It has been determined that the unsub in this matter possibly abandoned a pair of duck-billed pliers in the room from which KING was apparently shot.

These pliers bear the name Rompage Hardware on an affixed price label. It has been determined that this concern is located at 5542 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, California. The present employers at Rompage are positive that these pliers came from their store. None of these individuals recall any specific sale of these pliers, the price of which was \$1.98.

The coding on the label establishes that these pliers were placed in inventory by Rompage in October, 1966 and sold from a bargain bin tray located near the front of the store. The owner has provided the names of the following former employees who ceased employment subsequent to October, 1966. In some instances the period of employment was brief, however, all these persons must be contacted expeditiously to determine any knowledge or recollection they may have of a sale of these pliers. It is not out of the realm of possibility that these persons may have purchased or appropriated these pliers themselves.

In questioning these persons, it should be sufficient to explain only that these pliers have a bearing on a matter we are investigating.

The unsub is described as follows:

LUCY PINELA, Manager of the Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning, 5200 Hollywood Blvd., Los Angeles, advised the writer and SA DENNIS LE MASTER, after observing a color photo of the shorts and T shirt found in connection with this case, that she believed the shorts might belong, or were the same type to a former employee known only to her as JIM (LNU) or "Uncle". She said JIM worked at the laundry for a period of about one month during February and March, 1968. She said JIM was a personal friend of J. W. It has been determined that the unsub in this matter possibly abandoned a pair of duck-billed pliers in the room from which KING was apparently shot.

These pliers bear the name Rompage Hardware on an affixed price label. It has been determined that this concern is located at 5542 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, California. The present employers at Rompage are positive that these pliers came from their store. None of these individuals recall any specific sale of these pliers, the price of which was \$1.98.

The coding on the label establishes that these pliers were placed in inventory by Rompage in October, 1966 and sold from a bargain bin tray located near the front of the store. The owner has provided the names of the following former employees who ceased employment subsequent to October, 1966.
