
They advised that they had the think the they had the Los Angeles Free Press, ADALT GARDE News PARES.

EVELYN ROBRIGUEZ, 1649 South Berendo Street, Los Angeles, California, advised on May 4, 1968 that she had been on the mailing list of The Local Swinger for approximately three months but that she had never received any correspondence from GALT Off or RAY, or had ever met anyone resembling him.

SELNA NAHOOD, 255 North Cordova Street, Eurbank, California advised on May 3, 1968 that she had sent the amount of \$1.00 to The Local Swinger, had received a list of names, but had never received a letter from GALT or RMY, or had never met anyone resembling him.



PAUL LEVY, 3905 Stevely Avenue, Los Angeles, California advised and MAY6, 1968 on Hay 3, 1968 that he has submitted ads to the Los Angeles Free Press and that perhaps The Local Swinger acquired his name through these ads, however, he has never received any correspondence or met any person names ERIC GALT or JAMES EALL NAY.

ROMANNE KLENHERLY, Apartment # 9, 218 North Alexandria Street, Los Angeles, California advised on May 3, 1968 that she had placed an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press stating she was lonely and seeking dates. She surmises that The Local Swinger placed this advertisement in their magazine since she had received about ten letters from persons who had seen the ad in The Local Swinger. She never received correspondence or met anyone named GALT or RAY.

DOROTHY MEACHAM, Manager, Carolina Hollywood Motel, 1520 No. La Brea avenue, Los an geles, Palifornia, advised on Lay 3, 1968 that she had placed an adveryisement in the Los Angeles Free Press but had never joined The Local Swinger. She had never received any correspondence from GALT or LAY, and after viewing photographs of RAY stated that she has never seen him.

BETTY WISHARD and BARBARA SNELL, 1625 North Martel Street,
Los Angeles, California advised on May 3, 1968 that they had placed
advertisements in the Los Angeles Free Press and had received
some correspondence, but had not received any communications from
anyone named GALT or RAY. They viewed photographs of RAY but stated
they had never seen him.

AUGUSTA L. CADE, 1429 South Cloverdale Avenue, Los Angeles, California, advised on May 3, 1968 that she had placed an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press in January 1968 and that she received correspondence until March 1968; however, she never received any letters from GALT or RAY, and after viewing photographs of RAY stated she has never seen him.

MARIA G. URIADO, sister-in-law of OPELIA AYON, 820 North -astern Avenue, Los Angeles, California, whose name was on the mailing list of The Local Swinger, stated that OPELIA AYON was now residing in Mexico, but that she had never received any correspondence from The Local Ewinger, nor had she ever contacted this organization. URIADO viewed photographs of RAY but stated she had never seen RAY.

LINDA WAPATO, Apartment #2, 4259 Verdugo Road, Los Angeles, California advised that she had placed an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press for about two weeks in January 1968 but had never received any mail from GALT or *** RAY, and after viewing photographs of RAY stated that she had never seen him

BETTY KRAKER, 1336 North Edgement Street, Los Angeles, California advised on May 3, 1968 that she had received a letter addressed to BARBARA BELL in mid-April 1968, along with a photograph of a man, however, it was not a letter or photograph of ERIC S. GALT or JAMES EARL RAY.

MRS. NICHAEL VAN FIFTLIN, 15050 Parthenia Street, Sepulveda, California advised on May 3, 1968 that her husband, MICHAEL VAN TIFFLIN was receiveing mail from a correspondence club at one time but since January 1968 he has been an inmate at the Atascadero State Hospital, Atascadero, California. This facility is for the criminally insane.

BRYAN GRANT, aka BRYAN PMARSON, 13469 Rand Drive, Sherman Oaks, California advised on May 3, 1968 that he had placed an advertisement on the Los Angeles Free Press and had received some mail, but never anything from GALT or RAY. He viewed photographs of RAY but stated that he had never seen RAY.

HAROLD L. CONRAD, 7901 Hesperia Street, Canoga Park, California advised on May 3, 1968 that he had placed an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press but that he had ## never received any letters from GALT ### or RAY. CONRAD viewed photographs of RAY but stated that he had never seen RAY.

SANDY TERRY, 2543 West 225th Place, Torrance, California advised on May 4, 1968 that she never heard of The ##### Local Swinger, had no knowledge of ######## anyone named GALT or RAY, and had no idea how her name might on been on the list of the group.

Milody Mc Carthy, 420 Irving Street, Glendale, California advised on May 7, 1968 that she had placed an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press and had dated some of the persons who responded to the ad. She stated that she did not belong to The Local Swinger group, and upon viewing photographs of RAY stated that she had never seen him or had never heard of the name ERIC S. GALT.

CAROLYN BROOKS, 1200 North Orange Grove Avenue, Los Angeles, California advised that she had been receiving mail as a result of an advertisement placed a few years ago but she had never #### received any mail from anyone named ERIC S, GALT or JAMES EARL RAY.

May 3, 1968 that she had joined a Pen Pal Club in Pasadena, California a few years ago, and has been receiving correspondence ever since.

She has never seen or heard of GALT or RAY.

ROBERT LEE HOFFMAN, 229 South Ardmore Avenue, Los Angeles, California advised on May 9, 1968 that he had never heard of The Local Swinger and had never subscribed to the club periodical. He viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated he had never seen him or had he ever received any correspondence from RAY or ERIC S. GALT.

MR.CHARLES ANDERSON, 6402 Haas Avenue, Los Angeles, California advised on May 3, 1968 that he had no idea how his name was secured by The Local Swinger, and that he had never communicated with this club. He stated he had never seen or heard of anyone named JAMES EARL RAY or ERIC S. GALT.

MRS. CAROL VOLBERG, manager, apartments located at 3184
West 8th Street, Los Angeles, alifornia reviewed the rental
records for the years of 1964 through #968## April 1968 for any
record of one EDITH SIEBOLD, whose name # was somehow obtained
by The Local Swinger, with negative results.

After several attempts to contact PeGGY MTNTERS, hostess athe My Desire Bar, she was interviewed at her home (1008 N. Serrano, LA) on 5/6/68. WINTERS was shown photos of RAY and advised that she had never seen him before. WINTERS thought that she would have remembered him if he had been in the bar because she has a very good memory for faces.

In view of the above investigation, no further investigation is being conducted to locate CROSBY.

He is a driver for the International Hotel and works the night shift. Around 3:30 am on 5/4/68as he was walking on the main floor of the hotel, off the lobby, he saw a man obtaining a pack of cigarettes from the cigarette machine. He saw the man head on for a brief moment, the man stared at him, and the man then walked right past him. TAYLOR went around the corner of the hall and when he turned back several moments later the man was gone. The man must have notten on the elevator or otherwise TAYLOR would have seen him.

TAYLOR described the man he saw as follows: WM, 150-160, age 35-40, 5feet 9"-5'10", blue eyes, light brown hair (crewcut), full face. TAYLOR was shown all the photographs of JAMES HARL RAY. 
