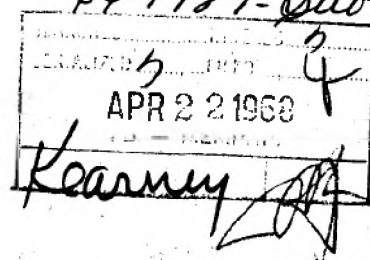
AT SHALLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA

The shorter was white, male, 5'7", 160 lbs, 35 years old, dark hair, well spoken but had country boy appearance, square cheeked and solidly built.

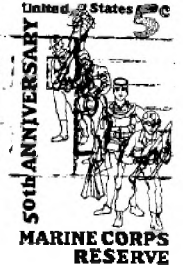

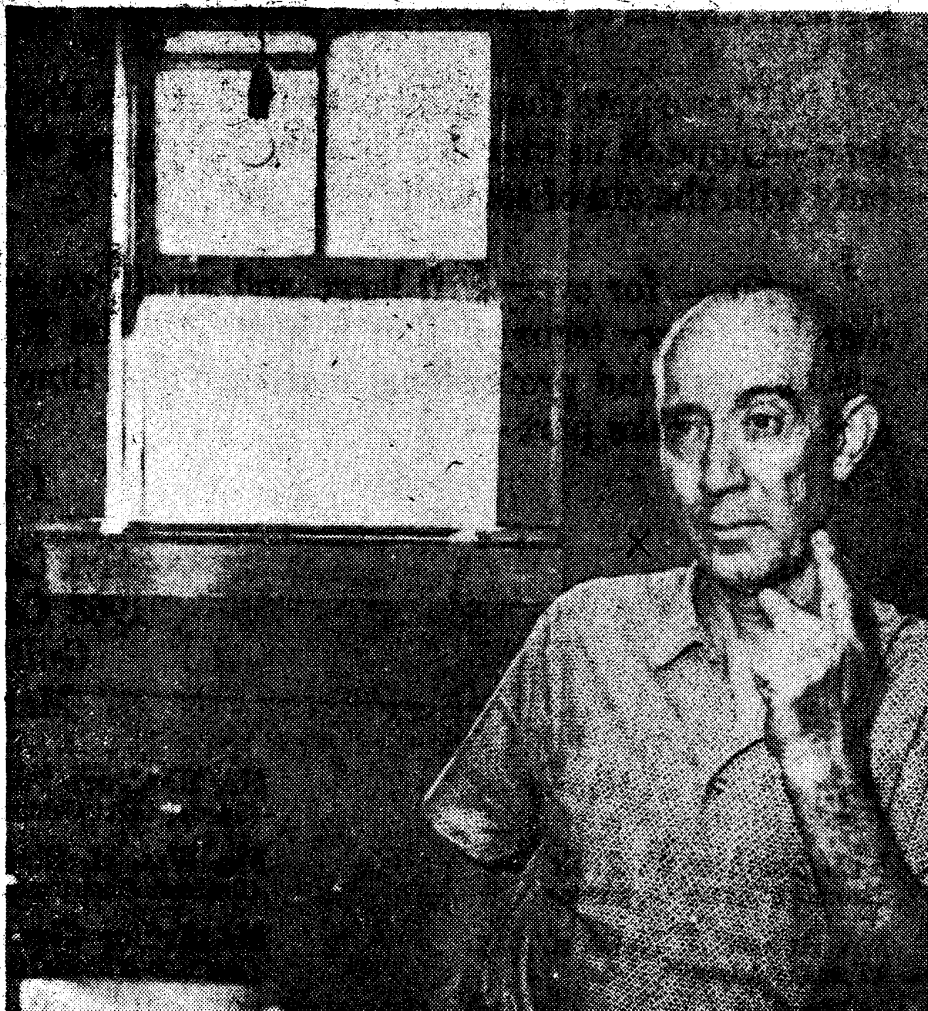
