If not already handled, you should exhibit photographs of Ray to J. W. Farris and personnel at the William Len Hotel. You should attempt to obtain registration cards and/or any other identifying data which would disclose handwriting and/or possible latent fingerprints of Vincent Walker and Lawrence Rand. Determine whether or not Walker and Rand made or received any telephone calls while registered at the hotel and if so attempt to determine whom they may have contacted or by whom they were contacted. Recontact personnel at Delta Airlines, Memphis, and personnel at the Municipal Airport in an effort to further identify W. Davis and B. Chidlow and conduct necessary investigation to determine whether or not Davis or Chidlow are identical with Walker and Rand.

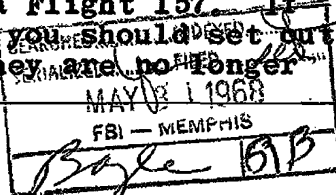

Pages three and four of rerep set forth information furnished by Lupy Delao who operated the limousine which transported six persons from the Houston Airport during the early morning of April 5, 1968. According to Delao, three of the men were dropped at the Sheraton-Lincoln Hotel, two were dropped at the Rice Hotel and one was dropped at the Downtowner Motel. Investigation was conducted by Houston at the Rice Hotel, as well as neighboring hotels; however, there is no indication of any investigation being conducted at either the Sheraton-Lincoln Hotel or the Downtowner Motel. Delao also advised that the two individuals he dropped at the Rice Hotel indicated at first that they intended to be dropped at the Downtowner Motel.

If not already handled, Houston should immediately conduct additional investigation at the Sheraton-Lincoln Hotel and the Downtowner Motel, as well as other hotels and motels near those two sites. Determine if any guests checked in following the arrival of Delta Flight 157. If such persons are located and identified, you should set out appropriate leads to interview them if they are no longer *ADDED*

in Houston. Through the records of Delta Airlines, Houston should also determine other persons who were aboard the flight and attempt to identify, locate and interview.

Memphis, if not already handled, should determine whether or not Walter and Rand had reservations at the William Len Hotel. Also determine the method utilized in paying for their rooms - cash, check or credit card. Determine from car rental agencies in the area of the William Len whether any vehicles were rented during the pertinent period to individuals named Davis, Chidlow, Walter or Rand.

This phase of the investigation is to be given your continued expeditious attention so that it may be resolved at the earliest possible time.
