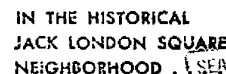

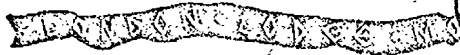

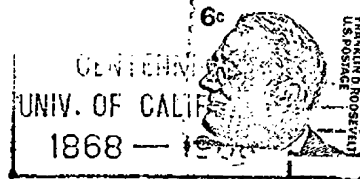

On instant date, GERALDINE MARIE TANNER, a prostitute presently incarcerated at the Portland Jail, Portland, Oregon, upon request was interviewed by SA WILLIAM A. TENWICK, Portland Division. She made available a copy of a letter (one xerox copy enclosed for San Francisco and Memphis) which she received from PEARL R. MILLER aka KATHY LAWTON, Room 52, London Lodge Motel, Broadway at 7th Street, Oakland, California. In the letter the following quotation is contained: "I knew whites was going to kill that man," referring to KING.

TANNER states that she is well acquainted with MILLER and she insists that MILLER knows something about the individual who killed KING. She is unable to give any basis for this supposition other than she knows MILLER so well and this is so "unlike her" that she is confident MILLER has knowledge of the murder.

MILLER apparently left Phoenix, Arizona, 3/26/68 for Oakland, California. Under Portland PD File #44-261, she has a prior arrest for prostitution.

Re Portland airtel to San Francisco, dated 4/10/68.

On April 12, 1968, Miss PEARLIE REE MILLER, aka PEARL MILLER, HELEN BROWN, JANICE MARIE LANE, KATHY LAWTON, SHIRLEY ANN WHITE, a Negro prostitute, born [redacted], at Idabel, Oklahoma, was located and interviewed by SAs FRANK UNDERWOOD III and DOUGLAS CORRIGAN at the London Lodge Motel, Room 71, Broadway and Seventh Streets, Oakland, California, where she has resided for two weeks, registered as KATHY LAWTON.

Miss MILLER stated that the basis for the quotation contained in her letter of April 8, 1968, to GERALDINE MARIE TANNER, Portland, Oregon, "I knew whites was going to kill that man," referring to MARTIN LUTHER KING, was the fact that MEDGER EVERS had been previously killed by a white person and, therefore, she felt that eventually KING also would be killed by whites. She stated that she feels that eventually STOKELY CARMICHAEL, H. RAP BROWN, and other leaders involved in the black civil rights struggle will also be killed by whites.

Miss MILLER emphatically denied having any knowledge as to the perpetrator of the KING murder. She stated that the basis of the aforementioned quotation was completely misinterpreted by TANNER.

Miss MILLER disclaimed membership in any organization or associations with members of any organization.

On 4/10/68, Mrs. MILBRED WALTON, wife of former PCI, telephonically contacted SA MICHAEL J. MANANEY, Jr., and advised as follows:

Mrs. WALTON visited her husband on Sun., 4/7/68, in the Ohio State Penitentiary (OSP), Columbus, Ohio, where he is presently incarcerated on local charges of Forgery and Carrying Concealed Weapon, Inmate No. 123910. WALTON told his wife that a couple of years ago while he was down South (Ala.), a group of individuals, not further identified, offered him, WALTON, a lot of money to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr. At this time WALTON was also going to join an organization, name not recalled.

WALTON RECALLED THAT RESTAURANT ADJACENT TO MAC'S TRUCK STOP WHICH IS CALLED MAC'S BUT IS NOT OWNED BY ELKINS. MAN AND WIFE, NAMES AND DESCRIPTION UNRECALLED, OPERATING THAT RESTAURANT ARE STAUNCH MEMBERS OF KKK. DEWEY (LNU), WHOSE SISTER IS WIFE OF OWNER OF THAT RESTAURANT, IS CHARACTERISED BY WALTON AS MOST VICIOUS INDIVIDUAL IN THAT AREA. WALTON INDICATES DEWEY (LNU) CAPABLE OF MURDER. CLINE, 3316 Loch Haven, Montgomery, Ala., for a 1959 Ford four-door. This vehicle has identification number B9PT106857 and was registered on 11/2/67, by RAY H. CLINE.

On 4/8/68, Mrs. GERTRUDE KING, Driver's License Bureau, Montgomery, Ala., advised that she could find no record for a driver's license being issued to RAY H. CLINE. She stated, however, that their files reflect a RAY H. CLINE, 3316 Loch Haven, Montgomery, was arrested in Montgomery on 5/15/66, for speeding. He was fined \$15. According to their records he was born on [redacted] and had a driver's license number [redacted] issued to a TOMMIE ALLEN, St. Stephens, Ala., born [redacted] in his possession. Mrs. KING advised that this driver's license issued to TOMMIE ALLEN was revoked on 5/9/63, and this number has not been issued since 1953. She stated that TOMMIE ALLEN, born [redacted] has a current Ala. license [redacted], issued on 12/9/53. According to the driver's license he is described as a W/M, 160 pounds, 5' 11", blue eyes, gray hair. In 1953 ALLEN was charged with driving while intoxicated but the charge was reduced to reckless driving and this occurred in Clarke County. He was fined \$123. At that time he was driving a pick-up truck. In 1953 he was employed by Clarke Co. Motors, Jackson, Ala.

The 1968 City Directory contains a listing for RAY H. CLINE, wife LUCILLE E., residing at 3316 Loch Haven Rd., Montgomery. The directory indicated CLINE to be in the USAF.

She stated they sold this vehicle to RAY KINCAID, who was visiting his sister, LUCILLE SPIVEY, 1036 Zephyr Hills Drive, Montgomery. She said that to the best of her recollection KINCAID came to Montgomery about the first of March, 1968, from Cleveland, Ohio, and departed Montgomery on Saturday night, 4/6/68, for his home in Cleveland, Ohio. He was employed by Kershaw Mfg. Co., Montgomery, Ala., while visiting with his sister.

On 4/9/68, Mrs. LINDA BLACKWELL, Secretary, Personnel Dept., Kershaw Mfg. Co., 2205 W. Fairview Ave., Montgomery, Ala., advised that according to their records LOWELL RAY KINCAID, 1036 Zephyr Hills, Montgomery, Ala., born [redacted], was employed by the firm on 3/13/68, and according to their records is still so employed. She stated, however, that he did not report for work on Monday, 4/8/68 or Tuesday 4/9/68. According to their records he has Social Security No. [redacted]. He indicated he is married and has no children. He was employed as a welder in the welding shop. One photo each of **EUGENE SMITH MANSFIELD** is being enclosed for Birmingham, Memphis and Jackson.

Investigation previously conducted by the New Orleans Office to locate and interview **MANSFIELD** determined that he worked in Grand Isle, La., in late 1967 as a welder with Grand Isle Shipyards and Buras Construction Company.

ANDREW ADAMS, Grand Isle, La., associated with **PERCY CROSBY**, Grand Isle, advised on 3/25/68, that **MANSFIELD** left the area in January, 1968, after being gone for several days at a time on several prior occasions. He is living with **CROSBY**'s 19 or 20 year old daughter, **MERLYN CROSBY**, and reportedly has left a wife and four children somewhere, place unknown to **ADAMS**.

ADAMS said he co-signed note when **MANSFIELD** bought a 1968 blue Ford pickup truck at Ford dealer, Lockport, La, and financed same through Commercial Securities, Co., Lockport.

MANSFIELD, according to **ADAMS**, is an alcoholic and was previously in Grand Isle about a year or more ago when arrested by Jefferson Parish SO for stabbing at Tony Marullo's Bar.

Manager, Moore Business Forms, Inc., 601 E. Hickory, advised
that D. WESLEY MITCHELL is a current employee and has been
employed as a senior design artist since August, 1958. MURRELL
advised that MITCHELL was believed employed on 3/29 and 30/68,
and 4/4/68, and this could be better established on the
following date since MURRELL does not punch a time card.

He described MITCHELL as follows:

Mrs. RUBY DANSEY, owner and manager of the Belvoir Grill, 9100 Richmond Highway, U. S. 1, Fairfax Co., Va., phoned Fairfax Co., Va. PD night of 4/10/68 and they in turn, phoned WFO to advise that DANSEY served an unknown itinerant on 4/10/68, whom she thought resembled the artist's conception of subject which had appeared in local newspapers.

Mrs. DANSEY was interviewed by SA ROLAND M. COCKER 4/11/68 and advised that the description of the itinerant who came to her Grill was 54 years of age, 5'8", 155 lbs., sandy-graying hair, thin mustache, blue eyes, no car, and without money. She later saw the artist's conception appearing in the local newspapers and believed the itinerant to have resembled the artist's sketch. She advised she has not maintained the dinner utensils used by this person. This description was also furnished by ROSE "FRENCHIE" KELLY, a waitress who also saw the itinerant.

In view of the wide discrepancy of the physical description of the itinerant from that of the subject, no further action is being taken in this regard.

WILLIAM JOYNER, Bureau of Identification, Fayetteville, North Carolina, Police Department, advised on April 7, 1968, that GEORGE WILBUR BREECE is the son of J. WILBUR BREECE, who operates a funeral home at 123 Bow Street in Fayetteville, which is located directly across the street from the Police Department.

Mr. JOYNER stated he is acquainted with BREECE and saw him last week in Fayetteville in United States Army fatigues. He was driving a late model green automobile which was believed to be a Mustang or Cougar and he observed over the sun visor a sign with the words "Army Mortuary Service."

Mr. JOYNER stated that BREECE is of similar stature and bears a resemblance to the composite photograph of the suspect in the KING assassination, however, his nose is not as prominent as the nose shown on the photograph.

AT FORT BRAGG, NORTH CAROLINA

Desk Sergeant J. N. STEVENSON, Provost Marshal's Office, advised on April 7, 1968, that his records contained the name of Specialist Fourth-Class GEORGE W. BREECE, Army Serial Number [REDACTED] who was as of February, 1968, assigned to Headquarters Company, United States Army Garrison, Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

Sergeant J. H. BURKE, Headquarters Company, United States Army Garrison, advised that he has no records available at this time of the morning to indicate the whereabouts or duty status of Specialist BREECE, but stated these records would be available possibly in the later morning hours or not until Monday morning, April 8, 1968.
