STEIN LIVED WITH HER AT ONE FOUR TWO NINE BURGUNDY FOR TWO DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS. STEIN'S ORIGINAL PLANS WERE TO SPEND ONE DAY AND ONE NIGHT IN NEW ORLEANS, BUT HIS PLANS WERE ALTERED AND HE SPENT TWO DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS. STEIN CAME TO NEW ORLEANS TO PICK UP RITA STEIN'S TWO CHILDREN.

STEIN ADVISED LEE HE WAS DRIVEN TO NEW ORLEANS BY ERIC GALT. (RAY). STEIN ADVISED LEE HE DID NOT KNOW GALT AND HAD MET HIM TWO DAYS PREVIOUS TO TRIP. STEIN'S TRIP ARRANGED BY MARIA MARTIN WHO HEARD GALT STATE WAS COMING TO NEW ORLEANS AND MARTIN APPROACHED GALT TO ARRANGE RIDE FOR STEIN.

GALT STAYED AT PROVINCIAL MOTEL ON CHARTRES STREET IN NEW ORLEANS. WHILE IN NEW ORLEANS STEIN BECAME FEARFUL GALT MIGHT LEAVE HIM, SO HE TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED GALT AT PROVINCIAL MOTEL AND ASKED HIM TO COME TO LEE'S HOUSE SO GALT WOULD KNOW WHERE TO PICK STEIN UP. LEE STATED GALT CAME TO HER HOME ON SECOND DAY OF STEIN'S VISIT AND WAS INTRODUCED TO HER AS ERIC. SHE STATED GALT WAS EXTREMELY QUIET AND DID NOT SAY MUCH. GALT DID NOT ACKNOWLEDGE STEIN'S INTRODUCTION OF LEE AND MERELY LEANED AGAINST PORCH POST. LEE ADVISED GALT WAS DRIVING WHITE MUSTANG, BUT SHE COULD NOT COMMENT ON LICENSE ON THIS CAR. LEE ADVISED SHE WAS IN GALT'S COMPANY APPROXIMATELY FIVE MINUTES. LEE ADVISED STEIN COMMENTED HE COULD NOT UNDERSTAND

GALT, AS GALT PAID FOR EVERYTHING ON TRIP AND REFUSED TO ALLOW STEIN TO PAY FOR GAS OR FOOD.

LEE ADVISED ON THIRD DAY OF STEIN'S VISIT GALT PULLED UP TO HER RESIDENCE IN MUSTANG, BUT DID NOT LEAVE CAR, MERELY HONKED HORN AND STEIN LEFT HER RESIDENCE.

LEE DESCRIBED GALT AS WHITE MALE, THIRTY TO THIRTYTHREE, FIVE FEET TEN INCHES, MEDIUM BUILD, LIGHT HAIR, LONG SKINNY NOSE. LEE ADVISED FRONT VIEW OF PHOTOGRAPH OF GALT TAKEN IN SIXTY THAT APPEARS ON IDENTIFICATION ORDERS AND WANTED FLYERS IS EXCELLENT LIKENESS AND PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN IN SIXTYEIGHT IN BARTENDERS SCHOOL IN LOS ANGELES DOES NOT RESEMBLE GALT. LEE ADVISED SHE KNEW OF NO OTHER TRIP MADE TO NEW ORLEANS BY RAY EXCEPT THE ONE IN DECEMBER SIXTYSEVEN.

RE INTERVIEW WITH HERBERT RODRIGUEZ, HIS SISTER, THERESA
STONE AND DALE RODRIGUEZ, HIS WIFE, ALL RESIDING FOUR ZERO

AND ALL HE COULD RECALL OF THE CONVERSATION WAS THE INDIVIDUAL ASKED RODRIGUEZ FOR HIS ADDRESS AND ADVISED HE WAS BRINGING A BOX. RODRIGUEZ STATED HE HAD JUST COME OFF A LONG ROAD TRIP PRIOR TO THE PHONE CALL AND WAS STILL "PUNCHY" FROM SAME. IT IS NOTED RODRIGUEZ IS AN EX-FIGHTER.(COULD NOT IDENTIFY PHOTOS OF RAY).

DALE RODRIGUEZ IN REINTERVIEW STATED BOTH SHE AND HER HUSBAND HAD GONE TO BED IN EITHER FEBRUARY OR MARCH NINETEEN SIXTYEIGHT, WHEN THEY RECEIVED KNOCK ON DOOR AND SHE ANSWERED THE DOOR, ACCEPTED A BOX, ASKED HOW MIMI WAS, STATES COULD NOT RECALL ANY CONVERSATION FROM THE MAN, DID NOT LET HIM IN HOUSE OR TURN ON LIGHTS. SHE RECALLED IT WAS WINDY AND RAINING THAT NIGHT. FURTHER, SHE BELIEVED INDIVIDUAL WITH BOX TO BE APPROXIMATELY FIVE FEET SEVEN INCHES AND COULD NOT IDENTIFY ANY PHOTOGRAPHS OF RAY. BOX STAYED AT HOUSE FOR APPROXIMATELY TWO DAYS AND WAS PICKED UP BY MRS. LORRAINE CALLOWAY, MOTHER OF HERBERT RODRIGUEZ. HERBERT AND DALE RODRIGUEZ HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF RAY'S TRIP TO NEW ORLEANS IN DECEMBER NINETEEN SIXTYSEVEN.

THERESA STONE ADVISED SHE SAW STEIN ON WHAT SHE BELIEVED WAS DECEMBER EIGHTEEN, SIXTYSEVEN IN FRONT OF RESIDENCE OF HER

COUSIN, MARIE LEE, WHO AT THAT TIME RESIDED IN FOURTEEN HUNDRED BLOCK OF BURGUNDY STREET. SHE STATED SHE HAD GONE THERE TO SEE CHARLIE STEIN. WHEN SHE WAS THERE STEIN RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL AND STEIN ASKED HER HOW BEST ROUTE FOR A PERSON TO GET TO THAT ADDRESS. SHE COULD NOT RECALL WHERE THE PERSON WAS COMING FROM. SHE STATED SHE RECALLED THIS DATE AS DECEMBER EIGHTEEN BECAUSE SHE WAS IN HURRY TO GO TO WORK AND IT WAS BETWEEN NINE AND TEN P.M. FURTHER, SHE DID NOT WORK ON SUNDAY OR TUESDAY NIGHTS. SHE ADVISED AS SHE WAS LEAVING SHE MET WHITE MALE ARRIVING AT HOUSE, INTRODUCED BY STEIN AND DOES NOT RECALL THE NAME AND WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL FROM PHOTOGRAPHS EXHIBITED TO HER OF RAY. At 1:30 P.M., 4/26/68, Superintendent WOOD, Wilcox Post Office, Hollywood, telephonically advised that one of their carriers had observed Wanted Flier 442-A on GALT and feels that he has a patron on his route who fits the description of W. C. HERRON, one of the aliases.

Mr. HENRY DANDINI, the carrier, advised that a man who presently resides at 824½ North Hudson fits perfectly the description of GALT on the wanted flier. He said this man has been living for some time on routes covered by the Wilcox Post Office. At one time he was at 830½ North Hudson, then disappeared for some time; then he was at 825 North Sycamore, and then 824½ North Hudson. DANDINI said he had last seen him at the 824½ North Hudson address about three or four months ago, but that he is still there.

DANDINI had particularly noted that this man received many papers and magazines on the subject of guns, one of which was from the U. S. Rifle Association.

184 lbs.; Brown full hair; blue eyes.



WILLIAM BAXTER recontacted the FBI and advised that the individual was no longer in the restaurant when his detectives arrived, but that they were able to ascertain he was blond headed with a very thin face and a receding hairline. He further advised that the individual had departed from the Small World Restaurant in a late model yellow Comero, California License Number VAE 962.

Hollywood Blonde Located

By LOUIS LOMAX

BEVERLY HILLS

(NANA) — In a startling new development, the hunt for the person or persons responsible for the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. now focuses on a mysterious Hollywood blonde and a New Orleans industrialist.

The FBI let it be known Monday that they were in search of the Hollywood blonde but could not locate her. The report was that she has "disappeared."

This reporter located the blonde in question late yesterday afternoon. She is in her mid twenties as reported and,

as suspected, was a close confidante of James Earl Ray, then known as Eric Starvo Galt and the suspected killer of Dr. King.

INVESTIGATION by this reporter revealed that the young woman was a habitue of the Sultan Room and the Rabbit's Foot, bars along a sleazy section of Hollywood Blvd. She used several names but was known as "Jerri."

She spent several nights, perhaps weeks, with Ray (Galt) and on the day Ray left Los Angeles on the trip that led him to Memphis he purchased "Jerri" an airplane ticket to a Midwestern city where she is now visiting with her parents. There is some evidence that Ray arranged to visit with the girl and her parents in the Midwestern city "after I take care of some business in the South." This was the way Ray explained his mission to the girl in question. The FBI's search for the girl still continues and there is no indication that the agency is aware of the girl's whereabouts.

"JERRI" IS important to the investigation because of her close relationship to Ray while he was in Los Angeles.

Ray (Galt) kept this quiet and, on the whole, remained to himself. However, "Jerri" was in his apartment on several protracted occasions and the conviction is that she may well have information about the various contacts Ray was known to have made in the South, particularly in New Orleans.

As important as "Jerri" is to the stalled investigation, she is overshadowed by additional information uncovered by this reporter about Ray's New Orleans contacts. These are the facts that can now be published:

—On Dec. 16, 1967, Ray was in telephone contact with a major New Orleans industrialist, a man who is considered the economic and political "killer" of the community.

—On Dec. 17, 1967, Ray met in person with this New Orleans industrialist. On the day of the meeting, Ray was registered in a motel in New Orleans. The contact between Ray and the industrialist was made from this motel and the meeting with held in "downtown" New Orleans.

Investigators are attempting to zero in on the "industrialist" in the light of a disclosure from an inmate out of Missouri Prison, where Ray once served time and where Ray expressed interest in an offer of \$100,000 put up by "Southern businessmen" for anyone who would kill Dr. King. This reporter has also been able to establish a timetable for Ray that leads up to a few days to Dr. King's assassination:

—On Valentine's Day, Ray, who was then living in Room 408 of the St. Francis Hotel along Hollywood Blvd., visited another girl friend — not the blonde — and offered his console TV set for her portable. The girl accepted the swap. Ray loaded her portable

set in his car and told the girl he was ~~leaving~~ town.

Although they are tight-lipped about it, the FBI has found the portable TV set, probably in a Birmingham, Ala., roominghouse.

—Ray was seen on this same day in the parking lot of the Los Angeles Sears, Roebuck store on Pico Blvd.

—Three days later, Ray called upon a New Orleans family and delivered to them a package sent by their daughter in Los Angeles. The already published record shows that Ray then drove into Alabama, finally, into Memphis.

The FBI is having major difficulty tracing both the elusive blonde and the New Orleans industrialist because the trail leads through denizens of the underworld and semi-underworld who flatly refused to cooperate with law enforcement officials. The name of the New Orleans industrialist is not known.

However, this reporter is aware of how the telephone contact between the industrialist and Ray was established. A search is now on to locate records which will reveal both the industrialist's name and telephone number.

Other information developed by this reporter indicated that "Jerri" spoke with a foreign accent and is probably from ~~one of~~ the Scandinavian countries.


