## Killer Must Be Apprehended Alive-

(Indicate page, name of newspaper, city and state.)

THE CONFUSING REPORTS issued by lawenforcement officials investigating the
murder of Dr. Martin Luther King are disquieting. More and more the killing of Dr.
King begins to look like the work of a conspiracy. If ex-convict James Earl Ray was the
killer, as the FBI says, where did he get the
money he so freely spent? He had no visible
means of support. What was his motive?

It is important that Ray be captured alive. If he isn't, we are likely to be haunted by the same kind of questions that are still unanswered in the assassination of President Kennedy. By describing Ray as "armed and extremely dangerous" in a public announcement, the FBI has decreased the chances of apprehending him alive.

In an editorial over the weekend, The Atlanta Journal said: "We regard it as imperative that James Earl Ray . . . be taken into custody alive and closely protected therefore. If this is the killer, every possible step

must be taken to see that he is not silenced before he talks."

The feeling is growing that Attorney General Ramsey Clark prematurely ruled out aconspiracy theory. Later, in its warrant for the arrest of Galt (or Ray) the FBI charged him with conspiracy without disclosing the scope or nature of it.

This week *Time* magazine reported that a Memphis man "told *Time* and the FBI that he had overheard a local businessman giving an unknown triggerman urgent orders to kill King on the balcony of his motel, and even specifying the price for the job (\$5,000), and the pickup point for the fee." The FBI declined to comment on the report.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN 1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54; AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58. RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY, 1946, TO DECEMBER, 1948, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ARREST. MR. PAGE FOUR BEEN BORN MARCH 10, 1928, IN ILLINOIS; IS APPROXIMATELY 5 FEET 10 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS ABOUT 163 TO 174 POUNDS. HE HAS BLUE EYES AND BROWN HAIR. THERE IS A SMALL SCAR ON THE CENTER OF HIS FOREHEAD AND A SCAR ON THE PALM OF HIS RIGHT HAND. HAY HAS CLAIMED THATTHE ATTENDED SCHOOL THROUGH THE 10TH GRADE IN ALTON: ILLINOIS. 
