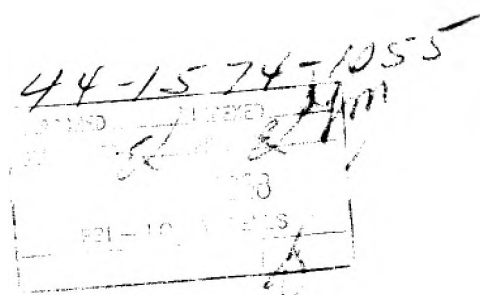

On 4/18/68, GLEN REDDICK, 2850 Union Street, Rialto, California, advised that he met an individual using the name PETE MADISON, who is the brother of EDWARD MADISON, who resides at 2707 West Second Street, Rialto, California. He stated this individual, PETE MADISON, looks like JAMES EARL RAY.

On 4/18/68, EDWARD MADISON, 2707 West Second Street, Rialto, California, advised that his brother, PETE MADISON, age 47, 5'11", 160 pounds, is currently in Bakersfield, California, attempting to obtain employment as a carpenter. EDWARD MADISON stated that his brother, PETE, arrived at his residence from Long Island, New York, on 3/22/68 and remained at this residence until 4:00 a.m., 4/18/68. He further advised that PETER MADISON was in the U. S. Navy during World War II and that he is not identical in appearance to JAMES EARL RAY. He exhibited photograph of his brother. This indicates that his brother is not similar in appearance to RAY and also wears a moustache. Since he was at this trailer park 3/29/68, he could not be identical with individual involved in the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Mr. R. S. KNOWLTON, 428 West Regent, Inglewood, California, was interviewed at which time he furnished the following information:

Mr. KNOWLTON said that on the day of the funeral of MARTIN LUTHER KING, he had returned home from Palm Springs, California, and had observed a gray Corvette convertible having Texas License Plates LRZ 756, parked on the street near his residence. He said he observed that this vehicle had a small black flag on the antenna for two or three days after this. KNOWLTON said that on 4/26/68, he observed that this vehicle now had Oklahoma License KK 3051. KNOWLTON said that he had observed a white male who apparently lived in the Page Apartments across the street enter this vehicle.

After viewing photographs of JAMES EARL RAY on wanted flier Number 442-A, Mr. KNOWLTON said that the individual he had observed in the car did not appear to be identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

Mrs. ALTA PAGE, 425 West Regent, Inglewood, California, manager of the apartments at this address, informed that the owner of the 1966 Corvette sting-ray apparently was Mr. and Mrs. RUSSELL CONNER who have resided in Apartment 7 at this address since February, 1968.

Mrs. PAGE stated that the CONNERS have two automobiles, one of which is a 1961 or 1962 blue Chevrolet convertible which had Georgia license plates. Mrs. PAGE said that she really knew very little about the CONNERS but recalled that when they rented the apartment, Mr. CONNER indicated that he had been sent out here by some company to go to school and Mrs. CONNER apparently intended to obtain a secretarial position. She recalled that when the CONNERS moved to this address, they brought two Hondas with them and what furniture they had they had transported in a U-Haul rental trailer. She said that it was her understanding that the CONNERS had formerly resided in Atlanta, Georgia.

Mrs. PAGE, upon viewing wanted flier number 442-A said that she did not believe that CONNER could be identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

On 5/1/68, Mr. FURMAN RUSSELL CONNER, Apartment 7, 425 West Regent, Inglewood, was interviewed by Detective ROBERT DANNAKER and the writer.

Mr. CONNER informed that he and his wife had been living at Marietta, Georgia, where he had worked for the Astro - Data Corporation, but he said that he had been laid-off on 12/4/67. Mr. CONNER advised that with the assistance of a friend, he obtained a position with the Scientific Data System which company sent him to Dallas, where he worked for two months. CONNER advised that while in Dallas, Texas, he purchased a 1966 Chevrolet Corvette sting-ray from Steakley Motors and in this connection he exhibited a transfer registration receipt showing that he had purchased this car on 2/6/68. The VIN of the sting-ray was listed as 194676S114935 and a lienholder was listed as the Scientific Data System Employees Credit Union, El Segundo, California.

It is noted that Mr. CONNER explained the reason he had switched the license plates on the Corvette from Texas to Oklahoma License was due to the fact that he would be leaving California in a few weeks to go to Ponca City, Oklahoma to work for Scientific Data Systems. He said that it was cheaper for him to register his automobiles in Oklahoma than in California and this was the reason he had recently changed the license plates on his cars.

On the basis of visual observation and physical description, CONNER was eliminated as being identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

KLEIN further advised that this vehicle contains a bumper sticker bearing the words "Where is Galt", which sticker has been on the vehicle for over a year and refers to the fictional character of JOHN GALT in ANN RYND's book *"Atlas Shrugged."* It is noted that KLEIN is the son of SAM KLEIN, INS, Los Angeles, and only slightly resembles JAMES EARL RAY.

On 5/1/68 Mrs. DALL HYMAN, 5612 Harold Way, Hollywood, California was contacted and advised that the individual whom she saw at her apartments did not at all resemble the recent photographs of EARL RAY, i.e., JAMES EARL RAY. Mrs. HYMAN stated that she saw a photo of RAY in TIME magazine which was taken fifteen years ago (1952) and thought that this photo somewhat resembled the man she saw at her door, who was applying for a room to let. Three current photos of JAMES EARL RAY were exhibited to Mrs. HYMAN and she stated that the man who appeared at her door was much younger than that depicted as RAY in the photos shown to her. Mrs. HYMAN said that the man had a full head of hair, was slender, weighing about 150 lbs and was about her (Mrs. HYMAN's) height. RAY's receding hairline was pointed out to Mrs. HYMAN and she stated that the man who appeared at her door seemed to have a full head of hair. Mrs. HYMAN is 5'8".

In view of the above facts no further investigation seems indicated in this matter.

ADDITION: In addition to the above the (C) Mrs. HYMAN stated that she was not cert in of the license of the car that the individual was driving and did not know the make of the vehicle.

Reference is made to memorandum for SAC of SA William J. Pettit, dated 5-3-68.

Rememo reflects that Jacob Wolfe, 1602 S. Myrtle Avenue, Monrovia, Calif. wanted to see pictures of James Earl Ray.

On 5-4-68, Jacob Wolfe, 1143 Florendale Dr., Duarte, Calif., telephone 358-6346 advised that he is employed as a mechanic at Glancy Union Service Station, 1602 S. Myrtle Ave., Monrovia. He advised that on 5-3-68, after lunch, about 2:00PM, he observed a 1961 or 1962 grey Mercury convertible with a dirty white top standing on the premises of the station. The vehicle definitely had a Florida license, number unknown and top rear on the passenger side had a square patch glued or ironed on. The patch was over the rear window.

There were two occupants of the car but Wolfe spoke with the driver. The driver asked for a map of the United States. Wolfe told him he had a map of Southwest U. S. and the man said that would probably have a small map of the U.S. The driver said he was going to Florida and to Oklahoma City, Okla. He wanted to know if Route 66 went to Oklahoma City. He was going to Oklahoma City enroute to Florida. He asked for Route 66 and Wolfe told him where it was. They made no purchase and drove off in a northerly direction which would be the way to reach Route 66. Wolfe said no other persons spoke to them at the station. Wolfe said he did not know the men's names, address or where they were from. He said he had never seen them previously. Wolfe described the driver as follows:

Wolfe advised that both persons were clean in dress and both were clean shaven; that he has no idea how to reach them. He advised that Ralph Glancy, owner of the service station, might have seen the couple, but he believed that Glancy was not there at the time.

The Wanted Notice re Ray as well as the Ray picture with a lamp in the background ^{was exhibited} Wolfe said that the 1968 picture on the notice is similar to the driver; that if Ray had brown eyes, they would look alike. He said that he "would almost swear he (the driver) had brown eyes. He said he was almost certain the driver had brown eyes. Wolfe advised that the passenger in the car was definitely not Ray.

Ralph Glancy was also interviewed at the station on 5-4-68. He was shown the Wanted Notice and the picture above mentioned, but he said he had not seen Ray. Glancy was informed of the information furnished by Wolfe and the time of occurrence but he said he cannot recall the incident and may have been out to lunch at the time.

The following investigation was conducted on May 1, 1968 by SA JAMES MC CAULEY.

MRS. CELEDIA FREDERICO, 10058 Willis Ave., telephone 894-3810 was interviewed where she is employed as a ~~manila~~ maid at the Carriage Inn Motel, 5525 Sepulveda Blvd. She said the man she had thought resembled the 1968 photograph of subject had stayed in Room 225 for about a week prior to several days ago. She had not observed any car. She recalled him as very polite. She advised that other photos of subject did not resemble the man, in her opinion.

TONI PUTNAM, room clerk, made available registration cards showing that Room 225 had been occupied recently on a nightly basis with different guests, except for the period of ~~MEMPHIS~~ 4/21-27/68 when it was occupied by R. BUCKLEY. On the registration card information was set forth by the guest (BUCKLEY) in hand printing, showing residence address as 10002 Des Moines Way South, Seattle, Wash. He had no car. His business connection was shown to be Boeing Co., P.O. Box 707, Renton, Wash. The original room reservation was made on 4-21-68 by MRS. STEWART, purportedly of the Boeing Co. MISS PUTNAM said that she was the one who checked BUCKLEY in, but couldn't recall him. She could suggest no one else who might have observed him except the maid.

Inasmuch as it is quite possible that the fact that the FBI was conducting an investigation at the "Free Press" where some evidence concerning GALT was located might appear in the next publication of this paper, along with Agent's pictures, this memo is being submitted for information.

ANTOINETTE ISAAC was interviewed at the Playboy Club, 8560 Sunset Blvd., Hollywood, Calif. by SA's Richard H. Ross and David R. Pender. ISAAC advised that her home address is 1010 N. Madison, Hollywood. She advised that she observed an individual on 4/30/68 about 10:30PM at 1010 N. Madison, an apartment building, who appeared similar to JAMES EARL RAY.

She advised that the individual knocked at the front door of the apartment building and requested to be let in. She advised that the door is locked at 10:00 pm and only residents with keys can get in. ISAAC advised that since her apartment is near the front door she heard the person calling out and knocking. She advised that she let the person in because he said that he had just moved in and left his key in his apartment. ISAAC advised that this was when she noted the similarity of the individual to RAY.

She described the individual as follows.

W/M, 5'10", reddish hair (crew cut), square face, ruddy complexion, very broad shoulders, wearing dark suit, dark socks carrying suit case and shaving kit.

ISAAC observed photos of RAY and advised that after seeing photograph she was doubtful of similarity of the unknown individual, to RAY.

ON 5/1/68, Mrs. RUTH MARILYN SMITH, MANAGER, 1010 N. Madison advised that ANTOINETTE ISAAC resided at the apartments. SMITH advised that ISAAC was very imaginative and made numerous complaints while living in building. She advised that the individual ISAAC described is the husband of Carline Van Horne, a resident of the apartment. She advised that Mr. Van Horne had recently joined his wife, in that he had returned from Europe where he had been in the Service. Mrs. SMITH observed photos of JAMES EARL RAY and advised they were not identical to Van Horne.

Re memo of SA JAMES M. KELLOGG, dated 4/22/68 at Los Angeles.

Mr. LAWRENCE ALLEN, 14052 McClure Avenue, Paramount, California was interviewed by the writer and SA E. RHEAD RICHARDS on 4/30/68, at which time he advised as follows:

He stated that on 4/14/68 he picked up a hitch hiker in Tucumcari, New Mexico, and brought him to the Los Angeles Area, arriving in Los Angeles on 4/15/68.

He described the hitch hiker as a white male, 5'8"-5'9" in height, weighing 170 lbs. He stated that the hitch hiker had brown wavy hair, which was worn long. He was wearing wash and wear slacks. The hitch-hiker advised him that his automobile experienced mechanical difficulty in Tucumcari, and that he had to hitch hike to Los Angeles where he expected to find a job. ALLEN stated that he let the hitch hiker out of his car in the Lancaster area, and the man purchased a bus ticket to Los Angeles at the Greyhound bus station.

Allen described the hitch hiker as a personable sort of person, who was an easy conversationalist. He told ALLEN that he at one time was in the U.S. Army, stationed in Germany. He had a cardboard box in his possession that contained his changes of clothing. He also gave ALLEN approximately 30 rounds of 30-30 ammunition.

The ammunition was examined and found to be armor piercing ammunition, with a black USA color code. He also gave ALLEN several M-1 rifle clips.

ALLEN stated that he obtained some 8 mm movie photos of the hitch hiker. He was shown photos of JAMES EARL RAY, and advised that he did not believe that the hitch hiker was identical with him. He was given a photograph of RAY to compare with the hitch hiker's photo, when the film was processed. ALLEN stated that he would call the writer if the photos he made appeared to be similar with RAY.

In view of the above, it not felt that the hitch hiker was in fact RAY. It is recommended that no further investigation be conducted in this phase of the MURKIN matter

On 4/29/68, VIC SHELTERS, Truck Salesman, Mack Trucks Incorporated, was interviewed by the writer at his place of employment, 2001 South Alameda, Los Angeles, California.

SHELTERS stated that on 4/19/68, during the early evening hours, possibly 6:00 PM he picked up a hitch hiker in the Newhall area on Old Balboa Road. He stated that he let the hitch hiker out at the Castaig Junction on the Bakersfield Highway.

While riding with the hitch hiker he was told by the hitch hiker that he was going to Coffeerville, state unknown, and that he was a "jack of all trades". He described the hitch hiker as a white male, 150-160 lbs, blond hair, wearing old clothing.

SHELTERS was shown photographs of JAMES EARL GALT, at which time he advised that he did not appear to be identical with the hitch hiker above described that he picked up on the evening of 4/19/68.

SHELTERS stated that the only reason that he contacted the FBI in this matter was that he felt at the time that there were inconsistencies in the hitch hikers story, and in view of the ~~recent~~ recent death of MARTIN LUTHER KING' thaought that there might possibly be a connection with RAY and the hitch hiker.

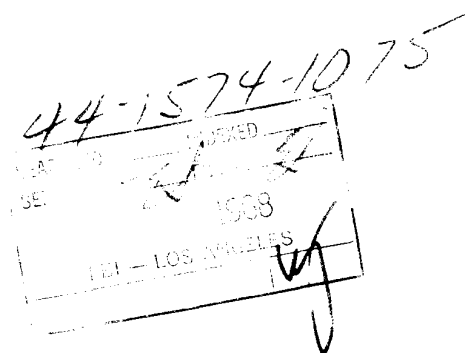
