On 5/6/68, Mrs. IRMA PICKERING, 12871 Safford, Garden Grove, California, advised that she is employed by Wanda's Dress Shop in Garden Grove. She advised that on Friday afternoon, April 19, 1968, a white male came into her dress shop and purchased three items of black lingerie. She stated that this man did not check the sizes of the items he purchased, and his actions scared her to the point that she almost rang an alarm bell. She advised that she believed the man was hiding from someone, and was attempting to obtain a disguise.

Mrs. PICKERING advised that the man's hair was either blond or light brown, was medium length, and was messed. She stated that he did not speak with any noticeable accent, and she did not notice the color of his eyes. She further described this man as being caucasian, 27-32 years, and exverage in height and build.

Mrs. PICKERING observed two recent photos of JAMES EARL RAY. She advised that RAY was not the man she sawrin the store. She advised she originally observed a photograph in the newspaper, and this photo was reported to be eight years old. She stated that the older photograph bore a strong resemblance to the man who came into the dress shop, but this man is not identical to the recent photographs of RAY.

Mary Willard, 95 Diabalo St., Ramon Trailor Park, Palm Springs, California was interviewed 6/2/68 and she said she was quite upset that the man charged with the killing of MARTIN L. KING would select the name John Willard, which was the name of her deceased husband, and is an old and honored American name. She said she is a naturalized citizen from Canada, 69 years of age, and intends to spend the summer in Canada and is fearful that she may be stopped at the border and be suspected of being the wife of the man who killed King.

Mrs Willard said that when she and her husband owned and rented property in Los Angeles in 1952, two men came and wanted to rent. She has been thinking about that situtation and thinks one of these men could be RAY who at that time found out her husbands name was JOHN WILLARD and thereafter used the name in Memphis.

Mrs. Willard did not appear to be completely rational in her reasoning or conservation.

On 5/6/68, JCE BROWN, Owner, Evans Motel, 4635 East Slauson Ave., Maywood, California, advised that on the afternoon of 4/18/68 he rented one of his rooms to an individual who resembled a newspaper photograph of MARTIN LUTHER KING'S killer. He advised that this han checked in with a woman and he observed both of them carry some kind of pans into their room. He advised that they stayed in their room for the remainder of the day, and he did not see this man until the following morning.

BROWN advised that he went to their room the following morning to collect that day's rent. He stated that the man came to the door with only a pair of pants on, and appeared very groggy. He advised that it appeared the man had been drunk or used drugs, but he could not smell or see any evidence of this. He advised that this man gave him seven dollar bills for that day's rent. He advised that he did not see the woman in the room at that time, and did not see either of them for the remainder of the day or night. He stated that this man gave him seven dollars the following morning, but this time only put his hand through the door, and did not show himself.

BROWN advised that this man and woman checked out that afternoon and he examined their room. He stated that he found two empty beer cans, a rack of short-play records, and noticed that all the furniture in the room had been pushed into the area of one corner. Examination of these records showed them to be of the rock and roll variety.

BROWN described the individual as white, male, mid-thirties, dark hair which was disheveled, blue eyes, a small scar on his forehead, medium build. He advised that this man did not speak with any sort of accent. He also advised that the man was very poorly dressed in wrinkled clothing. He observed two recent photos of JAMES EARL RAY and advised RAY is not identical to the man at his motel. He advised that the contour of RAY State is much different from the individual at signetemotel.

He recalled WASHINGTON as being a Negro male, who dated white women, and who was employed at the Kaiser Foundation Hospital.

DOROTHY GORELICK, Clerk, Kaiser Foundation Clinic Personnel Office, advised that she had determined from LOIS WADE, who is employed at the hospital's cafeteria, that WACHINGTON owns his own maintenance company, is not employed at the hospital, and resides in Santa Monica, California.

Mrs. LOIS WADE, Manager, Kaiser Roundation Hospital Cafeteria, 4867 Sunset Blvd., advised that she is the Becratary-Tressurer of the hospital's bowling league, and that WASHINGTON is a member of this league. WASHINGTON owns his own maintenance company and resides at 1934 E. 19th St., Santa Monica, California.

Attempts to locate WASHINGTON at the above-address were negative, and a message to him to call the FBI Office was left in the mailbox of Apartment 3 at that address.

The individual at Apartment 23, 16219 Eucalyptus, was determined to be ROBERT ERNEST EMBLETON. EMBLETON was interviewed on 4/24/68 by SA STEPHEN L. DURKIN. EMBLETON is not and does not in any way resemble the subject, JAMES EARL RAY.

Mrs. THEODORE L. EVANS, \$295 Don Carlos Drive, Los Angeles, CHITOPHIA, WAS INTERVIEWED on \$1/26/68 by SA's WALTER M. BRADY and GILBERT G. HEMJAMIN, JR. At the outset of the interview Mrs. EVANS, who stated she was also known as DOLORES EVANS and DODIE EVANS, was advised that the reason for interview was in connection with the investigation into the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., on \$1/5/68 at Memphis, Tennessee.

Mrs. EVAIS stated that she would be more than happy to cooperate with the FBI regarding this investigation. Mrs. EVANS stated that she has followed this case in the news media and admires the long hours and intensive effort the FBI has been devoting to this particular case. She also expressed her thanks to the FBI and its personnel for other investigations conducted in the civil rights field.

Mrs. EVANS stated that she first met Dr. KING in 1961. She said he had performed the wedding ceremony for a member of her family in Newark, New Jersey. She said that her friendship with Dr. KING had been a close and intimate one, explaining that she felt and has always credited him with saving her marriage to Dr. THEODORE EVANS. Mrs. EVANS continued that this close relationship with Dr. KING was also shared by her husband and other members of her family. She related that frequently when Dr. KING was attending to business matters on the west coast, including guest preaching engagements, she would see

him, indicating that these meetings were a family type gettogether.

Mrm. EVANS stated that she had absolutely no idea as to any person who would have wanted to kill Dr. KING, nor could she imagine why anyone would have wanted to kill him or have him killed. She stated that if any information of such a nature should come to her attention, she would immediately notify the FBI.

Mrs. EVANS stated that she frequently watches the Sunday evening television program, "The PBI", as she considers it one of the better television programs being aired locally. She said she was glad that the personal appearance of the interviewing agents had not shattered the mental image she had built up regarding Special Agents of the PBI. She said she also appreciated the great strides forward the PBI had made in professionalizing local law enforcement through its training programs and its scrupulous protection of the rights of the individual.

Mrs. EVANS volunteered the information that she and her husband had placed their home with a real estate broker, hoping for an early sale, as they feared for the life of their infant daughter. Mrs. EVANS explained that on two occasions recently she had "fished" her daughter out of their backyard swimming pool, which is very close to the sliding glass back door of their home. She indicated that she and her husband were afraid that the little girl would some day climb into the swimming pool when either they themselves or a baby sitter was not on the scene, and that the baby would drown.

On the date of interview several attempts were made to contact Mrs. EVANS for appointment for interview. Since she was not able to be reached, contact was made with her husband, Dr. THEODORE L. EVANS. He stated he would have no objections to the FBI interviewing his wife. He stated he felt she should be at home later in the day, and he would appreciate being advised at the termination of such interview.

Mrs. EVANS was eventually contacted during the late afternoon of $\frac{\mu}{26/68}$ at her residence. During the course of the interview there were numerous interruptions created by her

daughter, age approximately 3 years, running about the room. There were further interruptions by her maid regarding plans for the dinner menu and by a female house guest passing through the room.

At the conclusion of the interview Mrs. EVANS telephonically contacted her husband at his effice, at which time the interviewing agents advised him that his wife had been interviewed and the interview terminated.

Numerous opportunities were given Mrs. EVANS to expand on the nature of her personal relationship with Dr. KING, but on each such occasion she changed the subject to another topic. As the ultimate goal was to determine if she had any suspects in the killing of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, it did not seem prudent at this time, under the circumstances and with the lack of security, to push her for details regarding the intimate relationship she and Dr. KING maintained.

Through personal observation of the interviewing agents, the following physical description of Mrs. EVAES was obtained:

SUBJECT:

Mr. JOHN ROVACK, television actor known as "Sheriff JOHN," who is a personal friend of the writer, called to advise that he is now at KTTV this date, 4/26/68, at 3:30 P.M., in connection with his television show.

He stated he had just been with JACK SCOTT, who is director of the "Truth and Consequences" show and recently SCOTT had been in various parts of the city shooting film. About two weeks ago he shot some film at Holfywood and Vine and in reviewing the film this date both ROVICK and SCOTT felt they saw a man resembling JAMES EARL RAY. SCOTT told ROVICK that this man crossed the intersection and when he, the stranger, saw he was being filmed he made a fast ninety degree turn and disappeared into the crowd immediately.

SCOTT and ROVICK both feel the man filmed is someone the FBI is interested in. He said the film is in the Film Screening Room of KTTV, Sunset and Van Ness Streets, telephone 462-7111 and invited the FBI to come out and review it. Mr. ROVICK will be leaving about 4:00 P.M., but Mr. SCOTT is at the above telephone, Ext. 461, or Stage A of the Truth and Consequences show.

On 4/26/68, the writer went to KTTV, met JACK SCOTT, and viewed the film in question. SCOTT stated that the film had been shot about two weeks earlier at the intersection of Hollywood and Vine, Los Angeles. He did not have a single frame exposure of the individual who he falt resembled RAY. He stated that his office would attempt to have a single frame enlarged and make this available to this office.

On 5/3/68, SCOTT contacted this office and advised that the above enlargement was ready and could be picket up at his office by the FBI. On that date, the writer picked up this enlargement and in the presence of SCOTT it was compared with the photograph of RAY which had earlier been obtained from the "Local Swingers". It was obvious that the photograph of RAY did not resemble the individual in the above enlargement. SCOTT agreed that there was no similarity at all.

SCOTT was thanked for his assistance and interest in the matter. The pnlargement made available from SCOTT is being placed in the A section of this file.

At 4/26/P.M. on 5/6/68 Lieutenant NORMAN HAMILTON, Homicide Division, LASO, telephonically advised that one of his men had received an anonymous telephone advising that JAMES EARL RAY has a friend by the name of GLEN PARKER who was presently at the WALLACE Headquarters in Bell Gardens, California. The WALLACE Headquarters is located at 7939 South Eastern Avenue, Bell Gardens, California, telephone number 927-1454.

On 5/7/58 the writer contacted Mr. GLENN PARKER, 6021 Gotham Avenue, Bell Gardens, telephone number 927-090, at the above listed headquarters. He was exhibited all the photos available of JAMES EARL RAY, aka. John Willard, Harvey Lowmyer and Eric Starvo Galt. He advised that he has never observed the person in the photographs nor do the names listed mean anything to him.

PARKER advised that the North Hollywood Office of the Wallace Headquarters opened about the last week of October, 1967 and was closed down about January 3, 1968 after enough registrations had been obtained to place WALLACE's name on the California ballot. PARKER furnished the following names of persons whom he knew to have been associated with the office in North Hollywood:

EMMETT EATON, CHARLES THOMPSON, COY SMITH, PIERRE PELMAM and (FNU) HOLIFIELD. He advised the aforementioned persons were all out here from Alabama. He said that Mrs. OPAL WHITE, BEATRICE NICOLA, CHARLES PITCHFORD and (FNU) MC BRIDE were all persons who reside in the Valley and served as office help.

Mr. PARKER further added that he had traveled to Parkersburg, West Virginia on 3/31/68 and returned to Los Angeles on 5/2/68. He advised that he helped operate the Parkersburg campaign office while there. He advised he was in Parkersburg at the time MARTIN LUTHER KING was assassinated and has subsequently observed the photograph of RAY in serveral magazines and newspaper. He concluded by reiterating that he could not identify the photographs nor did any of the four names utilized by RAY mean anything to him.

On 4/25/68 VINCENT JAMES/FIRFARO was interviewed by SA's ROBERT H. CLAUDIUS and EUGENE B. McCARTHY at Los Angeles County Jail where FURFARO is incargerated for bookmaking.

FURFARO advised that he knows JAMES EARL RAY as JAMES RAY and stated that RAY told him he has used the name LOWMYER (FNU). FURFARO advised that he met RAY around May of 1967 In Los Angeles while playing pool at West 6th and Union in the Tayern Bar, the Shanty Bar and the Tiki Bar.

FURFARO advised that he was arrested on January 30th 1968 in front of these bars at about 9am. He advised that at this time he had just talked to RAY on the street and Ray said he was tond bar in some beach community but FURFARO could not give any information on where this beach community might be located. He also stated RAY mentioned that he worked tending bar in a place around Hollywood possibly a club. He drinks screwdrivers and beer.

FURFARO advised that he knew RAW around the taverns about 8 months and never knew where he lived whether he owned a car or had a girl friend or any other information about him. He advised RAY was never seen in the company of anyone male or female and was n never seen in a car. FURARO advised that in one of there conversation RAY mentioned he was going home to Missouri and then to TExas for an unknown period and purposh. At that time from Texas he would return to the beach area. He never expressed and hatreds or bigotry and never discussed racial matters. Never talked about girls and in fact FURARO only knew him to play pool with and nothing about the man.

FURFARO advised that the Photo on left of wanted poster looks mostly like RAY.
