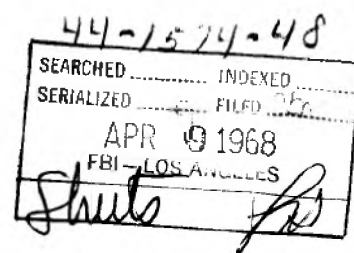

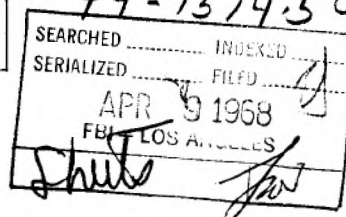

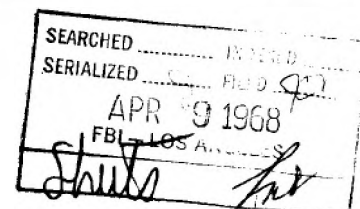

This is to advise that the writer contacted the FBI Laboratory concerning photographs of duckbill pliers sent by the Laboratory to Los Angeles. The purpose of the inquiry was to ascertain whether or not any code numbers appeared on the price ticket that was still on the pliers. This would indicate in the upper left a figure giving the month and in the upper right a figure giving the year this item was placed on the inventory of the hardware company.

At 11:20 A.M. 4/8/68 BOB FRAZIER telephonically advised the writer that the Laboratory was able to come up with the figure 10 in the upper left and a partial figure resembling a 0 in the upper right.

SA BENJAMIN, who is currently handling this lead, advises that at the hardware company it was ascertained that the company purchased one dozen sets of duckbill pliers and placed these pliers on inventory in October 1966. This information was furnished to FRAZIER. At the moment, the hardware company has one set of pliers remaining in stock, and Agents are going through all sales tickets from October 1966 to the present in an attempt to locate the sale of the additional 11 pairs of pliers, inasmuch as none of the current employees of the company recall making any recent sales.

A search of the premises believed occupied by Unsub who killed Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., on 4/4/68 disclosed a pair of brownish checkered print undershorts and white jockey tee shirt bearing cloth laundry tags. These tags were made by a thermo seal marking machine manufactured by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York.

The tags are one quarter inch wide and one and one sixteenth inch long, red in color and bear marking which appears to be "O 2 B-6" or "D 2 B -6". Only a portion of the first character is present on each tag, and this character is cut on a slight bias.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are fifteen point type and the last three characters are eighteen point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries fifteen point type for the first three characters and eighteen point type for the last two characters.

Experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape one and one sixteenth inch long instead of one and one eighth inch long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter.

The code is as follows: The first letter "O" stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, 2 being Tuesday; the second letter "B" indicates the first letter of the store name; the last number is the bundle number which is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain.

Telephonically contact all laundries to identify laundry using this code and these tags and pursue logical leads developed. First contact those laundries whose name starts with a "B" and advise Headquarters of results, thereafter contact remainder.

On April 5, 1968, at approximately 8:45 PM, GERALD PATRICK HEMMING, 2668 Hoyt, El Monte, California, (no phone) telephonically contacted the Los Angeles office Night Supervisor J. C. WILLIAMS. HEMMING stated his friend, ROY E. HARGRAVES (2662 Hoyt, Apt. C, El Monte), had a conversation with a "bunk mate" whom he identified as (FNU) PETERSON, a Seaman on the USS Mc Kenzie, a destroyer berthed at Long Beach California.

PETERSON allegedly has in his possession letters and photographs from FRANK (LNU), his cousin, who was formerly on board the USS Mc Kenzie, and was either AWOL or discharged from the Navy.

PETERSON, according to HEMMING, was very upset because the letters and photos outline a plan to assassinate KING. The letters indicated a sniper plan was to be used, and the place where assassination to take place was Memphis, Tennessee. The letters described the rifle with a telescopic sight.

ART ARREGO, OIC, NIS, Los Angeles was telephonically contacted and without disclosing reason why, asked to determine if a Seaman PETERSON was assigned to the USS Mc Kenzie at Long Beach. ARREGO discreetly ascertained an ordinary seaman, ALLEN ROY PETERSON, NSN [REDACTED] was assigned to the deck crew of the ship, located at Pier 20, Long Beach.

At 9:55 PM, ASAC ROGGE was advised of the foregoing, at which time he instructed that duty Agents DURKIN and GEORGE proceed immediately to the destroyer for the purpose of locating and interviewing PETERSON. 0

Indices of Los Angeles office reflect HEMMING is the subject of 105-10277; further that he is anti-Castro, anti-Communist, who appears to be a soldier of fortune who served in the rebel Army & Air Force of the Castro government in 1959, and later conducted anti-Castro activity in the Everglades of Florida.


