MARGIE CURTIS, 1838 Dunlap Avenue, East Point, Georgia, employed by National Car Rental, Atlanta, Georgia, advised on 5/17/68, she was the individual who rented the 1968 Dodge Dart to S. M. SCHNEIDERMAN on 4/2/68. She described SCHNEIDERMAN as being in his late 30s or early 40s, approximately 5' 7'8" tall, of small build, weighing approximately 140-145, with dark hair, postable black. She viewed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, and stated from her recollection, did not believe RAY identical to SCHNEIDERMAN, however, photograph of RAY, particularly the hair, did resemble SCHNEIDERMAN.

SCHWEIDERMAN appeared at the National Car Rental Office at the Atlanta Airport at approximately 9:42 am, wearing a business suit and presented 3 Millionaire Club credit cards, 2 in plastic covering, and 1 plain paper card, all in the name of S. MISCELLANEIOUS-INFORMATION CONCERNING

On May 31, 1968 EDGAR EUGENY BRADERY, 12208 Emelita St., North Hollywood, Calif. telephopically advised SA JAMES MC CAULEY at the Van Noys RA as follows:

He had heard from friends in Tulsa, Okla, and from relatives at Rudy, Ark, that FBI agents had been making inquiries as to his whereabouts on May 17, 1968. MR. BRADLEY said that as he understood the situation, one REX BASINGER had alleged that BRADEEY had told BASINGER on that date that BRADEEY was with ERIC GALT in Oklahoma.

BRADLEY said he wished to volunteer that he had been a close childhood framad of REX BASINGER in Arkansas. However he has not seen BASINGER since he was 15 or 16 years old and had lost track of him. He had heard that after WW II BASINGER had become a preacher. He said he had now heard that BASINGER had apparently had some mental problems, and the accusations against BRADEEY by GARRISON must have tirggered a mental reaction.

BRADLEY said that in fact on May 17, 1968 he was right in North Hollywood, working on some accounts, and making a bank deposit. He said that he had talked with a number of people here on that day, and his whereabouts can definitely be proven should it be necessary to do so.

BRADEEY mentioned that his extradition hearing scheduled for 6/5/68 at Secremento had been postponed until 6/26/68 because of an injunction against GARRISON by a Federal judge in New Orleans, in a related case. BRADEEY said that in fact he is anxious to get the matter settled and over with.

He was informed that the above information would be made
