledge of the existence of the substantial rewards available in the Murkin case could possibly prove of value in the solution of this major investigation.

CRISPI stated SCHNEIDERMAN opened a checking account on April 22, 1968, with a deposit of \$5 and stated he expected to receive at this branch of the Bank of America a wire of transfer of funds from Chicago, Illinois. He exhibited to CRISPI as means of identification Eastern Airlines Credit Card and Millionaire Club Credit Card. CRISPI stated he did not obtain the numbers of these cards. CRISPI described SCHNEIDERMAN as a white male, 5'7", 130 pounds, dark hair neatly trimmed, neatly dressed, shirt and tie, dark coat, no hat, 25 to 30 years of age. SCHNEIDERMAN indicated he was staying at the Holiday Inn in South San Francisco, California.

Mr. CRISPI advised he had one check dated April 24, 1968, paid to the order of the Holiday Inn in the amount of \$10, signed S. M. SCHNEIDERMAN. On the back of this check was the following identification information:

BRUCE LYON, Desk Manager, Holiday Inn, 245 South Airport, South San Francisco, California, on May 28, 1968, advised his records indicate one S. SCHNEIDERMAN checked into this motel on April 20, 1968, and skipped out sometime on April 22, 1968, owing a bill of \$60.48. The registration card gave his residence address as 715 Hope, Los Angeles, California, and firm as Equipment Engineers at 715 Hope, Los Angeles, California, automobile license VRG 245 (California).

Mr. LYON furnished a description of SCHNEIDERMAN which is the same as that furnished by Mr. CRISPI.
