TO LATENTS ON MATERIAL DEVELOPED IN MEMPHIS INVESTIGATION,  
THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS ARE MADE:

✓ THERE IS A STRIKING SIMILARITY BETWEEN VERNON AND

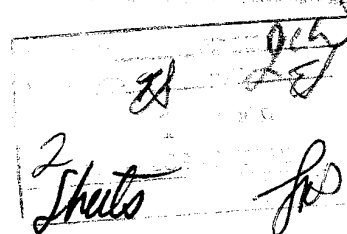
