Re your memorandum dated 4-9-68 concerning telephonically contacting laundries to identify the laundry using the marking machine of pertinence in this case.

The writer was assigned a list of laundries to contact. Before all were contacted it was determined that the marking machine had apparently been located. Therefore no further contacts were made as it was believed that no further contacts with laundries were necessary in this regard.

On 4-10-68, SA F. J. Petersen and the writer contacted B. E. Gorrill, President, Gor-Buc Security Systems, Inc., 2122 West Beverly Blvd., Los Angeles, phone 386-8010. Gorrill has residence phone 331-7449.

Gorrill was shown a photo of the laundry labels involved in this matter, but he said that they had no specific meaning to him. He said that these labels are commonly in use; that this type of mark is used throughout the U. S. He said that very few of the laundries they serve have home laundry; that Gor-Buc handles linen suppliers and industrial suppliers and not generally home laundries or laundries that do personal type work. He said that his company is a national agency, with headquarters at 2122 W. Beverly Blvd., Los Angeles; that his company serves in many cities in the U. S., such as Phoenix, Chicago, Kansas City, New York, Atlanta, etc.

Gorrill thought that the laundry involved in this case might be a small place as there were few characters in the labels.

He suggested contacting Dave Mc Kenzie, head of the Los Angeles Laundry Owners Association, Statler Center Room 222, 900 Wilshire Blvd., Los Angeles tel. 683-1574. He does labor negotiating. He has list that might be useful for circularization purposes. He could suggest trade publications for placing a notice.

Gorrill also suggested as another person who might be of assistance, Samuel B. Shapiro, Executive Director, Linen Supply Association of America, 975 Arthur Godfrey Road, Miami Beach, Florida. This organization publishes "Linen Supply News", its official magazine. Gorrill advised that this publication is the "book of the trade" and that putting a notice in it might be productive. He further advised that this is a monthly magazine and is received by numerous home laundries.

On 4-10-68, SA F.J. Petersen and the writer displayed a photograph of the pertinent laundry labels in this case to employees at Foasberg Laundry and Cleaners, 640 E. Wardlow Rd., Long Beach, California, after that place of business had been contacted by SA Richard J. Nelson. While making this contact to make a display of the photograph, one of the employees of the Foasberg firm advised that a ~~machine~~ label making machine similar to that <sup>the</sup> at Foasberg firm, was at Gaylord Cleaners, 1232 Obispo, Long Beach.

On April 13, 1968, the following individuals connected with National Dance Studios, 2026 Pacific Boulevard, Long Beach observed composite photographs of the suspect in this case. All of these individuals have seen ERIC GALT in the past.

CATHRYN NORTON, 155 East Eagle, Apartment 5, Long Beach. She has had numerous contacts with GALT from December, 1968 to February, 1968. She advised that the Memphis photograph most nearly resembles GALT, except that the forehead is a little too high

RICARDO DE CARO, 1923 Florida Street, Long Beach. He had only occasional contact with GALT. He said he did not recall GALT too well, and he said he could not say if the photographs resembled GALT.

ANDREAS JORGENSEN, 125 East 20th Street, Long Beach, California. He advised that the Memphis photograph closely resembles GALT, however the forehead is a little high and the chin should be more square.

At 3:10PM 4-10-68 Sgt. Ronald Mellinger San Bernardino County Sheriffs Department Barstow Substation telephonically contacted SA Martin and advised that Deputy Dean Kuckkahn of his department had just completed booking 4 individuals who had been arrested by the Sante Fe Railroad Special Agent Don Hall for trespassing of Sante Fe Property. Mellinger advised that while booking these individuals two of them a David Richard Brown and a Charles Edward Brogdon had made several remarks about the assassination of Martin Luther King. He stated that Brogdon told Kuckkahn that he was going to turn Brown in and Brown thereafter stated "I did it". He stated that both subjects appeared to be winos and did not fit any description he had of the murderer but he thought he had better notify the FBI anyway.

All 4 individuals were interviewed by SA Martin and 302s are attached.

On 4-10-68 a check of all laundries in the cities of SANTA BARBARA, LOMPOC and CARPINTERIA areas failed to reflect any information regarding the THERMO SEAL MAILING MACHINE. There are several laundries that utilize this marking method, but none use the same code and none have a machine that is not operating in good shape.

City Directory, Telephone Directories, Credit Bureau, Police and Sheriff's office records failed to reflect any information on ERIC BALT in Santa Barbara City and County, Lompoc and Carpinteria, Calif.

ANDERSON ONLY TENNANT IDENTIFIED BY GARNER AS BEING FRIENDLY WITH GALT HOWEVER ALL CONTEMPORARY TENNANTS IDENTIFIED AND WILL BE INTERVIEWED.

NOT POSSIBLE TO PURSUE WITH GARNER CONTENTS OF LOCKED ROOM WHICH CONTAINS TV WITHOUT RISK OF COMPROMISING SOURCE. THIS IS ROOM FOUR. ROOM FIVE AT ONE ZERO SEVEN FOURTEENTH ST. NOT RENTED SINCE VACATED BY GALT BUT CLEANED BY MAID WEDNESDAY APRIL TEN. ROOM SIX AT ONE ONE THREE FOURTEENTH ST. RENTED APRIL THIRTEEN TO NEW TENNANT PRIOR TO CLEAN UP BY MAID. BED MAKE UP BY NEW TENNANT AND SHEETS USED BY GALT OBTAINED DURING PROCESSING OF ROOM WITH GARNER'S CONSENT. ALL ITEMS OF POSSIBLE VALUE BEING FURNISHED BUREAU.
