"You might find your boy Eric Galt at 1629 So. Spaulding L. A.

He hangs out at some bars near 6th & Union.


He lives sometimes with some boys named Stromkist at 1629.

This guy always carries a carron."

The following investigation was conducted by SA J. CHARLES MERRIMAN and the writer:

On 5/9/68, RONALD SOLK, 1633 South Spaulding Avenue, Los Angeles, California, advised that a negro male and a white female had resided at 1629 South Spaulding Avenue, Los Angeles, until only a week or so ago. SOLK further advised that they had been asked to move by the landlady because there were so many "comings and goings" during the nights. SOLK stated he only saw one white man at 1629 during the residence there of the mixed couple. He could not identify a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY as being identical with that white man explaining he had only caught a glimpse of the white man.

On 5/9/68, VICTORIA CONTRERAS, 1623 South Spaulding Avenue, Los Angeles, advised that ALFRED and SHERIE JACKSON, who claimed to be man and wife, moved into 1629, 3/1/68, and moved out at her, MRS. CONTRERAS', request, 5/1/68. MRS. CONTRERAS stated she asked the JACKSONs to move because she could not put up with numerous nighttime guests of the JACKSON's. The guests, according to MRS. CONTRERAS, were both noisy and ~~obnoxious~~ obnoxious. MRS. CONTRERAS said that, while the guests were predominately male negroes, they were all young being about 19 or 20 years old. She stated that,

during the first 13 days of April, 1968, a white male was staying with the JACKSONs. That guest stayed with the JACKSONs at night but his old Off colored white car would be gone during the day. Mrs. CONTRERAS described that guest as white, male, 24 to 25 years at the most, 5'5" to 5'7", broad shoulders. She was unable to identify a photograph of RAY as that guest. MRS. CONTRERAS said the name of STROMKIST was unknown to her. No forwarding address was left by the JACKSONs, however, according to MRS. CONTRERAS, ALFRED JACKSON was then employed by Norris Ind., 588 7111. The JACKSONs formerly resided at 5837 Venice Boulevard, S. W. WORKINGS, landlord. ALFRED's social security number is [REDACTED] SHERRE's social security number is [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ALFRED's driver's license number is R 637019.

Also he does not have Air Force uniform in his possession. He advised that while dating his present wife, he once wore a set of khakis and she asked him then if he was in the service. He told her in a joking manner that "Sure I'm a colonel in the Air Force." CLAUDIA believed this and started telling all of her acquaintances that he was a colonel and he was too embarrassed to correct her. He has since advised her and her family that he is not a colonel and states that he has never made this remark to anyone else.

Mrs. CLAUDIA MORAN verified this and stated that she has advised her whole family that this was not any deliberate hoax on the part of her husband.

In the absence of further information to the contrary, it does not appear that a violation has occurred. No further investigation being conducted San Francisco *ROBERT FRANK MORAN.*

Mr. D. C. FOGLE, 2142 Mallul Drive, Anaheim, Calif., telephonically contacted the office at 2:15 p.m. on 5/11/68 and advised as follows:

On the evening of 5/10/68 he visited the Bourbon Street Bar located on Beach Boulevard, Buena Park, California. At about midnight, his attention was attracted by an individual drinking in the bar who bore a remarkable resemblance to the "bow tie" photographs of RAY. Soon after he noted the individual, the individual left the bar.

FOGLE said he asked the bar tender what the individual had been drinking. The bartender replied that he had served the individual grape juice with vodka. FOGLE said the newspaper account of RAY mentioned that RAY was fond of grape juice with vodka.

FOGLE said he mentioned the individual to a second individual in the bar. This second individual mentioned that the the customer referred to by FOGLE was unknown to him by name but that the customer had been coming into the bar on a regular basis for the past year or more.

FOGLE said the individual he observed was alone in the bar. He was about 6 feet to 6'2" tall and weighed about 200 pounds. He had dark hair. FOGLE said he did not know the direction the individual took when he left the bar.

FOGLE said he did not contact the FBI when he first noted the individual because he was not certain it was RAY and also when he ascertained that the individual was a regular customer he felt that there was no urgency about the matter.

HELEN C. CAUFIELD, Apartment 5, 6130 Afton Place, Hollywood, California, advised she is the manager of the apartment complex located at 6130 Afton Place, Hollywood. She said that on 4/18/68, a Caucasian male came to the apartment complex in search of a room. She said that he paid her one month's rent by means of a check. CAUFIELD said that she was suspicious of the check and through her investigative efforts she learned that the check was written on the victim's account by the boy friend of an associate-roommate of the victim. She said that she does not recall the victim's name. She stated that she did report this matter to the LAPD and her information is that they are conducting a fraudulent check investigation. She described this individual as appearing generally similar to JAMES EARL RAY. She described this individual as being shorter than JAMES EARL RAY, approximately 5'8" in height. She also stated that this individual had noticeably bad teeth in that some of them were missing, others decayed and being generally of a yellow color. All of these characteristics were evident, particularly on the left side.

JAMES JOSEPH was contacted at his residence, 2442 $\frac{1}{2}$ Adelia, South El Monte, California by the writer on 5/9/68 at which time he advised that he was formerly employed as a cook at GUYATTS RESTAURANT, 134 North Citrus, Covina, California. This restaurant is no longer in business.

JOSEPH stated that in November, 1967 while employed as mentioned above he observed a man, alone, in the above restaurant approximately three times. He never saw this man in a car nor did he see this man talk to any person at the restaurant, either employee or customer. He described this man as:
