Mr. GUIATTE stated that at no time during November 1967, could be recall an individual coming into their restaurant who resembled JAMES EARL RAY. He stated that such and individual could have come into the restaurant but he does not recall seeing such an individual nor does he recall ever having talked to such a person.

Mr. GUIATTE further advised that as far as he is concerned JIM JOSEPH is at to fabricate almost anything for his own glorification and he does not see how JOSEPH could recall an individual who only came into the restaurant two or three times back in November 1967, as resembling RAY although it is entirely possible. He stated, however, knowing JOSEPH that it is improbable in his opinion that JOSEPH ever saw anyone in the restaurant who resembled RAY inasmuch as he or his wife were always in the restaurant when JOSEPH was there.

In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U.S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It is being left to the discretion of Memphis and Los Angeles to set forth any lead for the Jacksonville Division in the event it becomes desirable to recontact JAMES SHUSTER when he arrives to work at the Pensacela, Plorida dog track.


