On 4/19/68 LT. COLEMAN of the San Gabriel Police Dept. was contacted by telephone, (AT2-11 44) and indicated that a patrolman with his department was stopped by a driver of acity garbage truck who stated that he observed a man who could be identical with ERIC S. GALT who resides at the Royal Palms Apts., Palm Ave., San Gabriel, California. COLEMAN was unable to recall the officers name, but did recall that the officer did not take the drivers name or place of residence.

On 4/19/68 Lt. COLEMAN was contacted at the San Gabriel PD, San Gabriel, California who was unable to furnish any additional information concernig this matter, but indicated that Palm Ave. is a very short street in San Gabriel and may run for approximately five blocks.

On 4/19/68 the Royal Palms Apartment was located at 1537 Palms Ave., San Gabriel, California and the manager HELEN FAUBIAN was contacted and after being shown photos of GALT she indicated that there was no one living in the apartment who was similar in appearance or description. She indicated that there are only three males residing in the apartm ent ~~but~~ building and they are all about fifty years of age and do not come close to GALTs description. She indicated that they might have mistaken her husband WILLIAM FAUBIAN as GALT, but he is bald and is over 6'2". After viewing a photograph of WILLIAM FABIAN and a review of the apartment records and a check with several tenants it was determined that no one identical with GALT resided at the above address.

On 4/23/68 WILLIAM FAUBIAN, Royal Palms Apts., 1537 Palms Ave., indicated that no one identical with RAY, aka GALT, ever resided at the above address. He related that most of the tenants at the apartment were over fifty years of age. He took care of all the maintance for the apartments and on Feb. 18, 1968 he recalled that he was watering the plants around the apartment and no strangers were around the apartments with the exception of the postman and the garbage collectors. Mr. FAUBIAN does not resemble GALT who resides in Apt, #1.

EACH GIRL STATED THAT SHE DID NOT RECALL SEEING SUCH AN INDIVIDUAL ON THE PLANE. SHE STATED THAT FLIGHT FOUR SEVEN IS A MIAMI BASED FLIGHT AND THAT THE STEWARDESSES ABOARD THAT FLIGHT ALL WOULD LIVE IN MIAMI.

Facts of complaint

C stated that around Oct. 67 a man moved into the apt. next to her, #17, that looked very similar to RAY. C stated he moved out one of the last couple of days of March. C said he drove a Mustang, but she doesn't remember the color, maybe red, and he had a girlfriend with blonde hair. He was usually home, and played western music constantly.

C said she does not know his name, and she only saw him one time. C said the landlord could probably furnish his name.

This is to record that Mrs. MARGARET M. FLYNN, 529 South Figueroa, spoke to the writer at 2:08 p.m., 11/5/71. She was quite irate, saying she wanted to know where her reward money was for the apprehension of JAMES EARL RAY. She said she had furnished this Office information concerning the JAMES EARL RAY matter and she felt she was entitled to a reward.

She was courteously informed this was not an FBI case but that the FBI had assisted in an international search in an effort to apprehend him. The matter was handled by the District Attorney's office in Memphis, Tennessee, and if she felt she was entitled to any reward money concerning JAMES EARL RAY's apprehension in England, it was suggested she furnish a letter to the above District Attorney setting forth her views.

Mrs. FLYNN was not satisfied with this answer. I repeated the information in a courteous manner and thanked her for contacting this Office. The conversation was then terminated.

ADDENDUM: Files of the LA Division reflect Mrs. FLYNN contacted this Office at various times concerning the whereabouts of MARTIN BORMANN, Nazi fugitive. Her information was of no value. In addition, the files reflect that as of 4/23/68 she appeared in person and was interviewed by IC RICHARD T. VOYLES, at which time she said a man had moved into her apartment building, next to her, who looked very similar to RAY. See 44-1574-632 - a notation by the supervisor on this serial reflects "negative - whereabouts accounted for during this period."

MARKS stated that his office is located at captioned address in a large office bldg, suite 108A and that he, MARKS, resides at 18424 Collins, Apt. 39, Tarzana, tel# 343-9735.

MARKS thereafter proceeded to state that he believes the person responsible for the threat to be GINO BELLINI who is a henchman for a crime syndicate boss named THOMAS ROSE. Stated that BELLINI is presently residing at 4318 Wilkinson, North Hollywood and proceeded to provide writer with information regarding the bombing of his office on Montana Street, Los Angeles, 1965 and subsequent theft of the bombing investigation evidence from his office. The facts re this matter and prior contacts MARKS has had with this office are recorded in file 44-1030 which contains info to the effect that MARKS is a constant source of problems to police and is listed in the office nut file as possible "psycho".

Mr. CHARLES FRIDBERG, 5330 Lindley Ave., Encino, (987-1173), employed as an agent for the New York Life Insurance Co., 7080 Hollywood Blvd., Rm 405, Hollywood, (463-4161), appeared at the Van Nuys Resident Agency this ~~day~~ and furnished the following information. Mr. FRIDBERG specifically requested that his name be kept confidential and that the information be used circumspectly as he feared that some reprisal might be taken against him by the men involved if it became known to them that he was the source of the information.

In mid February, 1968, WILLIAM S. ORWIG, who at that time was residing at the Studio Motor Inn, 4005 Lankershim Blvd., Studio City, was referred to him as a person desiring an insurance policy. FRIDBERG contacted ORWIG and the latter made application for a \$75,000 policy naming his foster son, LARRY LA COSTA, as his beneficiary. ORWIG passed the physical examination for the policy but the check he gave as payment for the premium bounced.

ORWIG claimed to be self-employed as an agent for entertainers. He moved from the Studio Motor Inn to 4135 Laurel Canyon, Apt #9, (unlisted phone 769-8367) but left there owing money to move to 4150 Arch Dr., Apt #26, Studio City, (unlisted phone 769-6127). Latter is his current address as far as FRIDBERG knows.

FRIDBERG said he contacted ORWIG on several occasions after his check bounced and each time ORWIG assured him that he would give another check to him; however, he did not do so. On 4/3/68, in the morning, FRIDBERG went to ORWIG's apartment on Arch Dr. in an effort to get the matter straightened out. ORWIG was busy on the telephone in another room and FRIDBERG was admitted to the apartment by three men who were playing cards in the living room. FRIDBERG waited for ORWIG for about twenty minutes and during that time the three men

talked about a gun and a "scope". FRIDBERG said he could not recall the details but one of them said he got it from "Dad" and he did not think he had to pay him. The amount of \$50.00 was mentioned in connection with this.

When ORWIG came into the room, he appeared very nervous and excited and said he had no time to talk to FRIDBERG as he had to get these men off to Hawaii immediately. FRIDBERG left after that and he has not seen ORWIG or the three men since.

FRIDBERG said that one of the three men who were playing cards while he waited for ORWIG resembled the picture of ~~ERIC~~ ERIC STARVO GALT which appeared in the "Los Angeles Times" of 4/21/68. This was the picture of GALT taken in 1960. FRIDBERG viewed ~~the~~ the 1968 pictures of GALT which appear on the Wanted Flyer but he said they did not resemble the man he saw.

FRIDBERG described the man as follows:

WILLARD advised he was 31 years of age, 6'1", and weighed 190 pounds. He was employed as a relief bartender at the Yorba Linda Inn, Placentia, California. He denied any complicity whatsoever in the KING murder case.

On 4/12/68, MICHAEL CORSALI, owner, Yorba Linda Inn, 1162 Yorba Linda Boulevard, Placentia, California, advised he had seen JOHN WILLIAM WILLARD, JR. at his bar on 4/4/68 and that he was a long-time friend of WILLARD.

In view of the foregoing, no further contact with WILLARD was had by SA MEYER.

A review of the indices of the Los Angeles Office failed to disclose that any JOHN WILLARD of Long Beach was interviewed in connection with the MURKIN case. There was record located in the indices of a JOHN WILLARD being previously interviewed in connection with another FBI investigation.
