On 4/16/68, JAMES POWELL, 3533 S. Georgetown, Montgomery, Alabama, advised SA GERALD O. GRAYBILL that the following items were found AM, 4/16/68, on the side of the Bell Road, Montgomery, approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile from the intersection of Highway 80 East:

1. A map of the City of Memphis, Tennessee, which indicates that the map was distributed by the National Bank of Commerce, Memphis.
2. Holiday Inn Passport, 2/1/67 - 5/31/67, which is a directory of Holiday Inns throughout the U. S.
3. Eastern Travel Guide, a booklet listing Eastern and Western motels throughout the U. S.

He picked up these items and wanted to turn them over to the FBI as they might have some connection with captioned case.

Item #1 has a penciled circle, approximately  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter, around a residential section, approximate center of which would be intersection of Scenic and Highland Roads, which appears to be about seven miles from center of city. Several numbers with alphabetical prefixes, possibly telephone numbers are written on back of map.

Enclosed for Memphis is a copy of New York letter to Bureau, dated 4/12/68, which states that three (3) rolls of film taken by Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS), Staff Cameraman REGGIE SMITH at Spelman College of the funeral of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING were obtained from ROBERT ROCKS of CBS and forwarded to the Bureau.

On 4/16/68, the film was returned to ROCKS and a receipt obtained.

ROCKS stated that the film was loaned to the FBI to be reproduced but not to be made available to CBS competition or other news media and that if the film is needed for court then a subpoena duces tecum would have to be issued.

The film was duplicated and copies kept at the Bureau.

Enclosed herewith are 3 rolls of film which were obtained on 4/12/68 by SA Francis L. Cashin from Robert Rocks, Supervisor of Film Editors, CBS, 524 W. 57th St, NY, NY. THEY MUST BE RETURNED TO ROCKS BY THE AM OF 4/16/68 and are not be made available to other news media.

The films were taken by CBS Staff Cameraman Reggie Smith at Spelman College and are of the funeral of Dr. Martin Luther King. The Bureau is requested to reproduce the film and forward the enclosures made back to NY by 4/16/68. In each film there is a white male, who not necessarily the same white male, who could be the subject of MURKIN. It is noted that cameraman Smith confidentially advised SAC ROY MOORE that while he was taking pictures a white male looked suspicious to him

As to the enclosed rolls:

- #1. Crowd going into Spelman to view the deceased. White male will be to the left in a tan coat.
- #2. End of sequence. Lower right corner. White male turned head and looked toward camera. Taken outside Spelman.
- #3. INSIDE Spelman. People viewing deceased. Only white male in the pictures.
