At 1:45 p.m. on 5/20/68, Mrs. BARBARA VAIL, 2803 Loganarta Avenue, Arcadia, California, telephone number 447-7779, employed at Biggers, Radadena, tele-phonically adrised that yesterday, 5/19/68, she and her brother and his wife boarded the San Diegan train at Oceanside, California, at approximately. 4:57 p.m.. She identified her brother and sister-in-law to be Mr. and Mrs. MEL E. MAURER, and noted that he is the vice-president of A. B. Dick and Company, Chicago, Illinois. After boarding the train, they proceeded to the club car, where they sat during the trip to Los Angeles.

While they were in the club car, an individual entered the club car and sat next to Mrs. VAIL. He had two Budweiser, bears and departed. While the individual was in the club car, Mrs. VAIL had the feeling that she had seen this individual before and mentioned it to her brother and sister-in-law, who also observed the individual. They decided that the individual strongly resembled the composite photograph of the individual who allegedly murdered Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

This morning they observed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, in the U.S. News and World Report, and all are now convinced that the individual who they observed on the train yesterday strongly resembles RAY. Mrs. VAIL advised that the individual she observed on the train yesterday walked with a slight limp in his left leg.

Mrs. VAIL requested that in the event this information leads to RAY's apprehension, that she be advised in order that she can put in a claim for the outstanding rewards in this matter.

Following investigation by SA Leslie F. Warren:

Fhotos of Ray were exhibited to Vail 5-21-68. She said she had only had a profile view of the man in question and he closely resembled the artist composite picture of Kings killer. Further this man she had seen on the train resembled the profile photo of Ray taken at the Missouri Dept. of Corrections, 1-1-66. She did not know where the man had boarded the train, ##the was still on the train when she got off on Los Angeles. The general physical description on the Warted Flyer on Ray as to age, height, age, weight and color of hair fit the ukn suspect. She was of the opinion the eyes were brown however. She saw him walk from the lounge car to a chair car and noted suspect walked with one leg, the left one, might be an artificial leg. She did not get the impression he was faking this walk. He was dressed in a dark business suit. She did not recall if he wore a regular shirt with tie or a sport shirt. The man appeared to be alone, no one was observed talking to him. He was rather furtive when Vail looked at the suspect and would not look at her directly. Vail said she did not discuss the look a like appearance of this man with Ray, with her brother and wife, Nel E. and Hazel ... Maurer, while they were on the train as she did not want the suspect to hear the talking about him. They had not noted the resemblance until Vail/called it to their attention. They were then some what in agreement with her observations.Mr. and Mrs Mauer live at 640 Glendale Dr., Glen view, Ill. and have already returned to their home.

Mrs. Vail appeared to be an intelligent woman. She is a sales lady at the Biggar Furniture Co., 630 E.. Colorado Bl, Pasadena, Cal. She said she had been with this company 23 years.

The crew of the train in question, The San Diegan, a Santa Fe train, was identified through F.W. Arbuckhe, clerk in the office of H.D. Fish, Supt. of the L. A. Div. of the Santa Fe,5-21-63. The crew was interviewed at the Union Sta. in L. A. as follows: 5-21-63.

P.A. Schamber, Conductor said the most recent photo of Ray resembled a man he recalled being on the train but could not recall any thing in detail or when he got on or off. The train had 15 cars and about 700 passengers on it between San Diego and L.A. on 5-19-68, a Sunday. He said he was too busy.

Conrad Gil, bar tender in the lounge, the only employee in the lounge had no recollection of the man in question and did not recall seeing any one on the train resembling the photos of Ray. Gil was exceptionally busy. 44-1574-1402

At 4:28 PM, 5/20/68, HIBBARD LAMKIN, SAC, U. S. Department of State, Office of Security, telephone 688-3290, telephonically contacted the writer concerning above-captioned individual who is the publisher of the "Local Swinger." 44.1874.1175, LAMKIN stated that a Department of State Special Agent, 1097 FRANK TERRY, is in Los Angeles to conduct investigation and in this regard had developed information that above-captioned individual had been recently interviewed by SA JOHN C. O'NEILL of the FBI. He stated in order to coordinate and facilitate TERRY's investigation he desired to know if arrangements could be made for TERRY to confer with SA O'NEILL concerning O'DOWD before he did further investigation.

IAMKIN stated that TERRY is assigned to a division in Washington, D. C. that primarily is interested in running down allegations of homosexuality in the State Department. IAMKIN was advised that this matter would be checked into and that he would be called back.

On 5/21/68 SAC HIBBARD LAMKIN, U.S. Department of State, Office of Security, and SA FRANK TERRY, U.S. Department of State visited the Los Angeles Office and along with SA's WILLIAM B. NOLAN and JOHN C. O'NEILL discussed the phase of the MURKIN (44-1574) case concerning The Local Swinger, P.O. Box 3802, Downey, California. LAMKIN and TERRY Tesired to know if Agent O'NEILL had ever obtained a list of the Local Swinger and he was told that a list was never obtained. They were assured that if JAMES E. O'DOWD contacted this office an effort would be made to determine where he is currently residing. They were also told that the FBI would cooperate fully in the Department of States effort to uncover homosexuals in that Department by relaying an information concerning the whereabouts of O'DOWD.





On 5/15/68, Captain DON BURKE, Pomona, California Police Department, advised that at 10:02 AM, 5/15/68, his department had received an anonymous telephone call from a female, perhaps in her 50's, advising "if you want the man who shot Mr. KING, he is living at 331 East Pearl, and he has a loaded shotgun at the front and back door. If you pick him up be careful".

It was determined that the current resident of 331 East Pear is one GEORGE FLEMING CHAPLINE, with telephone number 622-0671. It was also determined from the records of the Pomona Police Department that CHAPLINE had never been arrested, but that he was born and has made numerous complaints and furnished information from time to time from the Pomona Police Department from December 7, 1967, up through 1/1/68.

Records of the Credit Bureau reflected CHAPLINE was employed at Wallach's Music City and is divorced from FRANCES CHAPLINE. He has a good credit record.

on 5/15/68, CHAPLINE was contacted at his residence by SAs SCRUGGS and JOHN L. WALTERS, along with Detectives of the Pomona Police Department. It was noted that in no way did CHAPLINE fit the description of RAY. Mr. CHAPLINE allowed a search of his house to determine if anyone else was there. This search was conducted with negative results. Mr. CHAPLINE stated nobody has been residing with him at this apartment.

On 5/15/68, Captain BURKE later advised that CHAPLINE had contacted him and advised that he believes the manager's wife at his residence is attempting to get him evicted, and might be the person making the anonymous telephone call concerning him.
