"AV" WESTIM, Director, Public Broadcast Laboratory (PBL), 342 Madison Avenue, NYC on 4/19/68, advised that an assistant would aid the FBK in making available tape on questioned broadcast of 4/7/68. He stated that PBL has had employees following the developments leading up to the "poor people's march on Washington" which was to have been led by Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING in the Spring of 1968. He stated that the questioned portion of the broadcast was produced by GREG SMUKER of FBL.

On 4/19/68, PBL made available two film excerpts from the broadcast of 4/7/68 which shows two white males in

background of photograph, either of which could represent the person referred to by Dr. IRVING HALL of Bradenton, Florida. It is further noted, however, that others in the room made similar remarks about the "poor white people getting screwed" if KING led the march.

It is noted that one individual, which according to the tape was located in the area of, or next to, the Negro moderator, who was HOSEA WILLIAMS, seemed to be pulling at his left ear lobe as depicted in the enclosed excerpt from the film.

GREG SHUKER, Producer, PBL, Stated he was in the room during the filming of this sequence of events and identified the location as Paschal's Motel, located on Hunter Street, Atlanta, Georgia. He stated he personally recalls most of the participants in the discussion other than the man with his hand up to his ear. He stated that the Southern Christian Leadership Conference Headquarters (SCLC) in Atlanta is believed to have a list of all persons attending this discussion. He stated that the events took place on 3/14/68 and that BILL RUTHERFORD, Executive Director, and TOM OFFENBERG, Public Relations, SCLC, Office # (404)-522-1420, possibly could furnish names of all persons in the room. RUTHERFORD's home number was given as 523-3381 and that of OFFENBERG, who is Director of the March as 522-1425.

SHUKER stated that other groups and races of people were meeting at the time in the same motel in connection with the upcoming march, but indicated that the group in question was basically white and that HOSEA WILLIAMS came in late only to answer their questions and to convince them that KING would lead and speak for all the poor people, regardless of race, in the March on Washington.

SHUKER is in the process of preparing a copy of the entire tape for the FBI which is to be made available to the NYO possibly today, 4/22/68.

It has been requested by PBL that above excerpts from the tape as well as the othermaterial to be made

available, be used siely by the FBI for their investigative purposes. The film is still being used by PBL and no publication otherwise should be made.

Referenced communication reflected that Géneral Delivery, Atlanta, Georgia was a large manila envelope addressed to ERIC GALT, 9533 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California which address had been crossed out and in turn had been forwarded to General Delivery, Atlanta, Georgia. There was no postmark on the envelope but the reverse side was stamped 4/13/65, Hollywood. The envelope appeared to contain a regular size sheet of paper and a booklet with return address of HEW, Social Security Administration, Baltimore, Maryland.

The files of BA CS-4 were checked and they revealed that a letter postumrked 2/29/68. Los Angeles, California had been mailed to Social Security Administration, Baltimore, Maryland, with return address of ERIC GALT, 5533 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California 90028. The letter itself is dated 2/29/68, is typewritten except for the written signature ERIC GALT and is as follows:



ROBERT B. ERACKER produced a Navy Identification Card reflecting that he retired from the W. S. Navy on March 19. 1965, and was assigned Navy Serial Number He is described as a white male, born

pounds, brown hair and eyes. His residence is 750 North 3rd Street, El Cajon, California. BRACKEN advised he is living temporarily with WAYME RYAN near Lead Hill, Arkansas, Since he has been separated for about a year from his wife and she is obtaining a divorce in California.

ROBERT BRACKEN advised that he has an intense desire to cooperate in every way possible with the FEI and he would furnish any information in his possession. He advised that he arrived in Mountain Home, Arkansas, on Thursday evening, April 4, 1968, at 9:00 PM by bus from Springfield, Missouri. He said this bus arrived in Mountain Home one-half hour early and was scheduled to arrive at 9:30 PM. He was met at the bus in Mountain Home by WAYNE RYAM, who brought him to RYAM's residence near Lead Hill, Arkansas. BRACKEN advised he took a train the same day from Kansas City, Missouri, to Joplin, Missouri, and then rade the bus from Joplin, Missouri, to Springfield, Missouri.

BRACKEN produced a train ticket stub number 83971 dated April 2, 1968, reflecting he left San Diego, California, on the ATLSF Railroad, Seat 65, Card 800, at 4:00 PM on April 2, 1968. He arrived in Los Angeles, California, 6:55 PM and left Los Angeles, California, at 7:30 PM. He arrived in Kansas City, Missouri, at 5:35 AM on April 4, 1968, and departed Kansas City, Missouri, at 9:40 AM on the same day, destined for Joplin, Missouri, where he arrived about Moon. His train fare was \$59.10 with an extra fare of \$3.75 and a tax of \$2.00, making a total of \$64.85.

BRACKEN further produced an insurance policy, number 6267330, for BORERT BRACKEN, effective 3:30 PM, April 2, 1968, at San Diego, California.

BRACKEN then produced an identification check number 960106 for the MK&O Bus Lines of Tulsa, Oklahoma, stamped April 4, 1968, at Joplin, Missouri. Included with this identification check was insurance policy number 174170B with the C. T. Life and Accident Insurance Company of Lincoln, Nebraska, effective April 4, 1968, at 4:00 PM for one day on Continental Trailways at Joplin, Missouri.

BRACKEN advised that he talked with the driver of the bus from Springfield, Missouri, to Mountain Home, Arkansas, on the night of April 4, 1968, all the way from Springfield to Mountain Home and the driver told him, BRACKEN, that he lived at Mountain Home. BRACKEN advised that this is as close as he ever got to Memphis, Tennessee, on this trip.

BRACKEN further advised that he well recalls drinking rather heavily at the Valley Inn, El Cajon, California, on April 2, 1968, before going to San Diego by car to catch the train there. He said after arriving on the train he continued drinking rather heavily and "had a ball all the way to Kansas City."

BRACKEN advised that he was stationed in the Navy in Memphis, Tennessee, at the Naval Air Station there from 1961 to 1963, and he knew the people in Memphis and these people are very peaceful and kind and would not put up with a bunch of people burning the town down. said that he does recall saying, "If KING goes to Memphis the second time to rabble rouse, he'll be killed." He said that he meant by this that the people are peaceful in Memphis, but they would not put up with someone destroying their town and that he firmly believed something would happen to KING if he returned to that town. He said that he certainly did not mean that he was going to do anything about KING and he had no recollection whatsoever of making any such statement that he had been paid \$5,000.00 or any other amount of money to make an attempt on KING's life. He said that he had been talking to some other men in the bar at El Cajony California, and he believes he mentioned to these men that he had been stationed in the Navy at Memphis, Tennessee, several years ago, but he definitely made no statement indicating that he himself was going to make any attempt on KING's life, and since the other persons LR 157-1215

in the bar had been drinking, also, it is his opinion that someone must have misconstrued what he said at the time.

BRACKEN advised that he does not believe in violence, that he realizes sometimes when he has been drinking he may brag and boast a little, but he said that this is liquor talking and he definitely would not attack anyone or cause them any harm. BRACKEN advised that he has no idea of the identity of the person or persons who might have murdered MARTIN LUTHER KING, but that it did not come as a complete surprise to him because he felt in his own mind that something very serious would happen to KING if he dared go back to Memphis, Tennessee.


BRACKEN advised that he intends to stay for some length of time with WAYNE RYAN here at Lead Hill, Arkansas, and that he is in the process of negotiating to attempt to buy some land nearby where he can settle down. He stated that at any time he would be available for interview should the occasion become necessary, that he has absolutely nothing to hide from the FBI or anybody else, and he is willing to cooperate in any possible fashion.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Mr. LOY "EUCK" GREEN, Boone County Deputy Shariff and former ABC Agent, advised that he is well acquainted with WAYER RYAN, who lives just over the line in Marion County about seven or eight miles east of Lead Hill, Arkan-GREEN advised that RYAN raises hogs and is an ex-Navy man who appears to be of good character and reputation and has lived around here for three or four years.

Mr. CREEN further advised that an individual named BOE DRACKER, an alcoholic, came into Lead Hill with a woman about a year ago and he, along with WAYNE RYAH, leased a cafe building here in Lead Hill and operated it for several months until they went out of business and BRACKER left here. He returned about two months ago, alone, possibly in early March 1968, and stayed at Lead Hill motel for a short time and then moved into a cabin located near WAYNE BYAN's hog ranch east of here. GREEN advised that he believes BRACKEN is a diabetic, according to BRACKEN's own statement, and through his, GREEN's, observation, BEACKEN has been a very heavy drinker. the latter part of March 1968, BRACKEN left here by bus for an unknown destination, but GREEN advised he believes BRACKEN returned to California. Mr. GREEN stated that he would accompany SA LUPTON out to locate WAYNE RYAN and make further effort to locate BOB BRACKEN for interview.

WAYME RYAN was located and interviewed at his residence several miles east of Lead Hill, Arkansas. He advised he is a retired U. S. Havy veteran and has lived out here for about four years and is raising hogs for market. He advised that BOB BRACKEN is here now and is asleep in his trailer.

WAYNE RYAN advised further that BOR BRACKER called him from Springfield, Missouri, about 5:00 PM in the afternoon of April 4, 1968, requesting that he meet the bus at Mountain Home, Arkansas, at about 9:30 PM and bring him, BRACKEN, back to Lead Hill to visit with RYAN. KYAN advised that he recalled the exact date because after BRACKEN had called, he remembers turning on the radio for the 6:00 o'clock news and heard an announcement that MARTIN LUTHER KING had been shot in Memphis, Tennessee He then left Lead Hill about 6:30 PM to go to Mountain Home, Arkansas, to pick up BRACKEN at the bus station. bus was due to arrive at 9:30 PM but actually arrived at 9:00 PM, one-half hour early. He said he saw BRACKEN get off the bus which was a small bus and not the large type used for travel between large cities and over long distances and BRACKEN was sitting near the driver. BRACKEN told RYAN later that the driver was an ex-sailor who lives in Mountain Home, Arkensas. BRACKEN told WAYNE RYAN that only a few people got on the bus at Springfield and they dropped them all off until he was riding alone with the driver coming into Mountain Home. RYAN advised that BRACKEN has been staying here ever since arriving on the night of April 4, 1968; has been living with him here in his trailer and he has not had a single drink since that time.

WAYNE RYAN advised that he was in the Navy with BOB BRACKEN, who also retired from the Navy about two or three years ago. He said that BRACKEN has become a very heavy drinker and when he is drinking he often states that he is going to kill a particular captain who had kicked him, BRACKEN, off of an aircraft carrier while he was in the Navy. BRACKEN only does this when he has been drinking heavily and he always said that he is going to get this

If something does not go right when BRACKEN is drinking and he gets upset or angry, he usually makes this statement because he states that this captain has ruined his life, but he never mentions the captain by name. RYAN advised he has never heard BRACKEN make a threat to kill any other person.
