Re San Francisco teletype, dated 6/5/68, and report of SA JOE C. HESTER, dated 6/5/68, at Memphis.

Enclosed for the Bureau are three copies of an FD-302, dated June 7, 1968, reflecting the results of interview of ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL. Two copies each of this FD-302 are enclosed for Kansas City, Memphis, and New Orleans.

Observations of the San Francisco Office Relative to the Interview of ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL

ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL was interviewed during the morning of June 4, 1968, and the interview was continued after a break for lunch. During this entire interview, RUSSELL rambled, was vague, incoherent, inconsistent, and evasive. The entire impression created was that RUSSELL was looking for attention. It is believed that he was not truthful at all times in that any knowledge that he has concerning JAMES EARL RAY could have easily been obtained by reading newspapers and could be spiced by his knowledge of New Orleans where he was arrested in 1967. RUSSELL stated that he knows he has lied on

many occasions, but he was telling the truth now. His story would vary from time to time.

By teletype dated June 6, 1968, the Philadelphia, New York, and Newark Offices ~~were~~ advised that ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL had furnished those offices with inaccurate and unreliable information.

San Francisco does not contemplate a reinterview of RUSSELL at this time unless directed to do so by the Bureau, Memphis, or Kansas City.

New Orleans is being furnished copies of this communication; however, no lead is being set out for New Orleans to conduct specific investigation. It is noted that New Orleans conducted an 88 investigation regarding ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL during 1967 at which time he was using the names JAMES ALEXANDER and ROBERT LAWRENCE. *aha*

Re Phoenix teletype to Salt Lake City dated 6/6/68, indicating information received from one JEAN DEAN that she believed an individual known to her as JACK (LNU), who is employed at YD Motors, Salt Lake City, Utah, might be identical to JAMES EARL RAY.

On 6/6/68, ROBERT RYAN, Manager, YD Motors, 860 South Main Street, Salt Lake City, stated the only individual named JACK he has ever had employed there, is C. JACK CARLTON, who is currently employed. CARLTON resides at 2937 Pamela Drive, Salt Lake City, and has been employed by YD motors since April, 1967. He took a three-week vacation during the summer of 1967, and was gone for four days over Memorial Day, 1968; otherwise, he has reported for work every day since April, 1967. CARLTON is a WMA, 37 years old, 6' tall, 230 pounds, and has a heavy build.

Mr. RYAN observed the identification order of JAMES EARL RAY and said that in his opinion C. JACK CARLTON bears no resemblance to RAY.

No further investigation being conducted this matter, Salt Lake City.

Re Cincinnati teletype to Bureau 6/20/68.

On 5/21/68, Mrs. ANN JACOBSON, 434 Robb Avenue, Johnstown, Pa., advised SAs EARL W. CALLOWAY and JOHN S. HUGHES that for the past three weeks she has been doing domestic work for a DONALD SHAEFFER and a Mrs. HELEN STANCE, at 446 Somerset Street, Johnstown, Pa. She explained that SHAEFFER and STANCE are not married, but are living together; that SHAEFFER is a local contractor and that he has several employees working for him who meet at the residence of 446 Somerset Street, each morning prior to going out on a particular contracting job.

Mrs. JACOBSON initially denied making any statement to anyone that the "killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING" was in any way connected with SHAEFFER or his contracting group. She then advised that she might have made a statement that SHAEFFER could be the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING inasmuch as he drinks excessively and has made statements that he could see nothing wrong with KING's assassination. Mrs. JACOBSON stated that all of SHAEFFER's workmen are in their late teens or early 20's; that none of them look like JAMES EARL RAY, but that SHAEFFER bears some slight resemblance to the subject.

On 5/22/68, Detective HAROLD BECKEYBIL, Police Department, Johnstown, Pa., advised that he is personally acquainted with SHAEFFER; that SHAEFFER has been a fly-by-night contractor in Johnstown for many years; that one of SHAEFFER's employees is his brother, JOSEPH, and that SHAEFFER could not in any way be identical to JAMES EARL RAY.

FORMER LANDLORD OF BOYD ROBERT BARTON AT ONE ZERO EIGHT FIVE ZERO KLING ST., NORTH HOLLYWOOD, DESCRIBES BARTON AS REPUTABLE STABLE INDIVIDUAL WHO APPEARED RELIGIOUS, QUIET LIVING AND NEVER INDICATED ANY EXTREMISM IN ANY FORM. STATED SHE WAS IN BARTON'S APARTMENT ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS AND NEVER SAW ANY EXPLOSIVES OR FIREARMS. BARTON INTERVIEWED THIS DATE AT PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT AND DENIES POSSESSION OF ANY EXPLOSIVES NOW OR DURING PERTINENT PERIOD AND EMPHATICALLY DENIED EVER DISCUSSING OR ADVOCATING ASSASSINATION OF KING OR TO BLOW UP UNITED NATIONS BUILDING. HE IDENTIFIED MONSEE, JOHNSON AND ARMSTRONG AS WELL MEMBERS OF THE RADIO CHURCH OF GOD AND STATED THAT THE BELIEFS OF THE RADIO CHURCH OF GOD ARE STRICTLY CONTRARY TO VIOLENCE AND PREACH STRICT ADHERENCE TO THE TEN COMMANDMENTS THEREBY ABHORING RACISM, ANTI SEMITISM OR VIOLENCE IN ANY FORM.

BARTON ADVISED THAT HE AND WIFE ATTEMPTED A RECONCILIATION APPROXIMATELY ONE YEAR AGO UNSUCCESSFULLY. AFTER A BRIEF VISIT TO HIM IN LOS ANGELES, SHE RETURNED TO NEW YORK. BARTON DESCRIBED HIS EX WIFE AS A HEAVY DRINKER WHO HAS HAD SEVERAL MARRIAGES. HE STATED THEY PARTED ON A BITTER NOTE AS SHE EXPECTED MORE FINANCIAL HELP FROM HIM ON THE TRIP THAN HE WAS WILLING TO PROVIDE.

IN VIEW OF THE FAVORABLE REPUTATION OF THE RADIO CHURCH OF GOD AND OF ITS LEADER, DR. HERBERT ARMSTRONG, THE ALLEGATION BY MRS. DOROTHEA BARTON, NEE CHILDS, RESIDENCE TWO FIVE ZERO WEST ONE HUNDRED FOURTH STREET, APARTMENT FIVE FOUR, NEW YORK CITY, ADVISED THIS DATE THAT HER EX DASH HUSBAND, BOYD ROBERT BARTON, LAST KNOWN ADDRESS, ONE ZERO EIGHT FIVE ZERO KLING STREET, NORTH HOLLYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, IS A MEMBER OF A "CULT" FOUNDED BY DR. (FIRST NAME UNKNOWN) ARMSTRONG WHO IS CONNECTED WITH THE AMBASSADOR COLLEGE, PASADENA, CALIFORNIA. SHE STATED THAT ONE OF THE MAIN BELIEFS OF THE CULT, NAME OF CULT UNKNOWN, IS THAT THE END OF THE WORLD IS EMINENT WITHIN FIVE YEARS. ONE OF THE PURPOSES OF THE CULT IS TO RID THE WORLD OF SOME OF ITS THIEVERY AND OTHER BAD FACTORS WITHIN THIS PERIOD OF TIME.

MRS. BARTON STATED THAT SHE RETURNED TO NEW YORK FROM THE LOS ANGELES AREA AROUND MAY, NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN. SHE STATED PRIOR TO LEAVING CALIFORNIA SHE ACTUALLY SAW NUMEROUS GUNS, HAND GRENADES AND DYNAMITE AS STORED BY THE CULT AT THE KLING STREET ADDRESS OF HER HUSBAND. SHE STATED SHE AND HER HUSBAND HAVE BEEN DIVORCED FOR APPROXIMATELY TWENTY YEARS, HOWEVER, IN THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS RESIDED TOGETHER AT THE ABOVE NORTH

SHE FURTHER STATED THAT DR. ARMSTRONG HAS A SON WHO IS A WELL KNOWN "BROADCASTER" IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA. SHE IDENTIFIED BOYD BARTON AS A WHITE MALE, BORN APPROXIMATELY [REDACTED] IN PENNSYLVANIA, FIVE FEET ELEVEN INCHES, ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY POUNDS, HAIR SANDY AND EYES BLUE. HE IS EMPLOYED AS A "FILM CUTTER" FOR DESI ARNEZ. HE IS NOW BELIEVED TO HAVE MOVED FROM THE KLING STREET ADDRESS TO AN UNKNOWN ADDRESS IN THE SAME AREA.

MRS. BARTON WAS INTERVIEWED AFTER SHE CONTACTED THE NEW YORK OFFICE REQUESTING AN AGENT TO CONTACT HER CONCERNING ABOVE INDICATED MATTERS. SHE WAS INTERVIEWED IN PRESENCE OF A FRIEND, JERRY YOON, WHO RESIDES WITH HER AND WHOM SHE IDENTIFIED AS HER BODYGUARD. THE ONLY REASON GIVEN WHY SHE HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY BROUGHT THIS INFORMATION TO THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION'S ATTENTION IS THAT SHE IS A HIGHLY NERVOUS PERSON.

The form furnished by SMITH reflects it was submitted by a JAMES E. RAY, 34 Gladys Street, San Francisco, Calif., 94110. RAY sets forth he is a 30 year old male, on the form.

The form submitted by RAY is for the purpose of placing an ad in "Select Magazine". It is noted this magazine is ordinarily described as being an obscene pen-pal club type of publication.

RAY set forth he wanted the heading for his ad to be "Sepia<sup>o</sup>modern husband". RAY said he wanted the ad

SMITH explained the envelopes subscriptions are received in are destroyed. He said the ad of RAY's was published in the December, 1967, issue of Select Magazine.

SMITH said the last issue of Select Magazine mailed to its subscribers occurred on 4/12/68. SMITH said RAY was sent a copy of this issue which apparently was not returned to Select Associates.

The following interviews were conducted at Washington, D. C., on April 8, 1968, by Special Agents JOSEPH C. KELLY and SIDNEY H. ROCHE:

Dr. DAVID MARK ROSENBAUM, Expert, National Resources Analysis Center, Systems Evaluation Division, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation building, 550 17th Street, Northwest, advised that he is acquainted with one RUSSELL YOUNG, Executive Assistant to the Vice President, Government Communications Division, American Telephone and Telegraph Company, and while in company with Mr. YOUNG sometime during the first, several days of April, 1968, YOUNG remarked to ROSENBAUM that Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING was possibly going to be killed in Memphis, Tennessee.

Dr. ROSENBAUM said that since the statement had been proven true, in as much as Dr. KING was killed, he felt that he should notify the Federal Bureau of Investigation of this information. He added that he could not suggest the source of YOUNG's information, and that he intended to call Mr. YOUNG and advise him that he had furnished the information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Mr. WILLIAM RUSSELL YOUNG, Executive Assistant to the Vice President, Government Communications Division, American Telephone and Telegraph Corporation, Room 1104, 1730 K Street, Northwest, telephone 392-5196, stated that he commented earlier in the month of April, 1968, while in the presence of one Dr. DAVID ROSENBAUM, that in view of the feelings and opinions expressed by the Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING, he predicted that someone would kill
