REGGIE SMITH, cameraman, Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS), Atlanta, Georgia, telephonically contacted SA JAMES O. INGRAM on April 12, 1968. He stated he had just arrived in Atlanta upon instructions issued by officials of CBS. The news media is presently carrying headlines indicating that ERIC STARVO GALT is a prime suspect in the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. at Memphis, Tennessee. A white Mustang registered to GALT was found in Atlanta, on April 11, 1968, abandoned. Through news media, SMITH has obtained description of GALT and believes he has information which could be of value to the FBI. He furnished the following information:

On Saturday, April 6, 1968, he and his soundman, LEROY COLLINS, traveled to Spelman College, Atlanta, Georgia, to film persons viewing the body of Dr. KING, or incidents. The first roll of film that he shot was of a group of about ten people. There was one lone white male who viewed the body in this first group and he and his soundman, COLLINS, noticed the unknown male pass by the coffin and smile. He appeared to laugh, looked around to see if anyone was observing him, and he left "with a smile on his face." SMITH did not consider the incident of any value at that time, until he reviewed the information on GALT and GALT's description.

He described the unknown subject who viewed the body of KING as a white male, in his early thirties, 5' 10" to 5' 11", weight 160 - 170 pounds, dark hair, and was wearing a light-colored suit. SMITH suggested that the FBI may desire to review his first can of sixteen

At 12:29 PM, 4/15/68, Section Chief C.L. MC GOWAN, telephonically inquired concerning suspect ERIC #AULT.

MC GOWAN stated investigative results from Los Angeles do not disclose if GAULT actually registered for the WALLACE for President Party; whether he witnessed the registrations of CHARLES STEIN and the other individuals at the WALLACE for President Headquarters.

MC GOWAN also inquired as to whether Los Angeles had interviewed any of the employees for the WALLACE for President Headquarters, inasmuch it was indicated GAULT appeared to be known at this location.

MC GOWAN was advised this investigation continues to receive vigorous and intensive investigation and supervisory attention. He was advised that immediate inquiry would be made concerning his questions and that the Bureau would be promptly advised of the results thereof.

In general discussion MC GOWAN stated investigative efforts are being directed toward ascertaining a date of birth for GAULT and to ascertain his activity prior to the Summer of 1967.

CONDRA was interviewed at his employment and indicated that he had formerly worked for the Chevron Station on Normandie Avenue in Los Angeles, but was unable to recall ERIC STARVO GALT and was also unable to identify a photograph of the above person. CONDRA related that he had left his former employment on 3/13/68 and if he serviced GALT's vehicle it would have to have been between January, 1968 and 3/13/68.

CONDRA related that he knew no person by the name of GALT and if it was necessary to be contacted again, he related that he was residing at 11 Normandie, Los Angeles, and his telephone number is 383-6691.
