Day before the assassination James Earl Ray was in Athens, Ala., and was taken to Memphis. That would have been April 3.

Ray registered at flophouse, along with another man, Samuel Lewis. Accding to informant, Lewis was to take King if the balcony scene didn't work out. After the shooting, Ray walked to his car accompanied by a man and a girl. The car: A new blue Buick with Alabama plates; lst digits: "14." Owned by Eddie Wilburn (Wilbourn?) of Huntsville, Ala. Lewis spent night of April KNYKK 4 at the flop house. He left the rext morning (April 5) for Knoxville...

Ray, along with two young women and a child, was driven out of \(\square\) Memphis by Wilburn Straight to Kansas City. The drive took 6\(\frac{1}{2}\) hours. Wilburn, the two women and the kid all from Huntsville, Ala.

In Kansas City, Ray stayed at a private home. At dusk April 5 he was flown to Belle Glade, KKKKMK Florida in a private aircreft which took off from a private field in Kansas City. Plane supposed to be owned by William Pierce, a wealthy man who also owns the private airfield, supposed to have had contracting company in Cubakerburgekerikes; owns motel at Belle Glade and cottages on Lake Okeechobee. He's also supposed to be KKK'er.

On April 11, informant says, Ray got on a yacht (which prb was a chartered fishing boat) at Key West, owned by Capt. Ben Thompson.

Incidentals: Pierce often flies to New Orleans. He knows Jim Garrison. Pierce and Wilburn may be related.

The murder rifle is still supposed to be stashed in the furnace of the flophouse. The guns were switched. The one found outside

The rifle is supposed to be underneath a pile of other stuff in the furnace. The informant says somebody in the rooming house ix was supposed to be in on the plot. That would be the guy who lives there and helps keep up the place making beds etc.

Ray may be wearing bifocals now. His white Mustang was never in Memphis. It never left Georgia. Don't know how it got in Capitol Homes public housing development.

On April 4, Ray made calls to Belle Glade from xxx from Memphis, a bus station. He used a credit card. The credit card might have been made out to Ridell Catering, subsidiary of U.S. Rubber Corp., Detroit. Or, he might have been made out to one Robert Brinkley. If towas Ridell, might be a Mr. Ridell who lives in Harper Woods, extra a fancy Detroit wavaraby suburb.

Some weeks before the assassination, Ray was supposed to have stayed in Belle Glade.

Payoffs: Winkhoumm Wilburn supposed to hv bn paid off in Reno, at the Cal-Neva Lodge. Someone won \$25,000 the night before at the lodge, and the thought is that the "winnings" were rigged to provide payoff money. Now enters one Charlie Cate, lived in Reno. He's from Tennessee, comes back occassionally to yisit. He reportedly knows about the payoff. Ben (& or maybe Jack) Sturgis of St. Louis was a bartender at Reno and supposed to have come into a lot of money during last few weeks.

Re Sam Lewis (or Louis): He's supposed to hy served time at prisons in Milan, Mich., Chillicothe, Ohio; Terra Haute, Ind. He took bus to ZKnoxville April 5. Then came through Memphis April 7 (day Mrs. King paraded) en route to Los Angeles. He may have stayed in Knoxville with a local fireman, perhaps a company emdr who is not supposed to be implicated.

Mr. CHRISS produced a 2-page memorandum containing information obtained from an informant of the "Los Angeles Times" in Los Angeles. CHRISS permitted his memorandum being copied on the Xerox machine and the copy is being made a part of the Memphis file.

The information furnished by the informant as to the manner in which the murder was committed, information regarding cars used, and the murder weapon is completely contrary to facts developed during the FBI investigation.

Mr. CHRISS stated this information had been made available in Los Angeles to the SAC of the FBI Office and that the boss of Mr. CHRISS in Los Angeles had directed that the information be made available to the FBI in Memphis.

Mr. CHRISS wanted to know if the FBI would keep him informed of the results of checking out the information furnished by the informant and if the information checked out, if the FBI could give him an off-the-record comment to the effect that the FBI might be making a release on the information. CHRISS was most interested in being in a position to publish any information first which might be developed from the information furnished by the "Times" informant.

I made it clear to Messrs. CHRISS and REASONS that I could not make any commitment to them about being able to inform them

Current Miami, Florida Southern Bell Telephone Directory lists a WILLIAM L. PIERCE at 500 N.E. 83rd Street, Miami, Florida.

Mrs. WILLIAM L. PIERCE, wife of WILLIAM L. PIERCE was located and interviewed at the PIERCE apartment, 500 N.E. 83rd Street, Apartment 5, Miami, Florida. She stated she and her husband were staying at Conch Key, Florida, on the night of April 4, 1968. Later that night they returned to Miami, Florida where they remained for four or five days.prior to her husband's departure to Waynesville, North Carolina, with his mother, DOLLY PIERCE.

PIERCE owns the Rocky Waters Motel, Waynesville, North Carolina, and his telephone number is 926-1585. Mrs. PIERCE advised that he has been at the Rocky Waters Motel since leaving Miami.

Mrs. PIERCE stated her husband has a private pilot's license which he obtained at the Asheville, North Carolina airport. He last flew a private plane in about October, 1967, in North Carolina. He flies only for personal pleasure and does not own a plane. Mrs. PIERCE knows of no one in a position to loan a plane to her husband.

Mrs. PIERCE further advised her husband has not been in Kansas City or New Orleans and to her knowledge he is not associated with JIM GARRISON or EDDIE WILBURN, he has never been associated with any Klu Klux Klan organization and he owns no property such as land or airports. Mrs. PIERCE advised her husband was born in Arizona on

The following investigation was conducted by SA PATRICK A. PHILBIN, at Belle Glade, Florida, May 20, 1968.

WILLIAM LEE PIERCE located at Tru-Flo Pump Company, advised he presently lives in Pahokee, Florida, across from the Farmer's Market on Lewis Friend Highway, but uses P.O. Box 398, Belle Glade, Florida, as his mailing address.

PIERCE advised that he came to Belle Glade as a young man from the area of Uniontown, Pennsylvania, in the early 1930 s, and after working hard in construction and other fields became one of the biggest property owners in the area and did construct some apartments known as the Bill Fierce Apartments on Mighway 441 in the city limits. He stated just after World War II he and several others cleared out a large field which is now the city airport and that he got into the air taxi and crop dusting business and that he had learned to fly back then but had never gotten a pilot's license. He stated that all of his airplanes were torn up and destroyed in a hurricane about 1949 and that was the end of his venture in this field. He stated that in the 50's he had developed some machinery which wove the fibers of the Rami plant into cloth resembling cotton and was doing an extremely profitable business in Cuba with Batista until Castro took over and put him out of business there. He said his financial statement would have been worth several million dollars at that time but that severe financial losses, poor business operations in construction, etc., cost him almost everything he had. He stated that he had signed a \$350,000 contract with TRUJILLO in the Dominican Republic for his weaving machine and that two days later TRUJILLO was assassinated and that was the end of that.

PIERCE stated that he became involved in several money losing ventures and a shopping center fell through in which he had invested heavily and that friends wanted him to declare bankruptcy but that he had worked hard and had paid off \$27,000 in debts and with the exception of \$125,000 which he owes in Federal Income taxes he is out of debt and plans to work hard and get back on his feet. He stated that at the present time he is completely broke but that he feels he can still make money and will soon have his own welding shop and has plans for the development of various types of machinery.

PIERCE stated that the only trips made in the past year was one trip to Bainbridge, Georgia, during March, 1968, to visit his sister-in-law, BESSIE WILLIAMS and one trip to Islamorada, Florida, to visit his step son CHARLES WARREN SMITH a day or two prior to Easter.

PTERCE stated he owns no airplane, could not fly one at this time. He has not been to Atlanta, Memphis, Kansas City, Missouri, for years and has not been contacted by anyone from the "Los Angeles Times" and has never heard of anyone named BEN THOMPSON who owns a yacht or shrimp boats in the area of Key West. Florida.

PIERCE stated that in the operation of his apartments and during his lifetime he probably has made a number of enemies.



The following investigation was conducted by SA RONALD TODD at Okeechobee, Florida:

On May 18, 1968, GERALDINE BOWLES, Ridge Apartments, Buckhead Ridge, advised that she is the wife of JOHN T. BOWLES. / She stated that she recalls that she was at the home of BOWLES' sister, Mrs. CHARLES GRIZZAFFE in Tampa, Florida, the day MARTIN LUTHER KING was killed. She stated that she had gone to Tampa that morning from Okeechobee. Florida for a dental appointment. She made the drive with Mrs. GRIZZAFFE and spent the night at her home. Early the next morning JOHN BOWLES flew from Okeechobee to Tampa and she flew back to Okeechobee with him that morning. She stated that she had not known he had been in Tampa the day KING was killed; however, she stated that they are getting a divorce and she is not aware of all of his activities. She commented that upon returning to Okeechobee on April 5, 1968, she asked his mother if he had been home on the night of April 4, 1968, and his mother stated that he had. She asked his mother this question because she wanted to know if he might have been out with his girl friend, MARY KNIGHT, a barmaid at the Fin and Feather Bar. She commented that nothing has occurred within the past two months that would cause her to believe he might have been involved in the murder of KING. She said she did not believe he could possibly be involved. She added that he has been in the Okeechobee area for the past two months with the exception of the few trips he took over to Tampa. She said she did not believe BOWLES would attempt to fly the airplane any further than Tampa.

On May 18, 1968, WARY KNIGHT, 106 1st Street, was located at the Fin and Feather Bar, Buckhead Ridge, and she stated that she was working the night KING was murdered. She said she could not recall if BOWLES was

at the bar that night. She said she is certain he could not have been involved and that with the exception of a few trips to Tampa around the time of KING's death he has been in Okeechobee, Florida. She stated that she is BOWLES' girl friend and that both she and BOWLES are getting a divorce.

On May 20, 1968, CHARLES GRIZZAFFE, Ridge Apartments, Buckhead Ridge, advised that his wife is the sister of JOHN T. BOWLES. He stated that he lives at 332 Westcrest, Tampa; however, he comes to Okeechobee, Florida often since he owns the Ridge Apartments at Buckhead Ridge. He stated that BOWLES and his wife, GERALDINE, manage the apartments for him. He stated that BOWLES made several trips to Tampa around the first part of April, 1968, to visit a dental laboratory. BOWLES would always call him first so that someone could meet him at the airport. He stated that nothing has occurred that would cause him to suspect that BOWLES might have been involved in the murder of KING.

On May 20, 1968, GLEN HAMILTON, Okissimmee Fishing Camp, Okeechobee, Florida, advised that BOWLES keeps his airplane just across the road from his camp. The place is called Hog Island. He stated that BOWLES buys gasoline from him for his airplane. The airplane has a capacity of about 13 gallons and a top speed of about 75 miles per hour. He believes the furtherest BOWLES has flown is Tampa. He stated that he has not heard or seen anything that would lead him to believe BOWLES could possibly be involved in the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING.
