Mrs. MYRTLE WILLIAMS, 8351 Country Club Drive, Buena Park, California was interviewed by the writer on 4/29/68, at which time photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were presented to her. After reviewing the photographs, she advised that he person that she encountered at the Hollywood Racetrack on the evening of 4/19/68 did not resemble him. She stated that the individual she observed did appear however similar to one of the composite drawings she observed on television shortly after the KING assination. She stated that she also observed the same composite drawing in local papers, which prompted her to call the Los Angeles Division of the FBI.

In view of the fact that RAY does not appear to be identical with the individual that Mrs. WILLIAMS observed, it is recommended that no further investigation be conducted in this fa phase of the investigation, inasmuch as Mrs WILLIAMS did not obtain a license number of the vehicle nor could she furnish details of the vehicle she observed.

On 4/25/68 attempts to interview resident at 12064 Guerin Street, Studio City, were negative as no one was present at apartment.

On A/26/68 SAS THOMAS E. LAVIN and the writer contacted JOHN GUNDRY ROTH, 12064 Guerin Street. Studio City. California, telephone number 761 - 9301. After announcing to him the nature of the call, RUTH stated that he believed that the person who called was his ex-wife, HELEN YORK, 632 North Whitmall, Burbank. He stated he could not think of any man who would dislike him enough to make such a telephone call. He advised he had been divorced by HELEN YORK about six years ago and that she "took" him for about \$22,000 worth of property.

Upon being exhibited the W/F and I.O. photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT - JAMES EARL RAY, RUTH stated that he has never known or seen the person exhibited.

RUTH advised that he recalls hearing of the shooting of KING on the television. Shortly thereafter he walked down to the Alchoholics Anonymous just several blocks away to give them some clothing and books. He recalls speaking to a man about the shooting but was not aware of KING's death at the time. He stated that he departed the next morning for Lancaster, Pennsylvania due to a death in the family. He exhibited TWA ticket stub from LA to Pittsburg on flight 76Y on 4/5/68 with a transfer to Allegheny Airlines flight 322A on 4/588. He advised that he arrived on Tuesday, 4/23/68 from Pennsylvania in order that he could apply for his unemployment insurance. His aircraft ticket stub verified his flight on 4/23/68 from Pittsburgh.

RUTH advised that he had a LAPD record for burglary and wife beating and that upon a couple occasions was "rousted" by the LAPD.

He advised that he enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps in 1929 and served for 14 years. He said his serial number was 221276. SA LAVIN observed a bound scrap book indicating RUTH received the Silver Star for valor in the Pacific Theatre of Operations.

RUTH advised that he possess two old antique hand guns and also exhibited a .38 caliber Colt revolver in a holster and gun belt bearing about 30 rounds of ammunition in the belt. He claims he keeps it loaded by his bed for protection.

On 4/29/68 a clerk at the LAPD Records and Identification affirmed the fact that RUTH has a criminal record with that department and that it is available for perusal.

RUTH advised that about three years ago he had a nervous breakdown and entered Sawtelle Veterans Hospital for treatment.

A review of the files of the LA office reflects in serial 5μ -0-225 (5/61) that one JOHN G. RUTH, 630 3/ μ Los Palmas, L.A., on 5/18/61 attended a party whereby the complainant stated he claimed he wax had been running guns to Cuba and strongly indicated he was Pro-Castro. He was described as age μ 8, 5'll, heavy build, black hair, ruddy complexion.

RUTH admitted that he had lived at this residence and that he had been approached by persons at one time to send guns to Cuba but that he never did. RUTH stated that he also has a very big mouth when he is drinking and brags a great deal. He advised that this was one of his bad failings while drinking.

He advised that he is presently unemployed but usually works for MCM studio as a sound man on the film series "Daktari".

It is the opinion of interviewing agents that some male who made the telephone call to this office desired to "get even" or get him in some sort of trouble with the law. The physical evidence of the airline tickets places RUTH in Los Angeles on the morning of 4/5/68 and that he returned on 4/23/68.

Dr. R. FLEMING JONES was interviewed at his place of business, The Hollywood Medical Clinic, 1546 North Highland Boulevard, Los Angeles, California, on 4/26/68 by the writer.

After reviewing his medical admission cards, D. JONES advised that he could find no medical record of anyone having the name of JAMES EARL RAY, or any medical record under any name similar to any of the known aliases of RAY.

JONES stated that the most of his medical patients were known to him, at least if they were repeat clients. He added that approximately 130 persons were treated in the clinic daily, some of which merely walked off the street and requested aid.

JONES was shown photos of RAY, and stated that he could not recall ever seeing an individual similar to him. After consulting with associates in the clinic, and employees working for him, he advised that RAY was unknown to all persons of his staff.



Records, San Luis Obispo Sheriff's Office, as made available on April 25, 1968 by Records Clerk JEANNE PHILLIPS, contain the following information:

On September 10, 1967, R. B. HARRELL was booked into the San Luis Obispo County Jail by Officer WOODRUM, Pismo Beach, California, Police Department, on a charge of violation of Section 20002a, California Vehicle Code (Hit and Run). On September 11, 1967 in Justice Court, Grover City, California, HARRELL was sentenced to sixty days in the County Jail which was suspended for two years providing no involvement in like violations and HARRELL was to make restitution. According to San Luis Obispo Sheriff's Office records, HARRELL is described as follows:

HARRELL listed that he had lived in California for 15 years and had been in San Luis Obispo County one week when booked on September 10, 1967.

San Luis Obispo Sheriff's Office records contain bench warrant number A39442 issued October 4, 1967 for arrest of R. B. HARRELL for failure to comply with order of Justice Court, Grover City, California, where on September 11, 1967, he had been duly convicted and sentenced to make restitution to the victim in the matter. This warrant is still outstanding for HARRELL's arrest which has no bail set. On February 28, 1968, the San Luis Obispo Sheriff's Office placed a stop notice on HARRELL with Criminal Identification and Investigation (CII), Sacramento, California. San Luis Obispo Sheriff's Office requested that if HARRELL is located in California that local authorities be notified of above outstanding warrant for his arrest and that HARRELL be taken into custody.

AT PISMO BEACH, CALIFORNIA

On April 25, 1968, Mrs. TWILA EARLYWINE, Records Clerk, Pismo Beach Police Department (PBPD), advised that their records reveal that on September 10, 1967, R. B. HARRELL was placed under citizens arrest by HECTOR MARTINEZ, 1230 25th Street, Arroyo Grande, California, on a charge of violation of Section 20002 a California Vehicle Code (Hit and Run - Property damage) and booked into the San Luis Obispo County Jail.

PBPD was called to go to the Seaside Apartments, 172 Ocean View, Pismo Beach at about 8:10 p.m. on September 10, 1967, where a victim was holding a hit and run suspect. Upon arrival PBPD Officer found HARRELL and victim HECTOR MARTINEZ standing behind a 1965 Ford which had a damaged rear end. MARTINEZ said he had stopped at a stop sign about four blocks away and HARRELL, driving a pickup truck, struck the rear of MARTINEZ' vehicle whereupon HARRELL took off without stopping and hurriedly left the area and continued to this location where he lived.

MARTINEZ followed HARRELL to this address and called police. HARRELL denied having struck MARTINEZ' car, saying he would prove his pickup would not have done the damage to MARTINEZ' car. HARRELL claimed he pushed cars all the time with his pickup accounting for damage to his bumper. The bumper-grill of HARRELL's pickup was painted silver and there was silver paint on the back of MARTINEZ' car.

HARRELL appeared in Justice Court, Grover City, California, on September 11, 1967, plead guilty to the charge and was sentenced to sixty days in the County Jail which was suspended for two years if he had no like violations. HARRELL was ordered to pay MARTINEZ \$150.00 for cost of repairs to MARTINEZ' car at a rate of \$20.00 per week through the PBPD.

HARRELL failed to make any payments whatsoever. On October 4, 1967, Justice Court, Grover City, issued warrant number A39442 charging R. B. HARRELL with failure to comply with a court order. Efforts by the PBPD to locate HARRELL and serve this warrant were unsuccessful as he moved without leaving a forwarding address so the warrant was returned on November 21, 1967 to Central Warrant Clearing of the San Luis Obispo Sheriff's Office.

According to PBPD records, R. B. HARRELL had a 1949 Ford pickup truck, black and silver in color, California license V97983. HARRELL had California drivers license M124056. HARRELL lived at the Seaside Apartments with his wife, NADINE. His address prior to the one at the Seaside Apartments, Pismo Beach was Patterson Labor Camp, Patterson, California.

On April 25, 1968, Mr. and Mrs. FRANK COLE, Owners, Seaside Motel, 172 Ocean View, advised that their records reveal that NADINE HARRELL, Indio, California (no specific address listed) and four others registered at this motel on September 6, 1967. Their vehicle is listed as a 1949 Ford pickup with California license V97983. Further, these persons left this motel prior to their week's rent being up, apparently as the result of a hit and run incident in which Mr. (FNU) HARRELL was involved. The HARRELL's children consisted of an older girl the COLEs estimated to be a ninth or tenth grader and two younger children at least one of which was a boyd. The smaller children would have been third or fourth graders. Mr. and Mrs. COLE stated that the oldest girl was constantly smoking cigarettes and Mrs. COLE kept inquiring of the HARRELL's if they were going to enroll the children in school.. Mr. and Mrs. COLE do not know whether or not the HARRELL children were ever enrolled in school in this area. One of the younger children told Mr. COLE that when the HARRELL's were leaving they were going to Grover City, California, and Mrs. HARRELL was going to do babysitting. The HARRELLs claimed they could not send their children to school since they had no suitable clothing. Mr. and Mrs. COLE recall that at about the time of the hit and run incident in which Mr. HARRELL was involved, both Mr. and Mrs. HARRELL had been drinking. Mr. and Mrs. COLE advised that they have not seen or heard of the HARRELL's since the HARRELL's moved from this motel less than a week after moving in to the motel.

On April 25, 1968, Mr. GEORGE CHILDRESS, Super-intendent, Lucia Mar School District, advised that as of October 19,1967 there was no child with the last name of HARRELL enrolled in any of the public schools in this district which district is comprised of all public schools in the entire area including Pismo Beach, Grover City, Arroyo Grande, Shell Beach, and other areas.

On April 25, 1968, Patrolman RALPH HALLMARK, Pismo Beach Police Department advised that officers of this department located HECTOR MARTINEZ, victim of the hit and run accident caused by R. B. HARRHLL at MARTINEZ' present residence, 1313 19th Street, Oceano, California. HALLMARK edvised that MARTINEZ stated he has not seen or heard from HARRELL since the accident in September, 1967.

AT GROVER CITY, CALIFORNIA

On April 25, 1968, Patrolman TOM BOWLES, Grover City Police Department, advised that he can locate no identifiable record of RICHARD B. HARRELL, his wife, NADINE HARRELL, nor any youngsters who appear to be children of RICHARD and/or NADINE HARRELL. He stated that their department does have a record for curfew violation on one ROBIN SUE HARRELL, white, female, born whose father is JAMES RUSSELL HARRELL, mother is DORIS WARD HARRELL, residence 635 East Williams, Santa Maria, California, who does not appear to have any relationship to RICHARD B. and/or NADINE HARRELL.

The investigator asked BRADLEY if he had been associated with JAMES EARL RAY and BRADLEY replied he never had but he recalled that one CAROL AYDELOTTE used to refer to her boyfriend "RAY" and BRADLEY had no definite information to indicate this alleged boyfriend would have been identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

Officer AIKEN stated that in their LAPD Intelligence files they have one reference to CAROL AYDELOTTE indicating that on 2/23/65, she was residing at 6542 Fulton Avenue, Van Nuys, was age 27, and was at that time married to ARTHUR AYDELOTTE who had the reputation of being an extreme "right winger" and possible member of the American Nazi Party.

He said he recalled there were two men in the bar that night sitting next to an individual who was in conversation with a Mexican girl named ROSA and that when this unknown male, who in his opinion did not resemble suspect in any way, left the bar, the other two males, whom he described as "happy" began a conversation with the female named ROSA during which they discussed the possibility that the unknown male who had left the bar could possibly be identical with suspect. KENNEDY said ROSA is not a regular patron of the bar, he does not have her last name nor does he know where she resides or is employed.
