

SUBJECT: MURKIN

On instant date, CERALDINE MARIE TANNER, a prostitute presently incarcerated at the Portland Jail, Portland, Oregon, upon request was interviewed by SA WILLIAM A. TENWICK, Portland Division. She made available a copy of a letter (one xerox copy enclosed for San Francisco and Memphis) which she received from PEARL R. MILLER Paka KATHY LAWTON, Proof 52, London Lodge Motel, Broadway at 7th Street, Oakland, California. In the letter the following quotation is contained: "I knew whites was going to kill that man," referring to KING.

TANNER states that she is well acquainted with MILLER and she insists that MILLER knows something about the individual who killed KING. She is unable to give any basis for this supposition other than she knows MILLER so well and this is so "unlike her" that she is confident MILLER has knowledge of the murder.

MILLER apparently left Phoenix, Arizona, 3/26/68 for Oakland, California. Under Portland PD File #44-261, she has a prior arrest for prostitution.

Mrs. WALTON visited her husband on Sun., 4/7/68, in the Ohio State Penitentiary (GEP), Solumbus, Ohio, where he is presently incorcerated on local charges of Forgery and Carrying Concealed Weepon, Inmate No. 123910. WALTON told his wife that a couple of years ago while he was down South (Ala.), a group of individuals, not further identified, offered him, WALTON, a lot of maney to kill MARTIN LITHER KING, Jr. At this time WALTON was also going to join an organization, name not recalled.

WALTON RECALLED THAT RESTAURANT ADJACENT TO MAC'S TRUCK STOP WHICH IS CALLED MAC'S BUT IS NOT OWNED BY ELKINS. MAN AND WIFE, NAMES AND DESCRIPTION UNRECALLED, OPERATING THAT RESTAURANT ARE STAUNCH MEMBERS OF KKK. On 4/8/68, Mrs. GERTRUDE KING, Driver's License Bureau, Montgomery, Ala., advised that she could find no record for a driver's license being issued to RAY H. CLINE She stated, however, that their files reflect a RAY H. CLENE 3316 Loch Haven, Montgomery, was arrested in Montgomery on 5/15/66, for speeding. He was fined \$15. According to their records he was born on and had a driver's license issued to a TOMMIE ALLEN, OSt. Stephens, Ala., number in his possession. Mrs. KING advised that this born driver's license issued to TOMMIE ALLEN was revoked on 5/9/63. and this number has not been issued since 1953. She stated that TOMMIE ALLEN, born has a current Ala. license , issued on 12/9/53. According to the driver's license he is described as a W/M, 160 pounds, 5' 11", blue eyes, gray hair. In 1953 ALLEN was charged with driving while intoxicated but the charge was reduced to reckless driving and this occurred in Clarke County. He was fined \$123. At that time he was driving a pick-up truck. In 1953 he was employed by Clarke Co. Motors, Jackson, Ala.

She stated they sold this vehicle to RAY KINCAID, who was visiting his sister, LUCILLE SPIVEY, 1036 Zephyr Hills Drive, Montgomery. She said that to the best of her recollection KINCAID came to Montgomery about the first of March, 1968, from Cleveland, Ohio, and departed Montgomery on Saturday night, 4/6/68, for his home in Cleveland, Ohio. He was employed by Kershaw Mfg. Co., Montgomery, Ala., while visiting with his sister.

On 4/9/68, Mrs. LINDA BLACKWELL, Secretary, Personnel Dept., Kershaw Mfg. Co., 2205 W. Fairview Ave., Montgomery, Ala., advised that according to their records LOWELL RAY KINCAID, 1036 Zephyr Hills, Montgomery, Ala., born , was employed by the firm on 3/13/68, and according to their records is still so employed. She stated, however, that he did not report for work on Monday, 4/8/68 or Tuesday 4/9/68. According to their records he has Social Security No. He indicated he is married and has no children. 

BURTON interviewed Reverend FLOYD BROWER 2709 Big Bend, Poplar Bluff, Mo., concerning the statements he made from the Senath, Mo., Methodist Church pulpit that he was sorry to hear of KING's death, but would be even "sorrier" when the announcement was made identifying the person who did it. The Reverend BROWER advised that the basis for this statement was an article in either the St. Louis Globe Democrat or one of the local Southeast Missouri newspapers, which stated that the search for MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassin had spread to the Bootheel area of Missouri and that he was possibly from Pemiscot County. He also had heard several "rumors" that the assassin was from Pemiscot County. He advised he had no other basis whatsoever for making the statement, had never heard anyone mention any names of a possible assassin and was now sorry that he had made such a statement from the pulpit.
