He said that the individual in the photographs does appear similar to the individual that he observed on 4/20/68, with RUTH WILLIAMS. He said that this individual went into the second door of the Midnight Mission located at 396 South Ios Angeles Street, Ios Angeles. MITTWER said that he has not seen this individual subsequent to 4/20/68.

ALFRED G. MORRIS, Clerk, California State

photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and asked if these appear
similar to any individual with whom he has had recent

immediately if he sees any individual coming into that State
Employment Agency fitting the description of JAMES EARL RAY.

He said that no individual identical to RAY has been in the Rabbit's Foot Bar subsequent to RAY's departure in mid March 1968. He said, in particular, that no such person was in the bar on 4/19/68.

JAMES E. MORRISON, bartender, Rabbit's Foot Bar, 5623 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, said that he was familiar with the appearance of JAMES EARL RAY, aka Eric Starvo Galt, and that no such person has been in the Rabbit's Foot Bar subsequent to the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING and in particular on 4/19/68.





Mr. GLENN A. PLATZ, 722 South Broadway, Room 4, Santa Maria, California, visited the Santa Maria Resident Agency on 5/7/68, and stated that some time ago he wrote to the Post Office Department and advised that he had some information which might be of interest to the FBI in connection with the KING case.

Mr. PLATZ advised that he was employed for about two months in 1966 as a maintenance man at the Sovereign Hotel and Apartments, Santa Monica, California, but that he was unable to recall the exact dates of his employment. He stated that when he observed the name and photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT in the newspaper shortly after the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, it "rang a bell", and he feels sure that he saw GALT sometime in the past, and it was most likely at the Sovereign Hotel. However, that it was possible that he had seen GALT in Hollywood, or elsewhere in the Los Angeles area, since he remained in the Los Angeles area until the early part of 1967, when he moved to San Clemente, California.

Mr. PLATZ stated that he is aware that GALT has been identified as JANES HARL RAY, and that he would like to suggest the possibility that RAY has grown a beard and joined the "hippies", and is hiding out with the "hippies". Further that he had no additional information which he thought might be of interest to the FBI.

LARSON told her that the correct spelling of the uncle's last name is JACKIE WRAY, and that this man had been incarcerated in one of the midwestern state prisons. LARSON further advised MANN that this uncle died over ten years ago. MANN noted that she has told many of her friends about this uncle, and how at one time she thought his name was spelled JAMES RAY.

No further investigation re MANN and uncle is



Several photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were displayed to SCHOLTZHAUER at which time he advised he was unable to state that instant photos were identical with individual he saw driving a late model white Wildcat Buick on 5/7/68 along Victory Boulevard in Canoga Park. SCHOLTZHAUER explained that the license number he furnished when telephoning the FBI Office on 5/7/68 as Louisiana license number 96G-616 was not altogether correct. He further noted that he had written down the license number he observed on aforemention Buick, but that he had misplaced the piece of paper on which he had written the license number. He therefore pointed out he is not sure whether the license number 96G-616 is correct or not, noting that he furnished this number merely by memory.

In view of SCHLOTZHAUER being unable to identify photos of RAY as identical to person driwing above mentioned Buick, and fact he was unable to furnish correct license number of instant Buick, it is recommended that no further action be taken in this matter.

returned to MSP and served from 1962 to 1965. He advised that RAY came to MSP with a man by the name of RAY PRUITT. WADE stated that he and PRUITT were fall partners. He advised that both he and PRUITT were convicted at the same time but that PRUITT fought the conviction and did not enter MSP at the same time that he, WADE, did.

WADE advised that PRUITT and RAY may have met while both were in the City Jail in St. Louis, Missouri. WADE stated PRUITT knows RAY better than he does.

He advised that when PRUITT and RAY arrived at the penitentiary, that he, PRUITT and RAY all lived in "K Hall", and that because RAY and PRUITT were friends, he and his friends accepted the two of them and that PRUITT in effect, was RAY's sponsor. WADE advised that he and RAY worked in the bakery. WADE was a pastry cook and was fairly good.

WADE examined the photographs and drawings of RAY and stated that the drawing of RAY in which his eyes were open is not a good likeness in that it completely changes the appearance of RAY's eyes which are smaller and more slanted. WADE advised that his group in the prison consisted of the following individuals:

- (1) JAMES EARL RAY
- (2) RAY PRUITT
- (3) BOBBY BURNS
- (4) GLEN SHURNICK or SHERNICK (PH)
- (5) WADE

He advised that they, the five of them, had "a little thing going for them" in that they were selling amphetamine pills and other stimulants to inmates at the prison.

He stated that while he was confined to the penitentiary, that they had a semi-riot at the jail as prison authorities sought to integrate the prison and as a result, a few Negroes were stabled and that the jail was not integrated while he was there.

WADE stated, "I had a beef with a Negro over a debt about amphetamine powder. This beef was in 1962. I 'piped him', that is I hit him with a pipe a few times. He was hospitalized. This beef wasn't over RAY. This clique had a thing going for it."

He advised that he figures that they made about \$1,000 a month or more selling these pills each month. He advised they paid a guard \$100 to bring the jar in and after expenses, cleared about \$1,000 a month.

WADE stated that RAY is a very quiet individual. He stated he did not know what RAY's opinions were of Negroes.

He advised RAY had a friend who sent him some narcotics. He advised he did not know any more than this about that matter.

WADE advised that RAY was close-mouthed and never discussed anything with anyone, particularly he would not discuss any ideas or plans he had about escaping.

He described RAY as having a quick temper and a violent temper, but believed that RAY was in sufficient control of himself not to let his quick and violent temper unmask him. He said it was his opinion that if somebody got into an argument with RAY about something that RAY would control his emotions so as not to attract attention to himself, but he stated RAY was the type that would and could lay for the guy and later give him a good working over.

WADE stated, "I do not believe RAY would go to booze." He advised it was his belief that RAY liked narcotics but not hard stuff, and that he would probably just use the stimulant type. He advised that RAY could handle narcotics "real good."

He stated he did not believe that RAY at this time would engage in the sell of narcotics in view of the fact that he is an escaped convict.

WADE later stated, "RAY doesn't like Negroes. I believe

RAY is capable of killing KING. RAY could plan it."
He added it was his speculation "he must have had help."
He stated, "I don't believe RAY killed KING. I couldn't
see RAY getting into that bag as he was an escapee."

WADE advised that he never met any of RAY's family or friends from the outside while they were in jail and RAY never met any of his family or friends from the outside either. He stated, "I have no idea where RAY may be. I have no knowledge of RAY's outside connections. I believe RAY could have saved about a good sum of money from his share of the profits of the sale of amphetamine." He advised in the event RAY was going to escape he believes the other people in the clique would loan or give RAY as much money as they had available to them He advised that RAY used to read about foreign countries in his cell. He advised that PRUITT, who was a cell block mate, worked in the library and would bring the books to RAY. He advised that BURNS and SHURNICK each got 75 years so they are still in MSP. He advised he does not know where PRUITT is.

He advised that he is presently confined as a result of some robberies which he committed in the Los Angeles area with HAROLD KLEMP, DONALD BUSSMEYER and SAM MASSY.

He advised that all four of them had been in MSP at one time or another and he believed that KLEMP, BUSSMEYER and MASSY might know RAY. He advised that KLEMP is in Folsom Prison, BUSSMEYER is in Mc Neil Island and SAM MASSY went insane and is confined in some mental hospital in the State of California.

AT MC NEIL ISLAND PENITENTIARY, WASHINGTON. Will interview DONALD BUSSMEYER who was arrested with WADE in a series of Los Angeles robberies and who was reported to have been in the Missouri State Penitentiary with RAY.

Will interview BUSSMEYER to determine if he has any knowledge of RAY's present whereabouts.
