On 4/5/68, source advised that the West End Community Council, Louisville, Kentucky, a group whose announced purpose is to improve living conditions in the West End of Louisville and prevent it from becoming an all-Negro neighborhood, has made reservations to charter three Greyhound buses, each having capacity of 37 persons, for Louisville people to attend Dr. KING's funeral. The buses are tentatively scheduled to depart Louisville at 2:00 p.m. on April 7, 1968, arriving in Atlanta, Georgia, at the Greyhound Bus Station approximately 10:00 p.m. on the same date. No stops en route are planned and participants are to take box lunches as? scheduled routes will bypass the towns of Nashville and Chattanooga, Tennessee.

The above three buses are scheduled to depart at the Atlanta, Georgia, Greyhound Bus Station at 7:00 p.m. on April 9, 1968, and return directly to Louisville, Kentucky.

Major PRIEST FRY, Chief of Detectives, Louisville, Kentucky, on 4/5/68, advised that a confidential source of the police department had advised that CARL and ANNE BRADEN (SI subjects, Louisville Division) planned to attend Dr. KING's funeral in Atlanta, Georgia.

CARL and ANNE BRADEN are leading figures in Southern Conference Educational Fund, (SCEF) at Louisville. Mode of travel by the BRADENS is not known.

Police source further advised representatives of SCEF in Louisville had indicated that they were planning to have some of their representatives, identity not known, travel to Memphis in the immediate future by private automo-biles.

ADDENDUM:

First source later advised that a RICHARD COLLINS, who stated he represents the Louisville Federation of Settlements on April 5, 1968, reserved a Greyhourd bus, capacity 37, to depart from 1921 W. Broadway, Louis ille at 2:00 PM, April 7, to take participants to Doctor KINE's funeral in Atlanta, Georgia, which COLLINS says has now been set for 1:00 PM, 4/8/68. This group scheduled to arrive Atlanta at Greyhound Bus Station approximately 10:00 PM, 4/7/68, and depart Atlanta for Louisville approximately 4:00 PM, 4/8/68. The source stated that apparently COLLINS is acquainted with the fact that 3 buses are reserved for the WECC to go to Atlanta, as he commented his group could not afford to stay in Atlanta until 4/9/68, and would depart Atlanta, 4/8/68.

Louisville indices contain no identifiable data regarding COLLINS or Louisville Federation of Settlements.

INFORMATION CONCERNING.

During weekend of 4/6-7/68 this office received numerous anonymous calls regarding Dr. King's assassination and associated disturbances (riots) throughout the U S. Most calls could be placed under one or more of the following subjects:

CRITICISM OF FBI FOR ENTERING CASE. Many callers ask what grounds the FBI was using as basis for investigation of Dr. King's murder.

Callof PEOPLE WHO CLAIM THEY SAW MAN FITTING DESCRIPTION OF ASSASSIN AS GIVEN IN THE NEWS PAPER. This type call wasn't as numerous as that above, however, several were received. Most would just say that they saw a man fitting the description of answer was "Well....you know...like the description given in the paper." No caller cared to leave his name for further suspect. When ask just what the man looked like, the average No caller cared to leave his name for further contact. In no instance did office receive information that could be checked out by investigation. Most just said they saw a man and could furnish nothing else.

CALLS COMPLAINING ABOUT THE FLAGS BEING FLOWN AT HALF STAFF AS MEMORAL TO DR. KING. Many callers compalined about the flags flying at half staff, stating the occasion did not warrant such a moe. Veterans, calling this office, stated that they did not fight in World War II and Korea protecting the flag for it to be used for such an occassion. Many complained because the flag covered the casket of Dr. King.

CALLS WANTING THIS OFFICE TO CHECK THE WHEREABOUTS OF RELATIVES LOCATED IN RIOT AREAS. Of all the call received during period, this type was most numerous. Many people aalled wanting the FBI to use its facilities to contact relatives in riot torn cities and establish their well-being. Also many wanted this Bureau to use its influence with the Airlines in connection with passenger list. Many callers when told of the FBI's jurisdiction in personal and domesticmatters, became very angry and threatened to write the president to see if "something con't be done about you people.'

Ather type calls, too numerous to mention, along the same ere received.

Veterans, calling this office, stated that they did not fight in World War II and Korea protecting the flag for it to be used for such an occassion. Many complained because the flag covered the casket of Dr. King.

CALLS WANTING THIS OFFICE TO CHECK THE WHEREABOUTS OF RELATIVES LOCATED IN RIOT AREAS. Of all the calls received during period, this type was most numerous. Many people called wanting the FBI to use its facilities to contact relatives in riot torn cities and establish their well-being. Also many wanted this Bureau to use its influence with the Airlines in connection with passenger list. Many callers when told of the FBI's jurisdiction in personal and domesticmatters, became very angry and threatened to write the president to see if something can't be done about you people."

Ather type calls, too numerous to mention, along the same lines, were received.





Captioned matter is the civil rights investigation to identify the person or persons responsible for the killing of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in Memphis, Tennessee, on 4-4-68.

The Bureau has instructed that all investigation must be afforded immediate, thorough, imaginative attention: that all possibilities from any leads must be exhausted as any one lead could result in the solution of this most important investigation.

In view of the importance of this case, every lead in the Louisville Division must be handled at once and must be given priority over any other investigative matter. Similarly, results of any investigation must be furnished at once to the Bureau. Memphis (their file 44-1987), and Birmingham, as well as any office which will conduct additional investigation based upon our results.

For your additional information, pertinent periods in this investigation are 3-29-68 and 3-30-68 in Birmingham, Alabama, and 4-4-68 in Memphis.

In the event any data is developed regarding suspects, if the whereabouts of such suspects can be determined on the dates mentioned above, this may eliminate the suspect. If this cannot be done, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects in question and forward photographs to Memphis and Birmingham for possible elimination. Pertinent descriptive data should be included with photographs. If unable to eliminate suspects on the basis of established whereabouts during the pertinent periods, efforts should be made to secure fingerprints of a suspect and submit to the Bureau for elimination.
