The following investigation was conducted by SA JAMES E. HOFFER:

AT WEST COVINA, CALIFORNIA

On May 14, 1968, Mrs. LAWRENCE P. GUIATTE, 1322 North Easebury, Covina, California, advised that she formerly worked in their restaurant which was located on Citrus Avenue, in Covina, California. Mrs. GUIATTE stated that she could recall no one who resembled JAMES EARL RAY having come into their restaurant during November 1967.

On May 14, 1968, Mr. LAWRENCE P. GUIATTE 1322 East Easebury, Covina, California, advised that he is presently employed as an Engineer at Leach Corporation in Los Angeles, California. Mr. GUIATTE stated that he formerly had a restaurant on North Citrus Avenue in Covina, California, and had employed JIM JOSEPH as a cook at that restaurant.

Mr. GUIATTE stated that at no time during November 1967, could he recall an individual coming into their restaurant who resembled JAMES EARL RAY. He stated that such an individual could have come into the restaurant but he does not recall seeing such an individual nor does he recall ever having talked to such a person.

Mr. GUIATTE further advised that as far as he is concerned JIM JOSEPH is at to fabricate almost anything for his own glorification and he does not see how JOSEPH could recall an individual who only came into the restaurant two or three times back in November 1967, as resembling RAY although it is entirely possible. He stated, however, knowing JOSEPH that it is improbable in his opinion that JOSEPH ever saw anyone in the restaurant who resembled RAY inasmuch as he or his wife were always in the restaurant when JOSEPH was there.

For the information of St. Louis, referenced Kansas City airtel of 5/8/68 named seven former inmates of Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) who should be contacted to ascertain if they can furnish any information concerning the whereabouts of JAMES EARL RAY.

On 5/10/68, a review of the Los Angeles Police Department file 304218-D on DENNIS WADE FONTENNOT reflected that FONTENNOT is a transient drunk with arrests for drunk as recent as 12/15/67. Records fail to reflect any employment or residences in California, and FONTENNOT has been arrested for sleeping on park benches as recent as 8/1/67.

On 5/14/68, Mrs. LEORA PICO, 1278 East 126th Street, Los Angeles, California, advised that CHERRI PICO, sister of CHARLES AMOS STEWART, used to live in common-law with her son at their residence but she has not been in Los Angeles since November, 1967, when she left for places unknown in Missouri. Mrs. PICO advised that CHARLES STEWART has not been in Los Angeles to the best of her knowledge. Mrs. PICO advised she has no idea as to the whereabouts of her son who was living with CHERRI and she has no idea as to the present whereabouts of CHERRI or her brother CHARLES STEWART.

On 5/14/68, Mrs. MARY RUSSELL, Trailer No. 60, 8111 Stanford Drive, Garden Grove, California, advised that JUDITH LEA MC FARLIN, wife of DAVID DON MC FARLIN, had spent some time as a house guest of hers in 1966. Mrs. RUSSELL advised that she has no idea where DAVID DON MC FARLIN might be but she stated that the last she heard was that JUDITH

MC FARLIN was residing with her parents at 4331 A Lafayette, St. Louis, Missouri, telephone PR 1-3288. Mrs. RUSSELL stated that JUDITH is her Grand Neice by marriage, but she knows nothing about JUDITH's husband.

On 5/14/68, Mrs. PAULINE COMBS, 4676 West 133rd Street, Hawthorne, California, telephone 675-1047, advised that Mrs. ROSELEE GRIDER, wife of LAWRENCE ALBERT GRIDER, has not been living in California for many months. She advised that she has never met Mr. GRIDER and she has no information regarding his whereabouts. Mrs. COMBS stated that ROSELEE GRIDER was last known to reside at 1510 $\frac{1}{2}$ North Lyon Street, Springfield, Missouri.

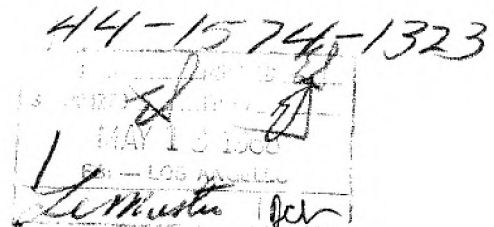

In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to

unidentified dead for the period beginning 4-5-68; and if fingerprints on such dead are maintained, they should be compared with those on the Identification Order on Ray in order to effect identification or nonidentification. This should be handled in the normal course of business and only reasonable investigation should be pursued along these lines.

The Identification Division has placed an appropriate stop on unidentified deceased inquiries it may receive. If feasible, appropriate offices and Legats, Mexico City and Ottawa should place similar stops with appropriate state, local or national agencies in your territories.

He was in the Navy Reserve until 2/1/68 when he returned to active duty status. He remained in the Los ~~XXXXXXX~~ Angeles area except for brief trips to Corpus Christi, Texas until 5/9/68 when he left for the Naval Air Base, Corpus Christi and enroute to Vietnam in about one month.

She exhibited two photos of her husband from her billfold in Navy uniform which did not resemble the photos of JAMES EARL RAY.

She described her husband as white, male, born [redacted] Texas, (city unknown) 5'10" 210-220 lbs, brown hair, blue eyes. tatbe of US Navy emblem on rt. outer forearm, USN ser. # [redacted].

Re Los Angeles airtel to the Bureau 5/14/68, setting forth a letter written by Mrs. ALMENA LOMAX, of Los Angeles, California, who published the Tuskegee Tribune in Tuskegee, Alabama, 1964 and 1965. She suggested the possibility that some of the people who subscribed to the Tuskegee Tribune during that time might have been implicated in the murder of Dr. KING.

Mobile files reflect a LHM submitted to the Bureau 11/12/64, reflecting that LOMAX moved to Tuskegee, Alabama, in late 1964, and published the Tuskegee Tribune. It was set forth that Dr. JULIAN GILES, Director of the VA Hospital, Tuskegee, regarded her as a "mentally sick" person.

In this same file Los Angeles LHM dated 1/18/65, LA file 100-51442, set forth that CS LA 3184-S advised on 1/14/65, that LOMAX was considered untrustworthy by most all the various Negro organizations and groups in the Los Angeles area, and none of them would give her financial backing. This source said that many people acquainted with her questioned her mental capacity.

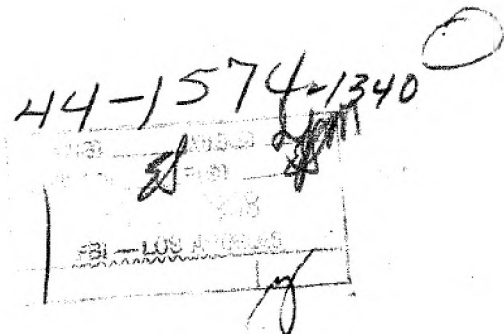

On 4/16/68 JAMES SHUSTER was recontacted and he said he had heard from his wife in Memphis who said KIDDER was still residing with her mother VIRGINIA McDANIEL on Penbody Street in Memphis but she had no additional information. JAMES SHUSTER's wife, CHRISTINA McDANIEL SHUSTER, 632 North Dunlap, Memphis, Tennessee, did not know JAMES SHUSTER had been contacted by the FBI or that KIDDER may be a fugitive. SHUSTER said his job would end at the Sanford - Orlando Dog Track about 4/19/68 and he planned to visit his wife in Memphis.

On 4/30/68, an attempt to contact JAMES SHUSTER met with negative results and his sister-in-law, Mrs. MORRIS SHUSTER, JR., 117 Edenhurgh Drive, Winter Park, Florida said he had departed Florida driving a truckload of racing dogs to Boston. He planned to see his wife and later work the summer season at the Pensacola, Florida dog track. She said that KIDDER was last known to be in Memphis and she knew of no plans for him to return to Florida but if he did she would notify the FBI.

It is being left to the discretion of Memphis and Los Angeles to set forth any lead for the Jacksonville Division in the event it becomes desirable to recontact JAMES SHUSTER when he arrives to work at the Pensacola, Florida dog track.

Sue Avenue, Lynwood, California, might have old records which would reflect what company the Matrix was sold to. Mr. LAVALLE was able to locate an old tread design mold which matched the design of the tread on the Mustang tires in every way and he advised that the Matrix was indeed made by the National Casting Company.

On 5/2/68, Mrs. MARY SKOLICH, 11079 Sue Avenue, Lynwood, California, home phone 532-3918, business phone 636-1033, was contacted at the Hogebuilt Manufacturing Company, Lynwood, and she advised that she would make a search of her old records in an effort to determine for which company the National Casting Company made the Matrix in question. On 5/3/68 Mrs. SKOLICH advised that the Matrix was made for the Garvin Tire Service Centers in the late part of 1962 or early part of 1963.

On 5/3/68, Mr. ROBERT PALLOTTO, Manager, Garvin Tire Service Center, 7257 Reseda Boulevard, Reseda, California, advised that his company purchased the Matrix in question in the late part of 1962 or early part of 1963 and his company has been and is still using the Matrix to mold tires. Mr. PALLOTTO advised that his company's tires do bear the identification mark of "GT" but he has no idea how the identification mark of "RGT" would get on one of the tires. A review of all of the sales invoices of the Reseda Center from August 1967 to the end of March 1968 failed to reflect any tire purchase identifiable to JAMES EARL RAY. PALLOTTO advised that his company often merely writes the word "cash" on the invoice rather than any name or address and it would therefore be impossible to identify the persons purchasing tires. PALLOTTO advised that his company also has a branch service center in North Hollywood, California, and their records would be available for review.

On 5/5/68, L.D. JOHNSON, Manager, Garvin Tire Service Center, 5140 Lankershim Boulevard, North Hollywood, California, advised he would have employees pull the sales invoices for August 1967 to the end of March 1968.

On 5/10/68, a review of the sales invoices for August 1967 through March 1968 for the North Hollywood branch of the Garvin Tire Service Centers failed to reveal any item identifiable to JAMES EARL RAY, aka ERIC STARVO GALT and it was noted that many of the invoices merely had the notation "cash".

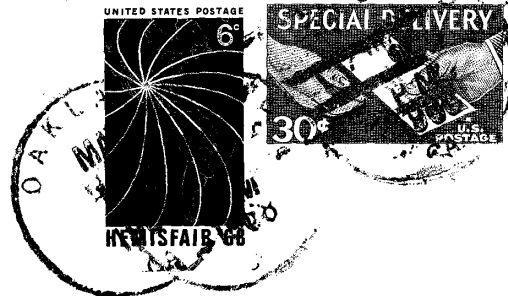
