- 3. THE BEST WAY TO RENEW IS: TAKE THIS APPLICATION NOW WITH CASH, CHECK OR MONEY ORDER, FOR THE EXACT AMOUNT SHOWN ON THE OTHER SIDE, TO THE DIATELY RECEIVE YOUR 1968 STICKER AND REGISTRATION CARD.
- 4. If you mail this application:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING U.S. INCOME TAX RETURN

Who Must File.—If your income in 1.967 was \$600 or more \$1,200 if 65 years of age or over), or your net earnings from self-employment were \$400 or more, you must file an income.dax.return. Forms may be obtained from the District Director of Internal Revenue, your employer, bank, or post office.

A single person with income of less than \$600151,200 if 65 years of age or overl should file a return to get a refund if tax was withheld. A married person with income less than her(his) own personal exemption(s) should file a joint return with husband or wife to get the smaller tax or larger refund. To assure any benefit of the split-income provisions, a married couple should file a joint income tax return.

Filing on Form 1040A.—Form 1040A may be used if your gross income (or the combined income of husband and wife) was less than \$10,000 and consisted entirely of wages subject to withholding and not mere than \$200 of dividends, interest, and other wages.

If you file Form 1040A and your income is less than \$5,000, you may figure your own tax or let the Internal Revenue Service do it for you. If your income is \$5,000 or more but less than \$10,000, you must use the standard deduction and compute your own tax. The use of the tax table or the standard deduction eliminates the need to

Hist contributions, interest, taxes, losses, medical expenses, child care expenses, and certain miscellaneous deductions. The tax tables and tax computation schedule are provided in Form 1040A instructions for this purpose. If you compute your tax any balance due must be paid in full with the return. If the Service computes the tax for you and-there is an underpayment, a bill will be sent to you. In any case where there is an overpayment a refund check will be sent to you.

File Form 1040 instead of Form 1040A if—(1) you had income from sources other than, wages, dividends, and interest, (2) either husband or wife itemizes deductions; (3) you claim the status of head of household or surviving husband or wife; (4) you claim retirement income credit, (5) you claim fisch pay" exclusion for an amount included in wages shown on this form, or (6) you claim deductions for travel, moving, transportation, or "outside salesman" expense, (7) you claim credit for payments on estimated tax or an overpayment from 1966, (8) you claim credit for nonhighway gasoline and lubricating oil taxes, (9) you had unreported tips on which employee F.I.C.A." tax is due, or (10) your Form W-2 shows an amount as 'Uncollected Employee Tax on Tips."

Filing on Form 1040.—Form 1040 may be used by all taxpayers and is designed to report all types of income and deductions.

Re memo from SA THEODORE M. GARDNER (44-1574-739) dated 4/24/68 showing the results of an interview with WILLIAM H. DAMERELL, Special Agent, Department of Corrections, State of California, Special Service Unit, 107 South Broadway, Los Angeles, who appeared at the Los Angeles FBI Office and furnished information given to him by FLORENCE HOLLOWAY SIMPKINS, 1232 West 5th Street, Los Angeles. SIMPKINS, an ex-alcoholic who is on probation, was, according to DAMERELL, reported by her probation officer as "prone to lie."

DAMERELL had agreed to furnish a written report on the information relating to SA GARDNER. A report dated April 25, 1968, was furnished to SA GARDNER on April 29, 1968, and is attached.

SIMPKINS is the subject of a closed 87 case in the Los Angeles Office (December, 1957)--LA 87-7151, Bufile 87-38025, FBI Number 933 437-C. SIMPKINS was involved in issuing a fraudulent check; however, the AUSA declined prosecution.

SIMPKINS was personally interviewed by SA LESLIE F. WARREN and JAMES E. FEENEY on 4/29/68 and reinterviewed by SA LESLIE F. WARREN on 5/2/68 (see separate FD-302).

In substance, SIMPKINS had identified one DONALD MARTIN BLAA, aliases John Figher, John Donald Fisher, Donald Martin and "Rocky." who in November of 1967 was associating with one EARL (LNV) and one PAUL (LNU) and that EARL closely resembled JAMES EARL RAY. On basis of information she furnished, agents identified a record on BLAA under the name of JOHN DAYID FISHER, DONALD B. BLAA, plus akas, LAPD No. 692-823F and FBI No. 25-798A (see data obtained from LAPD, Identification Division, 4/30/68 by IC MILLARD T. ANDERSON and copies of photo of BLAA obtained from the same source on 5/1/68 attached) photo of BLAA obtained from the same source on 5/1/68 attached).

MAY 1 3 1968 FBI - LOS ANGELES It was noted that the LAPD had a misdemeanor warrant outstanding issued 12/8/67 on the basis of a complaint made by the Arkay Realty Corporation, 12/5/67, who operate the St. Francis Hotel, 5533 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles. BLAA had been employed briefly in December, 1967, as a desk clerk and trainee at which time he maintained a room at this hotel. He disappeared along with \$95 in cash from the cash register.

AL THOMPSON Manager of the St. Francis Hotel, 4/29/68, and ROBERT KEELEY, Desk Clerk at this hotel on the same date, confirmed that under the name of BLAA that BLAA had been employed for three or four days in early December and was suspected of stealing \$95 from the cash register. THOMPSON said that BLAA had left some old clothes in a room at the hotel which he had discarded after it became apparent that BLAA had fled and that a complaint had been issued for him for his arrest.

THOMPSON said that he had no knowledge of any association between BLAA and GALT noting that BLAA fled the hotel on or about 12/5/67, whereas GALT had not registered into the St. Francis Hotel until January of 1968. This did not preclude the possibility that BLAA may have known or associated with GALT in the bar of the hotel prior to the time that BLAA fled.

In attempting to locate BLAA for interview, SIMPKINS had stated that he had learned from BOBBY, son of the owner of the King Edward Hotel Bar, 5th and Ios Angeles Street, over the previous weekend that one HOWARD (FNU) who frequents this bar and who is known as "Dictionary Dick" because of his use of big words, had received a letter from Chicago from BLAA sent to HOWARD c/o the King Edward Hotel Bar. This letter which had arrived recently reportedly gave an address on BLAA in Chicago.

On 5/1/68 SAS WARREN and FEENEY identified the BOBBY above as ROBERT PASIECZNY, son of the owner of the bar at 131 East 5th Street, Los Angeles, telephone MA 9-2023. PASIECZNY acknowledged that the letter had been received for DICK HOWARD from BLAA over the past weekend and had been given to HOWARD, who was then currently in the bar. HOWARD was pointed out and was interviewed by agents.

HOWARD identified himself as a RICHARD FRANCIS HOWARD (see LA 91-2368, Bufile 91-12621) and stated that the FBI had a file on him as he had served time on a bank robbery conviction on Terminal Island in 1959. HOWARD was cooperative and exhibited a slip of paper which he said had been received as part of a letter from DON BLAA, which letter was postmarked Chicago, Illinois, 4/21/68. BLAA furnished an address of Room 204 at 60 E. Walton Street, Chicago, and claimed that he was working for a club on Rush Street which was being redecorated and that he was doing odd jobs in connection with this project. BLAA had in the letter asked HOWARD to come to Chicago where BLAA would aid HOWARD in getting a job. HOWARD said that he had no plans of going to Chicago.

Both HOWARD and PASIECZNY described BLAA in substance, as being a hustler, thief, and opportunist who specialized in gaining the confidence of women around various bars, shacking with them, borrowing money and running off with their personal effects and never paying back any money he obtained. BLAA had frequented bars in the East 5th Street area of Los Angeles in the past.

The FBI Identification Record on BLAA, aka, obtained from the LAPD, revealed a felony warrant outstanding in Glendale on a grand theft and that the PD in Glendale had placed a want on BLAA dated 7/20/67.

Further, the "SO GREENE", Springfield, Missouri, had placed a wanted notice with the LAPD 9/12/66 on BLAA, aka, on the basis of a forgery - uttering, warrant which was outstanding at that time.

SIMPKINS had also during her interview stated that she had seen EARL and PAUL on three occasions and that on one occasion shortly before Christmas in 1967 she had been in a bar in downtown Pasadena, name unrecalled, and there had met one AVIS KIRKWOOD who furnished an address of 802 Buena Vista Avenue, Duarte, California. KIRKWOOD had offered to aid SIMPKINS in obtaining work at KIRKWOOD's place of employment, the Duarte Convelescent Hospital, 802 Buena Vista Avenue, Duarte, California. SIMPKINS had been of the opinion that KIRKWOOD might recall the EARL and PAUL who had met "ROCKY" at the

Pasadena bar, and that KIRKWOOD and some man that she was with, ROCKY, EARL, and PAUL, had engaged in conversation at the time.

KIRKWOOD had furnished SIMPKINS with an address, 908 Buena Vista Avenue, Duarte, and had said that a Mrs. IESLIE at the hospital would be the person for SIMPKINS to contact.

Through Mrs. O. IESLIE, Registered Nurse, Supervisor at the above hospital, 4/30/68, it was ascertained that AVIS MARY JANE KIRKWOOD, (nee Golden), aka Mrs. William Leroy Kirkwood, born Social Security No. had been employed in the Housekeeping Department, 9/12/67, and had terminated February, 1968. Her husband, WILLIAM LEROY KIRKWOOD, Social Security No. born had been employed as a janitor at the nospital at the same time AVIS was employed. The KIRKWOODS, both Caucasian, were last known to reside at 908 Buena Vista Avenue, right near the hospital.

Mr. and Mrs. KIRKWOOD were interviewed on 4/30/68. She said she was employed by the Loudel Company which manufactures telephone equipment and her husband worked for the Cal Patio Company, both in Monrovia. Both Mr. and Mrs. KIRKWOOD recalled meeting SIMPKINS, whom they described as a woman, height about 5', stocky, dark hair, who referred to herself as FLORENCE SIMPKINS. The time was just before Christmas, 1967, when the KIRKWOODS were shopping in Pasadena and dropped into a bar, name not recalled, right near a Veterans Thrift Store on Colorado Boulevard between Raymond Avenue and Fair Oaks in Pasadena. In the bar they had struck up an acquaintance with SIMPKINS when someone mentioned West Virginia where the KIRKWOODS used to live. SIMPKINS was with some man, male, white, about 40, medium build, dark hair, but neither of the KIRKWOODS could recall specifically what his name was, although Mr. KIRKWOOD remembered the name of ROCKY being mentioned several times. They pointed out that there were a number of people in the bar, all drinking and everyone was talking to everyone else, and they could not recall seeing or talking to anyone specifically who in their opinion resembled the photograph and wanted flier picture of JAMES EARL RAY.

Mrs. KIRKWOOD said that the man who was with SIMPKINS and described by the latter as her brother-in-law, somewhat resembled the picture of RAY; however, Mrs. KIRKWOOD was sure that he was not RAY.

SAS WARREN and FEENEY on 5/1/68 checked the following bars between Raymond and Fair Oaks on Colorado Boulevard, Pasadena, with negative results as to the identity of BLAA, aka; EARL (INU); PAUL(LNU); JAMES EARL RAY; FLORENCE SIMPKINS; and WILLIAM or AVIS KIRKWOOD:

The Red Carpet Room 6 East Colorado BEN JACOBS

Thirty Fiver 12 East Colorado ROBERT PEREZ and FRED TERZO

Patti's Grill and Bar 20 East Colorado A. A. SBAROUNIS

At Vitale's Bar, 49 East Colorado, near the Veterans Thrift Store, JIM HALES could not identify photographs of JAMES EARL RAY with anyone he had seen, nor could he identify any EARL, PAUL, or JOHN BLAA. He did recall one ROCKY who had frequented the Vitale's Bar four or five months ago and whom he had also seen at a bar called Carsons two blocks east of Allen on Colorado Boulevard. He did not know ROCKY's last name but described him as a male, white, about 40, dark wavey hair, medium build, 5'8". He did not know what ROCKY did or where he lived. He got the impression that ROCKY was an opportunist who was always trying to borrow money. He said that ROCKY mentioned something a couple of months ago when observed in Carsons Bar that he had been down around the Costa Mesa, California, area either doing or seeking construction work. HALES could not identify any woman specifically as an associate of BLAA's, nor could he recall anyone by the name of FLORENCE SIMPKINS.

Los Angeles indices did not reveal a record identifiable with DONALD MARTIN BLAA, aka. There were numerous references to the name of JOHN FISHER but on

the basis of available information, not identifiable with BLAA.

CAUTION: IT WAS NOTED THAT BLAA UNDER THE NAME OF DONALD MARTIN BLAA WAS ARRESTED BY THE LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, POLICE DEPARTMENT, 8/11/51, FOR CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON AND RECEIVED A SENTENCE OF FIFTEEN DAYS IN JAIL AS A RESULT.

Doug Bledsoe, sttendant, Gulf Service Station, 30429 Golden State Freeway advised that James Everett Brooks is unknown to Him.

Howard York, owner, above service making station advised that he had received mail at his service station for Brooks, and that Brooks is unknown to thim, but he believed that Brooks had been employed at the 99 Oaks Cafe, nearby.

Roy L. Dickerson, cook, John Bryan, handyman, Louise Kayona, waitress, Kennys 99 Oaks, Cafe, 30521 Golden State Freeway, advised that James Brooks had been formerly employed as a dishwasher for approximately three weeks, terminating 4/29/68 to proceed to Yosemite Nat'l Park to accept another position on 5/1/68.

Dickerson produced a letter address to Jim Brooks, Warm Springs Camp, Box 37, Castaic, Calif. postmarked 5/1/68 bearing return address of L. Heck, Rodney, Ta.

Dickerson advised that Brooks had been incarcerated at Warm Springs Camp, and had been hired when eligible for release as adishwasher. They stated that Erooks had a drinking problem, had no vehicle.

Photographs of subject Ray were exhibited to all of the above

individuals with negative results.

FBI - LOS ANGELES

A telephonic record check of the LASD reflected one possibility of a James Brooks asbeing identical with the above mentioned suspect. This individual has LASD Booking # B458141, was age 21 yrs. in 1956. Was booked for USM, LA 12/18/56 on Dyer Act Charge. No other information available as package is in archives.

Ave. 19, LA, Calif. following drunk arrest by LAPD in late 12/67 as part of attempt to rehabilate this individual.

Gilbody advised that on 4/12/68 Brooks left Warm Springs following arrangements to secure a position for him at Kennys 99 Oaks Cafe., Golden State Freeway, Castaic. He stated that other than Brooks attending AA meetings on 2/5,12,16,17/68 from 7pm to 1sm at night at which time he was always under supervision and accompanied by others, that Brooks had never left the facility from 1/4-4/12/68.


