In view of the fact DE LUCA advised that an undetermined number of individuals have handled the enclosures, and because Los Angeles is unaware of the details of the investigation surrounding captioned case, the above evidence is being furnished to the Memphis Division rather than being submitted to the FBI Laboratory and further leads are being left to the discretion of the office of origin.

Inasmuch as the postal guide shows there is both a Perry, Florida, and a Perry, Georgia, information copies of this communication are being furnished to those offices covering these locations.

FD-302 will be prepared on above-described investigation, and will be retained by the Los Angeles Division unless advised to to the contrary by Memphis.



FRANKLIN FREDERICK ALBERT BULTEMEYER was approached by Special Agent JAMES W. NORMENT JR. on the mall at 12th Street and Washington Drive S.W. SA NORMENT immediately identified himself as a Special Agent for the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and advised BULTEMEYER that he did not have to make any statements.

BULTEMEYER immediately made available an Indiana drivers license reflecting his name as above and that he was born ; he also made available a United States Merchant Marine identification card dated May 19, 1954, reflecting the same birth date. BULTEMEYER then voluntarily accompanied SA NORMENT to the Washington Field Office (WFO) where he was immediately given a yoluntary appearance advise of rights form which he read. He declined to sign the waiver but stated that he would voluntarily answer questions and allow his photograph and fingerprints to be taken.

After having his fingerprints and photographs taken he furnished the following information concerning himself. He has traveled about the country for the past 20 years working as a Merchant Seaman and construction worker. During the past year he has travaled to Jacksonville, Tampa, and New Orleans, and arrived in Washington, D.C. (WDC), about three weeks ago. Since then he has attempted to find construction work in and around WDC and on one occasion hitchhiked to Richmond, Virginia, without locating employment. Since his arrival in WDC he has spent the nights sleeping in the parks near the Potomac River. He was in WBC on Thursday, April 4, 1968.

The following description and background information was obtained from observation and statements by BULTEMEYER:

On April 10, 1968, information was received that an individual matching the description of the subject that shot MARTIN LUTHER KING was on the mall at 12th Street and Washington Drive S.W. This individual was described as unkept and carrying a brown napsack.

SA JAMES W. NORMENT subsequently observed an individual matching this description at that intersection. The individual identified himself as FRANKLIN FREDERICK ALBERTBULTEMEYER and voluntarily accompanied SA NORMENT to the Washington Field Office where he was photographed and fingerprinted. The fingerprints were immediately taken to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Identification Division and no identifiable record was located. A comparison of BULTEMEYER's fingerprints were made with the latent fingerprints obtained in this investigation and they were not identical.

BULLMEYER's prints were checked through the fugitive index with negative results.
