On July 25, 1969, C. R. CRANK, JR., Superintendent, Federal Detention Center, Florence, Arizona, made available the attached copy of a letter written by JOHN HAMILTON MORRIS, inmate of that institution to Mr. PETER GOLDMAN, 444 Madison Avenue, New York City, New York. Mr. CRANK pointed out that the significance of this letter was the fact that MORRIS indicated that JAMES EARL RAY had been paid by an individual known as "BIG D". Mr. CRANK advised that MORRIS was received at that institution on July 19, 1969, and was incarcerated there until July 25, 1969.

MORRIS was maintained at that institution as a stop-over while en route from San Francisco, California, to Leavenworth, Kansas. He explained that MORRIS was serving a sentence at U. S. Penitentiary, Leavenworth, and had been removed from that institution to San Francisco, where he was afforded a hearing on a Writ of Habeas Corpus.

Mr. CRANK advised that an information card maintained by that institution on MORRIS indicated that he had been convicted for crimes of bank robbery in 1949, bank robbery in 1969 and aircraft piracy in 1969. His attorney was listed as PAUL L. LARSEN, 309 South Third Street, Las Vegas, Nevada.

Peter Goldman, Senior Editor, Newsweek Magazine, 444 Madison Avenue, New York City furnished the following information to Special Agent O. Eugene Smith on November 3, 1969:

He cannot recall having ever met or having ever received correspondence from a John Hamilton Morris. A review of the files of the Letter Department of the Magazine failed to reveal that he ever received a letter from John Hamilton Morris.

He has never heard of anyone referred to as "Big D" in connection with the James Earl Ray case and he has no knowledge of any statement being made that James Earl Ray was paid by "Big D".

He receives mumerous "crank" letters which he deposits in the waste basket. No record is keept of these "crank" letters.

Enclosed for the Los Angeles Office are one copy each of letter from Phoenix to the Director 9-4-69 with LHM and xerox copy of letter from JOHN HAMILTON MORRIS; also enclosed for Los Angeles is copy of New York letter to the Director 11-5-69 reflecting results of interview with PETER GOLDMAN.

On 11-13-69, CARL F. ZARTER, Administrative Assistant, U. S. Fenitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas, advised that inmate JAMES HAMILTON MORRIS, #83856, was released to the custody of the USM on 9-11-69 to be produced in the USDC, Los Angeles, California. MORRIS has not as yet returned to Leavenworth. Authorities at Leavenworth are unable to anticipate his return. It is therefore suggested that the interview set forth in Phoenix communication for the Kansas City Division be handled by the Los Angeles Division. Los Angeles should be able to determine whereabouts of MORRIS through the USM's office in that area.

It is to be noted that the copy of the handwritten letter from MORRIS to GOLDMAN is barely readable. If Los Angeles decides a more legible copy is needed, it is suggested they obtain one from the Phoenix Office. Kansas City believes that the individual mentioned in the letter as Big D, who was apparehended in New Mexico two weeks ago is possibly ROBERT DE PUGH, head of the Minutemen organization, who is also currently incarcerated at Leavenworth Penitentiary.

On December 1, 1969, John Hamilton Morris was interviewed at the Los Angeles County Jail, Los Angeles, California, regarding information contained in a letter written by him on July 22, 1969, to Peter Goldman, 444 Madison Avenue, New York, New York. This letter contained information that James Earl Ray was paid by "Big D".

Morris stated that he is a journalist, that as a journalist he has his sources, and that as a journalist he does not reveal the identity of his sources. Morris stated it was common knowledge that Ray was paid to kill Martin Luther King. Morris was asked to explain what he referred to as common knowledge. He said that everyone knew that the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) was behind the murder of Martin Luther King. He continued that the CIA backed the Minutemen and Robert De Pugh of the Minutemen. The CIA wanted King out of the way so it had De Pugh make the arrangements. Ray being a small time criminal, was selected to do the actual killing and CIA the brains behind the whole scheme. When De Pugh was no longer needed by the CIA, he was arrested. Morris said that this scheme is common knowledge.

Morris volunteered that he has been declared medically and criminally insane.

Records of Atascadero State Hospital, Atascadero, California, as of April 13. 1959, revealed that John Hamilton Morris, born at Martin, Michigan, was admitted to that hospital on September 22, 1958, as criminally insane. At that time, he had a criminal record dating back to September 26, 1940, and had over 20 arrests, including grand theft, car theft, mail fraud, postal loss, forgery, and money postal orders. These records reveal that Morris was not found criminally insane by this hospital and had been turned over to the court in San Mateo, California, for further action.

John Hamilton Morris appeared at U. S. District Court, Southern District of California, Los Angeles, on February 23, 1967, for jury trial. At the conclusion of the trial on February 24, 1967, Morris was found guilty of violation of Title 18, Section 2113 (a), U. S. Code. On March 20, 1967, Morris was sentenced to 15 years custody of the U. S. Attorney General.

Morris filed an appeal of this conviction April 21, 1969, before the U. S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. He based his appeal on his not having been protected under Title 18, U. S. Code, Section 4244, in that under this statute, the U. S. Attorney failed in his responsibility to move for a determination of competency where he had reasonable cause to believe the accused might be incompetent. His appeal argues that under the same section and by Constitutional mandate, it was incumbent on the court to order a determination of competency, where reasonable cause appeared to indicate the accused might be incompetent; said failure violated Morris's guarantee of due process under the Fifth Amendment of the Constitution.

The appellant further argues that the courtappointed counsel failed to provide that assistance guaranteed by the Sixth Amendment of the Constitutional rights of due process in the fair trial.

The final point of the appellant's argument is that the Court's sentencing procedure was both a failure of its statutory responsibility and an abuse of its discretion under Title 18, U. S. Code, Section 4244; and under 4208 (b) which provides for committment of the accused to the custody of the Attorney General for a period of time not to exceed six months, for the purpose of evaluation to assist the trial court in passing a meaningful rehabilitative sentence.

On July 28, 1969, Assistant U. S. Attorney Darrell Mac Intyre, Los Angeles, advised that on July 24, 1969, a decision was received from the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals that the conviction of John Hamilton Morris had been reversed.

Morris appeared at U. S. District Court, Los Angeles, and entered a plea of guilty to violation of Title 18, Section 2113 (a), U. S. Code. Trial was set for November 4, 1969. Morris was to be afforded psychiatric examination prior to trial date. As of December 9, 1969, the trial of Morris had not commenced.

The Los Angeles Herald Examiner, daily metropolitan Los Angeles newspaper, in its issue of July 5, 1968, carried an article on Page A-1 captioned, "Dynamite Hijack Try Just a Dud", datelined Las Vegas, Nevada (UPI). This article reported that a Federal prisoner identified as John Hamilton Morris, 48 of Martin, Michigan, tried to hijack a commercial airliner, July 4, 1968, by falsely reporting he had dynamite on his person. His high altitude plot failed completely.

The U. S. Attorney at Las Vegas was expected to take this incident before the Grand Jury and ask for an indictment charging Morris with attempted hijacking.

Synopsis of C.O.B.R.A. News Conference Held at the Los Angeles Press Club March 5, 1970

- 1. Demand for the immediate closure of the University of California.
 - Beatings, bombings and burnings have befallen the "California" campuses as a result of the "CONTROLLED CURRICULA" engineered to caress the student into the acceptance of COMMUNAZI rhetoric. For example, HENAC (Human and Educational Needs for the Academic Community), a 12-unit accredited course at UCLA, funded by the fascistic Ford Foundation (to the tune of \$75,000) and the University of California, uses textbooks by Joseph Stalin, Lenny Bruce, Rosa Luxembourg, Malcolm X, Frederick Engels, Che Guevara, Karl Marx, Eldredge Cleaver, Ho Chi Minh, Leon Trotsky, and Fidel Castro . . . and those are just the conservatives. Money through HENAC paid for the Pauley Pavillion "riot rally" supporting the "Chicago Seven" on campus at UCLA. HENAC distributes position papers of Jerry Rubin, and their office doubles as the Black Panther Information Center. The Panthers' "Negro Nazi" black bigots have allied themselves with the Al Fatah in a COMMUNAZI collusion that promotes hate and hostility toward the Hebrew minority. They support "Nasser, Nazi of the Nile" and the COMMUNAZI alliance of "socialist states" who plan a program to "exterminate the Jew off the face of the earth.
 - b. UCSB, with open arms, offered William Kunstler taxsupported facilities to inflame the fury of the COMMU-FASCIST fanatics which left the Isla Vista in flames.
 - c. The students receive an indoctrination rather than an education . . . The curriculum is sick, slanted and subversive. There is no accurate concept of history

 . . no such thing as original documentation research assignments. The ability to accept rather than think is accented in the freshman year and then accelerated quarterly, resulting in a "BRAIN BENDING" indoctrination program rivaling that of Adolph Hitler's at the height of his hysteria. The University of California is disseminating the seeds of discontent, designed to divide, distort and destroy the system of free enterprise.
- 2. Abolition of property tax.
 - a. Property tax is the base on which the abolition of private property is promoted . . . that being the first plank of the Communist Manifesto, which leads toward total

totalitarianism through its support of the tenth plank of the Communist Manifesto which is tax-supported, government "controlled" public education. It is better titled "Reducation."

- b. The property tax is discriminatory in that it takes from the industrious who have contributed to society, built homes, industry, and business, and penalizes "them" to aid the parasitic populace who feels that the "workers of the world" owe them a living. The Communists have been conned and controlled by the Establishment, proving that CommUNism is not built on empty bellies but built on empty heads.  - a.  - b. It is discriminatory against the "individual" who chooses to send his or her child to private or parochial schools; in that they are taxed "double," once for the perversive and subversive education they choose not to support, and then must pay again for the education they choose, the quality of both suffering severely. What the government pays for, the government controls . . . What the government receives it must first take away, and what the government takes away it must do so by force or threat of force . . . Thus COMMUFASCISM flourishes as with Adolph Hitler's public "PROGRAMMED" populace.
 - c. Public Reducation further discriminates against the individual parent who wishes to tailor the education of a "talented" child toward specific "superior" capacities. The system, conversely, is geared down to meet the lowest standards rather than the highest . . . The bright students lose interest and imagination while being penalized, paralyzed and propagandized to the point of "severe" growth suppression.
 - a renaissance of Sodom and Gomorrah to antedeluvian concepts that once belched forth from the belly of Babelonian barbarians. The sickness saturates the society and permeates the peace and promise of freedom for all, with products of the public schools like Manson's maniacs and a multitude of other monstrosities that infest the streets with hypes, whores and heathens heralding hate and hostility for humanity.

Private or state banks could lend money to the parents for their children's education when a family is destitute. The parent would be required by law to pay for the education of his choice. We do not believe in the something-for-nothing concept.

The Bolshevik bureaucracy is beyond the belief of many parents who have grown to accept this COMMUNAZI "cancer" with concern but lack the courage and initiative to step out of their apathy into action. This C.O.B.R.A. news conference is designed to inspire them to cut out the cancer on the California campuses before it is too late. The elimination of public education will discourage irresponsible parents from foisting on society their "offspring" which they are not willing to pay for. We therefore encourage responsible parenthood designed to elevate society to new heights in the twentieth century.

- e. INSENSITIVITY TRAINING is being adopted by public schools which was first most effectively used by Adolph Hitler's storm troopers in his "strength through joy" program.
- 4. Separation of school and state.

Separation of school, media, church and state are essential to the "free right" of choice. Separation of the media and church from government control has brought about the best financed and most formidable media and religious organizations in the history of mankind. The same argument for "controlled" media and "controlled" church has been presented by every "COMMUNAZI" tyranny of the twentieth century. We feel that the child is the ward of the parent and not of the state.

James Eart Ray now at New Prison

PETROS, Tenn. (UPI)— James Earl Ray, the convicted killer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., was transferred today from the state penitentiary at Nashville to a smaller maximum security facility at Brushy Mountain near here.

"He arrived by car about 6:30 A.M." said Wallace Flood, assistant corrections commissioner for adult programs.

"He will be housed in a single cell in one of the cell blocs," Flood said. "He will get exactly the same treatment as any other prisoner here. And we plan to work out a work program for him, but we don't know yet just what that will involve.

"Actually he will be better off here than in Nashville," Flood added. "He'll have more opportunity for recreation and exercise, because of the smaller number of prisoners here. There's a big difference between 3,000 inmates and 325."

On 3/16/70 Supervisor CLEMENT L. MC GOWAN, JR., Civil Rights Unit, SOG, advised he received an inquiry concerning matter appearing in a new book due to be released written by former FBI Agent WILLIAM TURNER which relates to the KING assassination. He stated on page 106 of chapter 6 reference is made to an unnamed Los Angeles Police Department official who purportedly attempted to provide the FBI with information indicating that there was a conspiracy behind KING's assassination, but that the FBI declined to accept this information stating, "We got our man and that is it."

MC GOWAN stated a review of this file failed to indicate any factual basis for this statement and he requested that any pertinent information be furnished to him from Los Angeles files.



It seems water under the bridge, as the above person has long been captured, and is now serving time.

The thing that got me was - I know I saw this man in La Habra Calif. April 9th, 1968, I tried to get help from the local police, the F. B. I. in Los Angeles, and no one seemed to care- Then I wrote a letter to you, and the F. B. I from Los Angeles finally acted- I guess when they heard from YOU, because the two men who came to my house said: Why did I write You??

On April 9th, 1968, about 10AM, I was having my old car (1951 Hudson Hornet) serviced at the Texaco Station, the car was then was up on a heist, this man walks in and asked for the Keys to the men's room- I sensed right there that was the James Earl Ray, as I had cold chills up my back, I just was frozen, could not phone, could not get my car, but said to myself, don't act as if you know anything-well he wasn't in the men's room 30 seconds came out hung up the Keys, and seemed to stagger towards his car-altho not drunk- He had to be a very marked man-I don't for the life of me see how anyone could have missed him. at all--

Have never heard whether I was right or wrong I know I was Right-All I want to know was I Right? I realize it is a touchy thing to advertise, as the Blacks would Love me, and there are a lot of Whites, would have it in for me, but I am a great believer in equality, and Justice for ALL. I even told the F B I - (IA) that he would drive East which would have taken him to Ontariom Airport and to Canada.


