Mr. Davis stated he did not know for sure, but he suspected it had something to do with the murder of Dr. King and with Eric Starvo Galt. Davis stated he would write the writer's name of the envelope and mail it to the Memphis FBI Office.

# POSSIBLE SUSPECT SUGGESTED BY MILTON (NO MIDDLE NAME) LAMOUREAUX, 135 E. SPEEDWAY, TUSUON, ARIZONA

On April 6, 1968, MILTON (NO MIDDLE NAME) LAMOUREAUX, 135½ E. Speedway, Tuscon, Afizona, advised the Phoenix Office of the FBI that on or about January 29, 1964 he was staying at Smitty's Motel, Hartford, Alabama, when he was beaten and robbed and left unconscious on top of a heater in his room. He said that prior to the beating he was with the owner of the motel, SMITTY (LAST NAME UNKNOWN), when he observed a white male, age 31 to 33, 5'10" to 6' tall, dark blond hair, medium build, 165 pounds, regular style haircut, neatly combed, very clean and dressed neatly, to wit, a white uniform, possibly a laundry truck driver. He said that this individual presented an excellent likeness to an artist's sketch of the assassin of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., which he had observed on April 6, 1968.

The following investigation was conducted by SA RAY-MOND J. MAXWELL:

### AT HARTFORD, ALABAMA:

On April 8, 1968, HOUSTON A. SMITH, owner and Operator, Smitty's Hotel, advised that he remembers MILTON LAUDUREAUX of Tuscon, Arizona, staying at his hotel for two days around January, 1964. He stated that when LAMOUREAUX checked into the hotel on a Saturday night he was very dirty and told him he had been beaten by three men at Leon's Restaurant, Dothan, Alabama. He advised that after this person checked in on Saturday night he did not see him over the weekend. He went to LAMOUREAUX's room on Monday morning and found him passed out on the floor with the heater in the room turned up all the way with no windows open for ventilation, LAMOUREAUX had been drinking and taking some sort of pills. He was taken to a hospital and subsequently released to his mother who came from Arizona.

SMRTH stated LAMCUREAUX subsequently tried to bring suit against him, charging he had been beaten and robbed at his, SMITH's hotel, but investigation showed he was not beaten in Hartford, but was involved in a fight at Dothan, Alabama. Dr. SAM WINDHAM of Dothan had treated him.

SMITH stated he recalls no one coming to the hotel wearing a white uniform. He stated that on occasions he obtains linen supplies from the Pensacola, Florida, Linen supply

Company, but the drivers for this firm do not wear white uniforms. He stated they wear regular clothing. He advised he has no idea who LAMCUREAUX might be referring to as a person resembling the artist's conception of the killer of KING. He stated he, SMITH, saw this sketch in the Montgomery Advertiser, and it did not look familiar to him.

BUCHANAN was asked if he knew an individual named DONALD SPARKS or GENE SPARKS to which he promptly replied. "Who. TWO JUMPS?" He was thereafter shown as photograph of DONALD EUGENE SPARKS, Tulsa, Oklahoma Police Department Number 38224 dated September 7, 1963. BUCHANAN promptly identified this photograph of SPARKS as being identical to the person he has known for many years as "TWO JUMPS." BUCHANAN went on to relate that SPARKS got the nickname of "TWO JUMPS from his ability as a cowboy and according to BUCHANAN, SPARKS was an excellent "broncho buster" and could ride almost any horse. BUCHANAN considered SPARKS to be an extremely hard and tough individual who would not hesitate to kill anyone. Extensive investigation was conducted in several field offices to concretely identify "TWO JUMPS" and from the identification of PCI CLENNIE JOE BUCHANAN, Jackson, Mississippi, it was felt that DONALD EUGENE SAPRKS was identical to "TWO JUMPS."

Investigation by the Jackson Division at the Terrymore Motel in Jackson failed to disclose any registration that could be identified as being that of SPARKS. In addition to the above identification of SPARKS as "TWO JUMPS", Phoenix CI PX 737-C was interviewed at Phoenix on 1/26/65. This informant advised he knew DONALD EUGENE SPARKS and was well aware that SPARKS' nickname is "TWO JUMPS."

Based on this identification on 5/14/65, an attempt was made to interview DONALD EUGENE SPARKS, Inmate Number 71755, at the Oklahoma State Penitentiary. Following his being advised of his rights, SPARKS stated at the outset he would not furnish any information. He did deny being contacted by anyone at any time to commit a murder and said he did not kill anyone for money or any other reason. He denied ever being hired by anyone in the South and specifically in Mississippi to commit any murder. He denied knowing anyone connected with the Ku Klux Klan.

SPARKS at this time stated he had never cooperated with any police officers and did not intend to start doing so now. He said he had been contacted by numerous officers and would appreciate it if police officers would not bother him again since they wasted his time, as he was working in the plumbing shop in the Penitentiary and could not be away from his job. SPARKS terminated the interview by getting up and leaving the room.

OC 44-686 By airtel to the Bureau dated 5/17/65, in case "WHITE KNIGHTS OF KU KLUX KLAN OF MISSISSIPPI, RACIAL MATTER", the Bureau was advised of the attempted interview with SPARKS. Additionally, 9 copies of an FD 302 dated 5/17/65, was furnished to the Jackson Division. This showed the interview with SPARKS. At that time, it was the considered opinion of Agents that had worked cases involving SPARKS. his associates, and Agents who handled the former case involving former Top Ten Fugitive JOHN GIBSON DILLON, that information that SPARKS was hired to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and that he did kill DILLON was not accurate nor truthful information. It was pointed out that following DILLON's murder there was a massive amount of rumor, speculation and hearsay information circulated among the criminal element concerning the death of DILLON. It was this hearsay information that was probably being reported by Jackson's informant in all honesty. The Bureau's attention is directed to the fact that HERMIT EUGENE WING aka, ANTI-RACKETEERING, is the subject of a current pending file, Oklahoma City 92-588, Bureau file 92-9329. He is an Oklahoma ex-convict, Burglar, Armed Robber, who travels extensively throughout the United States. He was last interviewed by Bureau Agents, 3/5/68, where he was living at Bartlesville, Oklahoma. He was at that time employed at Jeanie's Lounge in Bartlesville. LEADS

KNIGHT advised that after thinking about the MARTIN LUTHER KING assassination he learned the following which he thought; he should relate.

He advised the armed robbery of SHELBY JACKSON at Baton Rouge, Louisiana on June 5, 1966 about which KNIGHT furnished information to SA RICHARD K. HARPER which is contained in referenced report. The following incident took place while travelling toward Memphis, Tennessee along with DONALD EUGENE SPARKS, and HERMIT EUGENE WING FBI # 377580B.

KNIGHT advised that they were listening to the car radio and the news of the shooting of MEDGAR EVANS was broadcast and the three of them were drying to figure out a route to Memphis which would bypass possible road blocks. During

to the car radio and the news of the shooting of MEDGAR EVANS was broadcast and the three of them were drying to figure out a route to Memphis which would bypass possible road blocks. During the conversation which took place KNIGHT recalled SPARKS and WING discussing the fact that SPARKS had been offered a \$10,000. payment to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING. They did not elaborate on this other than to indicate that when both were in the state penitentiary at McAlester, Oklahoma, some "agents" had come to interview SPARKS concerning this alleged offer and payment and that he had "run them off" meaning that he had refused to talk to the agents about the matter.

KNIGHT was quizzed thoroughly concerning this incident and advised that it was not discussed further, nor would SPARKS mention who had approached him with the offer.

KNIGHT stated that SPARKS is perfectly capable of committing a murder and is a known hater of Negroes. According to KNIGHT, SPARKS is not known to make jokes and it was believable to KNIGHT that an actual offer was made to SPARKS by someone.

For the information of offices receiving, DONALD EUGENE SPARKS is presently incarcerated at Fort Payne, Alabama and has been incarcerated during the period of the MARTIN LUTHER KING murder which would definitely eliminate SPARKS as a suspect.

TP 157-3231 Furthermore, Tampa is not in a position to elaborate this information and it is requested that: OKLAROMA CITY DIVISION AT OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA & MCALESTER, OKLAHOMA Review files for any pertinent details regarding "agents" attempting to interview SPARKS concerning alleged offer to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING. For the information of Oklahoma City, Tampa files reflect SPARKS incarcerated at McAlester, Oklahoma from 3/9/65 - 5/10/66 under penitentiary #71755. Oklahoma should advise the Bureau, Memphis and Birmingham of any pertinent information in this regard. 
