

It was pointed out that we cound not have any part of such a scheme, that our files are confidential and we could not discuss what Stine had or had not said, and that he was strictly on his own in any such venture.

Re Serial 44-1574-877 re person seen at 1537 Palm (city not named) who resembled Ray per report.

The following intestigation was conducted by SA Albert X. Carlblom on 5-2-68:

George L. Brown, 1351 East Vernon, Los Angeles, Calif. advised that he is a rubbish collector. He works for Sen Gabriel Disposal Co. He said that the person hereported to the FBI in this matter was seen in the ground floor spartment at 1537 Palm Ave., San Gabriel, Calif.; that the apartment concerned is in the front and has on the outside wall the working "Royal Palms". He said that it might bear letter "A".

Brown saidthat on Thursday, April 18, 1968, as he placed the date, he was at the abovelocation and saw a man in that apartment not seen before nor since. This man was described as being white race, 5'10 or 11", about 39-40 years old, 160-165 lbs., He had large ears that stuck out from his head. He had large, sunken appearing eyes. He was pulling his left ear with his left hand. This personwas seen in that apartment which is the manager's apartment The manwas seen to leave the apt. Via the southdoor, walk to the front of the premises and then enter the apt through the north front) entrance. Brown said he spoke to the present manager on 4-25th and the manager is not the man seen in the apartment through the window and also outside. He, Brown, mentioned this resemblance to a motorcycle officer of the San Gabriel PD on that same "hursday. Brown said the man reembled the 1968 photo of Ray when the writer showed him the Ray Wamted Notice. Brown said that also seen in the apartment at that time was a woman who stepped back. He said the apartment involved might be letter "A" rather than #1.

On the rubbish truck with Brown at time of interview was Augusta Bryant. He advised that he also saw the man at the apartment and vicinity as mentioned by Brown; that the man was white, about 5'10" o or 11", about 40 years of age, about 165-170 lbs. This man's ears stuck out from his head. There was a white woman also seen in the apartment but a good look was not obtained of here. The man's hair was black or dark brown and was rather stubby and rather stuck-up. When shown the Wanted Notice of Ray, Bryant said that the man favored the 1968 photo of Ray. He recalled this occurence as about April 18th. He had not seen the man previously. Bryant said he and Brown talked to the present manager on April 25, 1968 and the manager said he had been there the week before. Bryant said this manager is not the (1)

man observed at the window. He said that the apartment was letter A rat rather than #1.

An inquiry on 5-2-68 at Apt. B, 1533 Palm Ave., resulted in a woman, name unknown, saying that the manager for the premises at 1537 Palm Ave., had been manager since "prill, 1968. The "pt. A is located in the front and bears "Royal Palms" on its outer wall.

Mr. and Mrs. William L. Faution, Apt. A., 1537 Palm Ave., advised on 5-2-68 that they manage the premises at this address and have done so since "pril 1, 1968. They said that all apartments a relettered and do not bear numbers. The Wanted Notice of "ay was exhibited to them and neither could identify anyone from it. They said that tanants do come into their apt. but they would not go through the house. They said that they are the only occupants of the apt. along with their 14 years old son who is a blond boy with brown eyes about 5' 9 or 10". They thought that this matter might involve a reference to their son, J.Paul Prayton, 9275 Rio Tale, "osemead, Calif. telephone 444-5735, who was born in Texas on they said that this son visits their apartment occasionally and his wife also; that this son has used the back door (the one on the South). They said this son has blue eyes, is 5'll" or 6', hasdark hair and rather large ears. They didnot know if he was at the apt. on 4-18-68. They said they had no other suggestions asto the identity of the man seen. They said this son has lived in the Los "ngeles area for about the last five years and has worked for G. and H. Auto, 1673 W. Valley, "Thambra, Calif. allthat time.

J. Paul Praytor, 9275 Rio Dele, Rosemead, Calif. advised on 5-2-68 that he hasbeen in this area since coming from Texas about 42 years ago. He said that he has been employed during that period, and is still employed, at G. and H. Auto Parts doing counter sales work. He exhibited a driver's license (Calif. P 675537) which reflected that Jay Paul Praytor, 418 North New Ave., Apt. C, Monterey Park, Calif. wasborn he had brown hair and green eyes per the license. Also was shown as 6' and 160 lbs. When interviewed he said he was born on he is white. Examination of his fingerprints eliminated him as identical with Ray.

Referenced Butel reads as follows:

During automobile trip of subject RAY and CHARLES STEIN departing Los Angeles on 12/15/67 and arriving New Orleans on 12/17/67, subject RAY made about six telephone calls from various pay stations in Texas.

They traveled via automobile on Interstate 10 through El Paso to Van Horn, Texas, and went south on Route 90 to San Antonio, then Route 90 or Interstate 10 to Houston, Texas, and to New Orleans.

Each office should check with telephone company and determine the long distance calls placed at each public telephone on the above mentioned routes during period of 12/15, 16, and 17, 1967, and have each call checked out.

On 4/30/68, Mrs. HELEN ORNELAS, Service Representative, West Texas Telephone Company, Pecos, Texas, made available duplicate bills on pay stations from Van Horn, Valentine, and Sierra Blanca, Texas.

Noted that these bills reflect the telephone numbers of the individuals receiving the telephone calls from the pay stations in the above mentioned communities. As noted above, the pertinent dates are 12/15, 16, and 17/67. The teletype codes of the respective offices have been added to these duplicate bills, indicating the telephone numbers to be checked out by the various offices receiving this airtel.
