TYNER said he would furnish more names of the city employees if the interviewing Agent anytime in the future thought it was necessary. TYNER advised that no one had ever called TYNER by the first name of JACK.

POOLE advised that he could not be sure but he believed that he had heard TYNER called by the name of JACK previously.

By communication dated April 10, 1968, the Baltimore FBI Office advised that SAM H. SMITH, III 20 Austin Road, Bloomington, Delaware, employed at Dupont Company, furnished the following information:

In March, 1966, SMITH attended a reserve training session at Camp LeJeune, North Carolina, as a member of the Reserve Mobile Construction Battalion, 24th C.B. (seabee). His roommate was an individual known to him as "JACK" (Last Name Unknown), described as a white male, 34 years of age, 5'10", 150 to 155 pounds. This individual was assigned as Commanding Officer of the Second Platoon, A Company, and held the grade of Lieutenant Junior Grade.

JACK (LNU), during numerous discussions with Mr. SMITH, expressed hostility and hatred toward MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr., blaming him for the confusion and discord in this country. He appeared vehement in his criticism of KING and stated someone should kill him. Mr. SMITH states he heard his roommate, JACK, say that if he had the chance he would kill KING himself.

Mr. SMITH described this individual as an expert shot with an M-1 Carbine and attained the second highest score in his division.

Mr. SMITH recalled that JACK was employed as a surveyor and civil engineer in a small partnership in Canton, Mississippi. He resided in Canton and was attached to a C.B. Division at Jackson, Mississippi.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JOHN L. PUDDISTER at Jackson, Mississippi, on April 10, 1968:

He contacted FICK on several occasions to represent him and get him out on bond. SMITH could not raise any money and finally raised a total of \$400. FICK had set a fee of \$700. SMITH told FICK he owned some property in Houston and had some assets in Houston and if he could get out he could easily raise the other \$300 and pay him in full. FICK finally agreed to make the bonds and SMITH was released. He talked to SMITH after he was released from jail. SMITH was going to Houston and liquidate some assets and pay FICK the balance of his fee for making his bonds. FICK never saw or heard from SMITH until 2/29/68, when he read in the paper that SMITH was arrested with WALKER MARK FLANAGAN, well known Fort Worth police character, in Dallas. FLANAGAN were immediately taken to Houston, Texas, to face a number of burglary charges. FICK went to the District Attorney's Office in Fort Worth to get off the bonds of SMITH and learned that SMITH had been cooperating with law enforcement officers to get evidence on MARK FLANAGAN. FICK did not plan to make any bond for SMITH in Houston, Texas. The District Attorney in Fort Worth and Houston, along with state officers asked his assistance in this matter, and he made bond for SMITH in Houston on or about 3/4/68. He has not seen nor heard from SMITH since then. He has tried to locate SMITH through all known contacts in Fox Worth but has not been successful. He had heard rumors that SMITH might have been killed for cooperating with officers regarding MARK FLANAGAN. He has also heard that SMITH is using this as an excuse to lay low. FICK related that SMITH is a chronic liar, boastful, and exaggerates stories about himmlf. He stated SMITH is a low-life police character and will do most anything to raise a few dollars. FICK had never heard of SMITH having any dealings with MARTIN LUTHER KING and never heard SMITH mention "South Christian Conference." He has talked about everything else but this matter to FICK. SMITH claimed he could do nearly anything on earth. FICK did not trust or believe SMITH very much prior to last time he made bonds for him. He stated at this time he would not believe SMITH "on a stack of Bibles." SMITH has been involved in car thefts but FICK never heard of him being involved in Georgia or deep South. FICK is still trying to locate SMITH. as they have indicated they would call his case in Houston, Texas, in the near future. FICK related if he should receive any information as to the whereabouts of SMITH, he would notify the Fort Worth RA.

MR. H. J. COBB, Deputy Sheriff, was contacted on 4/29/68 and furnished the following information:

He is well acquainted with JANES ALLEN SMITH and has handled him for auto theft in the past. SMITH is wanted by his attorney and bondsman at this time. SNITH is also wanted for questioning in Oklahoma, but they have not issued a warrant. COBB believes SMITH is hiding due to the fact he cooperated with law enforcement officers in arresting WALTER MARK FLANAGAN. COBB stated SMITH might have been buried but he had not learned any definite information to sustain this belief.

DL 44-2649 MR. G. W. BURKS, Texas Ranger, advised on 5/2/68, he had not heard from SMITH and had not been able to develop any information as to his whereabouts. He stated SMITH might have been knocked off by some friends of MARK FLANAGAN. BURKS knows SMITH well and has talked to a number of contacts of SMITH but has not been able to locate SMITH. He stated SMITH talks big, brags, tells big stories, and is one of the biggest liars in the world. MR. GLEN HAWKINS, Detective, Fort Worth PD, was contacted on 5/6/68. He advised he is well acquainted with JAMES ALLEN SMITH. He has made inquiries through all his sources but has not turned up any information on SMITH. He related SMITH could be buried by some friends of MARK FLANAGAN or SMITH might be taking advantage of the situation, has left Fort Worth, and is laying low. HAWKINS had never heard of SMITH being involved in anyting in Georgia or Alabama. He further related he would not believe SMITH or any of the big stories he tells. MR. FRED FICK was recontacted on 5/7/68, at which time he advised he had not received any information as to the whereabouts of SMITH. TENNIS notes that SMITH is experienced in radio mechanics and formerly worked as a radio announcer in San Angelo. SMITH knows how to pilot a plane, is a good fast driver, dresses neatly, and speaks with a southern drawl. SMITH has traveled throughout the South in the past when dealing in stolen cars. He does not have any seaman type experience. GLEN R. (REX) GELVIN, 917 Glenna Street, San Angelo, Texas, advised on 4/15/68, that JAMES ALLEN SMITH last visited him in San Angelo approximately five months ago. He stated he has no information regarding the current whereabouts of SMITH, GELVIN noted that SMITH is an egotistical type liar, and had told him a story over a year ago regarding his (SMITH's) stolen car dealings with the "Southern Christian Conference" and MARTIN LUTHER KING in Atlanta, Georgia.
