Re memo of BA J. CLARE VILLIAMS dated 4/18/68 stating that he had received an anonymous phone call to the effect that GALT (RAY) was seen on a bus at 6:15 a.m. at either the 28th and Broadway or the 39th and Santa Barbara pickup points.

Chief Clerk GENE VALTERS, Security Division Southern California Rapid Transit District, 1060 South Broadway, Los Angeles advised that it would take two or three days to ascertain which buskes were passing the above points and which directions.

On 4/25/68, WALTERS advised that fifteen buses crossed the above points from 5:55 a.m. to 6:30 a.m. He contacted each of the fifteen drivers who advised him without exception that they were very familiar with the photos in the paper and on TV of GALT (RAY). The rivers advised that they had not seen GALT during the above period or any other time. Mr. WALTERS advised that all drivers were alert to the possibility that GALT might ride one of their buses and would notify their office immediately of a possible look-a-like as a public service. Mr. WALTERS was most cooperative and undertook the above questioning on a voluntary basis. No further investigation is being conducted by the LA office.

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent SPENCER H. ROBB, on April 18, 1968, at Montgomery, Alabama:

CECIL JACKSON, Executive Secretary to Former Governor GEORGE C. WALLACE, advised the Wallace for President Headquarters had received an IBM list from Los Angeles County, California, with names of all persons who registered with the American Independent Party. He stated this list was used for the mailing of literature to the registrants, but it has since been returned to Los Angeles County authorities and is not in possession of the Wallace for President Headquarters.

JACKSON advised he had viewed the photograph of ERIC S. GALT and does not recognize it as anyone who was active in the registration activity for the American Independent Party in California. JACKSON advised that he and WILLIE B. PAINTER of the State Department of Public Safety, were both closely associated with the registration activities in California and he feels they would have recognized the photograph if this man had been active in any way.

Captain WILLIE B. PAINTER, Alabama Department of Public Safety, advised he does not recognize the photograph of GALT as anyone he has ever seen.

JACKSON further advised that WILLIAM K. SHEARER, who was responsible for organizing the American Independent Party in California, but who has since been removed by the Wallace for President group should be acquainted with GALT if he were active in any way in the registration campaign in California. He stated SHEARER was found by the Wallace campaign people to be incompatible with their philosophy and in fact, appeared to be somewhat insane and this led to his removal by the Wallace people. He stated SHEARER was an excellent organizer and has a brilliant mind and although he does not resemble GALT in any way in appearance, he feels SHEARER would be capable of plotting an incident such as the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.


