CECIL R. TOMPKINS, Deputy Sheriff, Shelby County, Tenn., personally appeared at the Memphis Office of the FBI at approximately 11:00 a.m. 4/15/68 to disclose the identity of an individual he feels would be capable of committing captioned crime. He identified this person as WILLARD FROGG or FROGUE, a native of Jamestown, Tenn. TOMPKINS was a law enforcement officer in Jamestown from 1949 through 1953 and recalled that in addition to WILLARD there were three other FROGG brothers, WILLIAM FROGG who is currently head of the ATU at Memphis; (FNU) FROGUE; and a brother who was killed by a sheriff near Jamestown, Tenn., in a gun battle. Following this killing, the remaining FROGG brothers ambushed the sheriff's wife, children and collie dog in their automobile, shot up the car and severely wounded the sheriff's wife. She survived the incident, and while he recalled that the brothers were arrested and that the circumstantial evidence against them was very good, they were never prosecuted for the crime.

He further recalled that either WILLARD FROGG or the brother whose first name he could not recall was a Merchant Seaman. The younger FROGG brother would now be approximately 32 to 34 years of age. All of the brothers were "lovers of guns" and had an extensive gun collection. He recalled that the brothers on various occasions harassed law enforcement personnel in the Jamestown, Tenn., area, causing a number of these persons to resign. They also reportedly "treed the town" on a number of occasions with the use of dynamite and firearms and three times caused martial law to be invoked.

TOMPKINS does not have any real reason to suppose that the FROGG brothers are connected with instant matter and has furnished this information for evaluation.

A man identifying himself as DAVID JONES, 1821 South Riggins, Norfolk, Va., telephone # 583-2316, contacted the Memphis Office at 9:30 p.m. 4/7/68. He advised he was calling from a telephone booth in New York and had been requested by a friend to call to advise that a "young Negro", 6', heavy set, whose home is in California, was arriving in Memphis on a late flight for the purpose of locating the man who shot Dr. KING. The caller advised he had no further information as to the identity of the "young Negro" and in response to questions probing the matter, repeated only that he had been requested to call and did not want anything to happen to the boy. He said the boy would call this office and say he is the party who requested JONES to call.

In response to the question as to whether this boy had any information concerning the shooting of Dr. KING, the caller said he did not know but felt the boy had kept up with the situation and would have a purpose in travelling to Memphis.

No such individual is known to have contacted the Memphis Office.

At approximately 9:00 AM, 4/15/68, an individual who identified himself as C. M. HARRISON, Mattiesburg, Miss., furnished the following information telephonically:

HARRISON has observed information which has appeared in the Memphis "Commercial Appeal" regarding the murder of Dr. KING. He also has observed the drawing of the Unknown Subject which appeared in the "Commercial Appeal."

On Tuesday, April 9, 1968, HARRISON had lunch at the Northern Heights Restaurant on Highway 49. There is a service station operated in connection with this restaurant. HARRISON was in the restaurant from approximately 12:30 PM until 1:15 or 1:25 PM. He sat at one end of the counter and observed at the other end of the counter a person who resembled the drawing in the "Commercial Appeal." HARRISON observed this man who appeared to be watching everything that was going on in the restaurant. The man appeared to be very tired. Description given by HARRISON of the suspect is as follows:

was hung in the rear of the car near the left window. HARRISON observed this man turn off of Highway 49 onto a truck route going through Hattiesburg. The individual drove at a rapid rate and looked behind him as if to see if anyone followed

HARRISON has furnished the same information to the FBI Agent in Hattiesburg. He felt that since the Memphis Office of the FBI appeared to be running the investigation, he considered it important to make the information available to the Memphis

One important difference between the description of the man HARRISON saw and that of the UNSUB is the complexion. HARRISON described the unknown individual as having a well tanned complexion. The complexion of GALT has not been described as tan but more of the type that has been indoors.

He stated that on the morning of 4/5/68, the day following the murder of Dr. KING, as he was leaving his motel, room, #221, he noticed the following described person emerge from room #222:

The person proceeded to a late model, possibly 1968, Oldsmobile Toronado, bronze in color, bearing Louisiana license, tossed the revolvers in the front seat of the car, entered the car and departed. BROOKS did not take notice of the license number of the car, however, feels it would be available through Holiday Inn records.

BROOKS has made no further effort to identify this person and does not know whether or not this person might be connected with captioned case but felt this information should be brought to the attention of the FBI.

Pedre Island, Texas, advised that on the past Saturday night he went by the home of BILL HUCKABYA Missouri carpenter doing work for him, re additional work desired. A drinking party was in progress, and he was introduced to persons present including a man who had just driven in from Tennessee. He mentioned "it must be a mess back there", and the Tennessee man replied "it's only the beginning; if RAP BROWN or STOKELY CARNICHAEL show up there, they wont last 15 minutes", and further stated it was a woman rather than a man who killed KIRG. On Tuesday, 1/9/68, this same Tennessee man came to do the work requested by LEONARD. That evening LEONARD watched the Walter Cronkite TV newscast and saw the artist's sketch of the murder suspect who was believed driving a white car, and he had a feeling he had seen this individual. On Wednesday norming he suddenly realized the Tennessee man was a "dead ringer" for the artist's sketch. He recalled the man was referred to as DAVE.

DAVID DEWITT GREER, aks "Dave", located at the waterfront residence of HUCKABY in Port Isabel, Texas, advised as follows:

He has been residing for some time at Rt. 7, Sparts. Tens., property ewaed by J. W. OERTLA Laho manages the Travelodge Motel at Reanake, Va., as caretaker working on the side as carpenter, and he was there during March, 1968, and to 4/5/68.
