On 4/11/68 Mr. GENE GETT, 2490 Browning Circle, Memphis, Tennessee, telephone number 452-1049, telephonically contacted the Memphis Office and advised that he knows a person who has a white Mustang and operates a citizens band radio, who resides at Memphis, Tennessee. GETT stated that he met this individual at a Saturday morning ham radio operators' breakfast at Ferguson's Cafe on Summer Avenue in Memphis approximately 6 months ago. GETT advised that this individual goes under the radio name of "Honest Herc." GETT further advised that all radio operators operate on citizens band #3.

GETT advised that he believes "Honest Herc" is employed at a used car lot in the northeast section of Memphis and was described as being a white male, 6 feet, slender build, about 35 or 36 years of age, with a receding hairline.

No lead is being set forth at this time to locate and interview "Honest Herc," owner, white Mustang with citizens band radio, and this is being left to the discretion of the reviewing Agent.

On April 15, 1968, THOMAS BENTON, Criminal Investigations Division, advised that Corporal DONALD G. DENTON, Marine Serial Number [REDACTED], MAD, NATTC, Naval Air Station, Memphis, Tennessee, was residing at the Base Motel, 133 Main Street, Havelock, North Carolina. He advised that DENTON stated he was driving a 1965 white Mustang, two door, with Tennessee License KN-3502, with a Mississippi driver's license. DENTON stated that the Memphis Police Department had confiscated his car because he thought he had killed MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

BENTON advised that he had been in contact with the Marine Corps Air Station, at Memphis and that DENTON is on leave from April 6, 1968, through April 22, 1968.

HARRY CRISIAN, Manager, Base Motel, advised that DENTON had resided at his motel since April 9, 1968. He advised he considers DENTON "weird" and said he married a Cherry Point, North Carolina, servicewoman on April 12, 1968. He said DENTON very rarely leaves the motel.
