

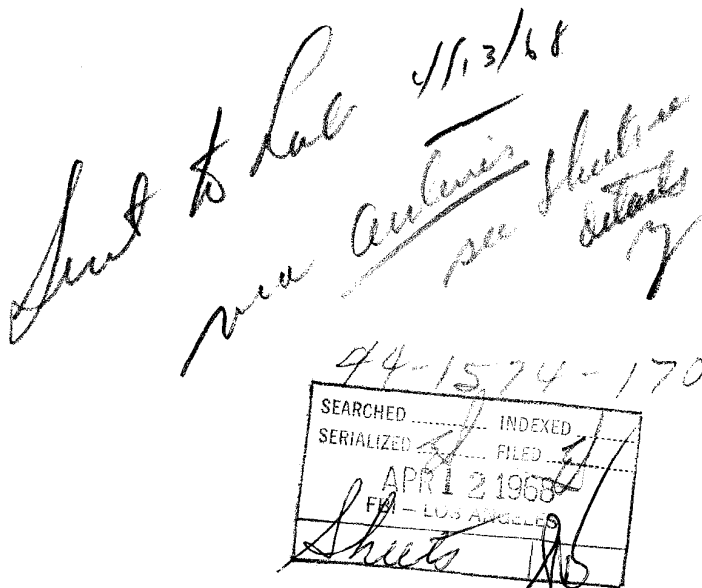
(1) One 3x5 white piece of notepaper, bearing the following inscription: "Keys from 303 Sorry we could not get to know you better Mr. Flikeid".

On 4/12/68 FREDERICK OSTENDORF, Probation Officer, Probation Department, County of Los Angeles, 600 East Broadway, Glendale, California (245-1831) furnished the following information:

For the past six months he has supervised the probation for JEROME WALLIS VERNON, who was convicted of forgery in May of 1967 by the Superior Court, Pasadena, California (# A540352), and placed on probation at Pasadena on 8/31/67.

VERNON appeared in person at the Glendale Office of the Probation Department between approximately 11:30 AM and 1:00 PM on 4/5/68, and talked briefly with OSTENDORF. On that date VERNON indicated (on a probation report form) that he was residing at 14 New York Street, Southend of New York Street, La Crescenta, California with a BONNIE BOYCE, not further identified. VERNON also indicated that he recently obtained employment as an OR mechanic at the Lockheed Aircraft Co., Burbank, California, and was working a shift from 4:00 PM to 12:30 AM.

VERNON, who formerly operated a laundry, told OSTENDORF that he lost this laundry because of "tax problems" incurred by the previous owner.

VERNON, CII # 860898, has numerous prior arrests including a 4/22/65 arrest for burglary and grand theft auto, a 2/21/66 arrest for reckless driving, and a 1/11/67 arrest for failure to comply with a court order. He (VERNON) was placed on probation 4/29/66 by a municipal court in Santa Anita, California for reckless driving.

VERNON's co-defendant in his 1967 forgery conviction was a JAMES RICHARD HENDRICKS, 1458 Ranch Road, Duarte, California (Born [redacted] at Atlanta, Ga.).

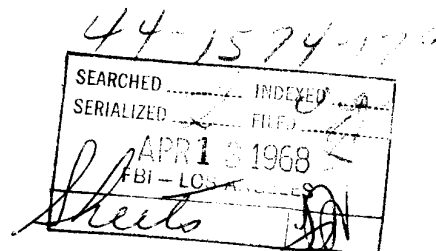

On 4/13/68, Sergeant HARVEY M CHANEY, LASO, Los Angeles County Jail, MA 69511, Ext. 83211, telephonically advised this Office that one GILBERT R. ABSTON, Booking Number 688086, a prisoner in the Los Angeles County Jail, had written a note that he, ABSTON had information concerning the killing of KING.

On 4/13/68, the writer proceeded to the Los Angeles County jail to interview ABSTON. The interview was arranged through Sergeant CHANEY who advised that ABSTON appeared to be quite normal. Sergeant furnished the note written by ABSTON in which ABSTON advised he would be willing to take a lie detector test.

ABSTON orally advised as follows:

A photograph of the suspected killer of KING appeared in the 4/13/68 issue of the "Los Angeles Times". The profile photograph "fits to a tee" one WILLIAM LENNARD or LENNORD who, in 1957 or 1958, served time in Draper Prison, Elmore, Alabama, with ABSTON. LENNARD was ~~xx~~ serving time on a manslaughter charge for the shooting of a negro. LENNARD, ABSTON's cellmate, told ABSTON that, prior to his, LENNARD's, arrest, he had followed KING from Bessemer, Alabama, to Tuscaloosa, Alabama, in hopes of getting an opportunity of shooting KING. LENNARD's talk centered around his hatred of negroes. He was always figuring ways of "getting rid" of KING. He said he would do it if no one beat him to it. LENNARD had a father and grand father who may still be living in Bessemer, Alabama, and who, in all probability, would know LENNARD's current whereabouts. LENNARD's father was a gunsmith who, according to LENNARD, made a gun for LENNARD which could not be traced. LENNARD's wife left him while he was incarated.

ABSTON hopes to be released from jail Monday, 4/15/68. Following his release, he can be reached through LOU HILL, 1775 Freeman Avenue, Long Beach, California, 438 5210. ABSTON claimed he married HILL in Mexico and, upon his release, will marry her in the United States.
