AT ELEVEN FIFTEEN A.M., MC GRATH TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED HE HAD TO GO TO WORK AT NOON AND WOULD NOT HAVE TIME TO COME TO THE HAYWARD RESIDENT AGENCY. AN APPOINTMENT WAS MADE TO MEET HIM AT HIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, THE BLUE DOLPHIN, A FIRST-CLASS SAN LEANDRO RESTAURANT. WHEN HE FINISHED WORK AT EIGHT P. M.

SAS RICHARD J. MC MULLEN AND WILLIAM HUTTON, JR. MET MC GRATH AT THE BLUE DOLPHIN. IN THE INTERVIEW, HE RELATED THE ABOVE INCIDENT, BUT THIS VERSION WAS SOMEWHAT DIFFERENT THAN THAT SET OUT ABOVE. HE SAID THIS INCIDENT OCCURRED AT APPROXIMATELY SEVEN TO SEVEN THIRTY P.M., APRIL FIFTEEN LAST. IT IS NOTED THE MAN HE REFERRED TO WAS SUBSEQUENTLY IDENTIFIED AS DALE C. Dr. TEAFORD also mentioned during this contact the reward (\$150M) which "it would be nice to get".

This application shows that BRADY worked as a chef at The Arsenal, 12012 W. Pico, Los Angeles.

The following investigation was conducted on 4/18/68 by SAs J. CHARLES MERRIMAN and the writer:

ZANE IRONS, bartender, 400 S. Barrington, Los Angeles, and waitress ETHEL LEE, 8957 Kitty Hawk, Los Angeles, both employed at The Arsenal, 12012 W. Pico, Los Angeles, both advised they have known JOHN BRADY, known by his acquaintances as JACK BRADY, for about the past two years. Both described him as about 6' tall and weighing about 200#. He did wrk at this restaurant as a chef, but quit the early part of this year because of the long and irregular hours. BRADY's wife, MARY BRADY, continues to work as a waitress at this restaurant. The BRADY's drive a Chevrolet station wagon, light brown, about a 1965 model. Glossy prints of GALT were shown to these employees and both stated that although there is some resemblance, this is not a photograph of JACK BRADY.

on 4/19/68 JACQUEL NE MARTIN, Assistant Head Teacher, Twentyfourth Elementary School Child Care Center, 2055 West 24th Street, Los Angeles, stated the person to whom Mrs. KATHY SCHARF refers is HOWARD LESSER, Los Angeles City Board of Education employment number 13673, who is a substitute playground supervisor at instant Child Care Center. She described LESSER in essence as did Trs. SCHARF. JACQUELINE MARTIN, along with BRIDGET MATLOCK and JEWEL NELSON, teachers at instant school, observed photographs of GALT and all stated that GALT's photographs were definitely not identical to HOWARD LESSER.

On 4/9/68, the captioned subject met the writer at the door of the Ventura Resident Agency and requested that he be allowed to "play a recording" for the agent. When inquired as to the nature of the recording, the subject stated that it was pertinent to items of national interest.

MILLER then proceeded to set up the portable recorder he had in his possession. However, instead of playing the recording, he began to inquire the identity of the interviewing agent by utilizing his microphone. At this point, the recorder was disconnected by the writer and MILLER was advised that it was against the policy of this office to allow a recorder to be used and he was again asked the nature of his visit.

MILLER, who was somewhat upset over not being allowed to use the recording, stated that his information had to do with the death of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated that on this morning when he had awakened, he was reading scripture and at this point he produced a pocket size Bible and quoted very rapidly a section of the scripture, a jest of what appeared to be a statement to the effect that "low and then he kicked dust in my eyes with his heels".

MILLER continued and stated that after reading this chapter and verse, he had a "premonition" or "revelation" to the effect that he believed that the assassin of MARTIN LUTHER KING was ADAM CLAYTON POWELL. He stated this connection was from newspaper accounts involving a white car, a white suit, and a "mulatto."

MILLER was advised that if he had any specific information that the writer would accept the same, but MILLER stated that all it was in his feeling that this was the answer to the killing of Dr. KING.

MILLER then departed after furnishing his resident address of 1109 Rodderick Street, Oxnard, California, telephone number 487-3690.


