On 5/16/68, TOMMY HIGHNOTE, 232 South Second St., Jacksonville Beach, Fla., telephonically contacted the Jacksonville Office and indicated that he had some information concerning the shooting of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

On the same date HIGHNOTE was interviewed and he indicated that his full name was THOMAS HIGHNOTE but that he has traditionally used the name of TOMMY. He stated that he has been dating a young lady named HELEN PHELPS who works as a waitress in the Quality Court Hotel Restaurant at the junction of Highway 27 and I 75 in Ocala, Fla.

He further advised that a week or two after the KING incident he was on a date with PHELPS and after he made some remark about the shooting she noted that her boss, BOB PATTEN. Teft for Birmingham, Ala., either the day before KING was assassinated or the same date and that PATTEN remarked that he was going to Birmingham to get "that black \$.O.B. MARTIN LUTHER KING".

HIGHNOTE stated that this is the only remark that PHELPS made concerning PATTEN in regards to the shooting of MARTIN LUTHER KING, but that he is aware that PATTEN is a businessman from Bessemer, Ala., who is in the real estate business and also is the owner of the Quality Court Motel in Ocala.

On 5/16/68, HELEN L. PHELPS, 4100 SW 20th St., Ocala, Fla., was mocated and interviewed at 8:15 PM by SAs TED R. TUCKER and WILLIAM M. BAKER at her place of employment, the Quality Courts, U. S. Highway 27 North, Ocala, Fla.

Mrs. PHELPS advised the owner of the Quality Courts is Mr. BOB PATTEN, a construction company owner, who resides at Bessemer, Ala.

Mrs. PHELPS advised at no time has she ever heard Mr. PATTEN make any remarks that he intended to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING or any other person. She advised if anyone stated that she had related this information then this is purely a figment of that person's imagination.

Mrs. PHELPS advised Mr. PATTEN is a very fine individual and she has never heard him discuss his political views with anyone. She further advised Mr. PATTEN resides in Bessemer, Ala., and only comes to Ocala on rather infrequent oceasions.

On 5/17/68, Mr. ROBERT O. REDDING, Investigator for Ocala attorneys WAGNER and PEARL, appeared at the Ocala RA at approximately 3 PM and furnished the following information to SA ROBERT H. ANDERSON, JR.:

On the night of 5/16/68, he, REDDING, was at the Quality Courts, U. S. Highway 27 North, Ocala, having a drink and entered into conversation with HELEN PHELPS whom he knew and who was acting as the bartender on this particular night. PHELPS informed REDDING she had been visited earlier in the evening by the FBI regarding remarks that her boss, BOB PATTEN, allegedly made concerning threats about MARTIN LUTHER KING.

According to REDDING, PHELPS advised she did not want to get involved in this matter and she informed the FBI

that PATTEN had never made any threatening remarks concerning KING in her presence. REDDING advised, however, that PRELPS told him that PATTEN had made the remark, "We're going to have to kill KING" in her presence and in the presence of Nr. (PNU) VAIL or VALE, the night bookkeeper, prior to KING's assassination.

REBDING further advised PHELPS told him that PATTEN cums a string of Quality Courts and is well known in his home town of Bosoomer, Ala., and is reportedly a high official of the Re Klum Klam in that area.

REDUING advised he has no way to assess the truthfulness of the comments made by PHELPS. He advised he has had business contacts with her in the past and he feels she could be possibly semenhat emotionally disturbed.

Attention is directed to the fact that HELEN FRELPS was formerly MELEN HOOKER, Postmistress at Citra, Fla.

She Further informed the Geals RA several years ago regarding LERGY AMBROSIA PRATIER (JX 78-543) who was then a Top Ten Pugitive. At that time, PMELPS was convinced PRAZIER was residing in Citra, Fig. Subsequent investigation revealed hep information was absolutely worthlose.

D. CHALKER at this address was received about two weeks ago and she returned it to the sender since this name is completely unknown to her or her husband.

Mr. HALL advised on 6/6/68 that a review of the checks returned on the CHALKER account indicated his address on one of the checks as 1238 Carrolton Avenue, Memphis.

Mr. CLIFFORD L. GAMET, 1238 Carrolton Avenue, Memphis advised on 6/6/68 that LAWRENCE D. CHALKER never lived at this address while in Memphis but approximately two months ago he resided at the Holiday Towers apartments in Memphis and was at that time self-employed selling cemetery lots for Forrest Hills Cemetery in Memphis. Mr. GAMET said CHALKER did not do good at selling, borrowed some money from him, left town and he has no idea where CHALKER is living or working. Mr. GAMET said his stepdaughter MARY RUDD, (age 49) of this address (who is currently out of town) has known CHALKER for over 15 years.

Mr. GAMET stated CHALKER does not resemble photographs of JAMES EARL RAY in any respect. He said he has seen numerous photographs of JAMES EARL RAY as published in the paper and none of the photographs resemble CHALKER in any way. Mr. GAMET added he recalls his step-daughter was in the Baptist Hospital in Memphis on 4/4/68, and she mentioned to him the next day (4/5/68) that CHALKER had spent the afternoon, evening and night visiting her in the hospital. Mr. GAMET furnished the following description of CHALKER:

Also no further investigation will be conducted by the Memphis Division concerning the checks CHALKER has written since these are true name checks and no known federal violation exists.

By communication dated May 22, 1968, the Columbia Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation advised as follows:

On the night of May 18, 1968, BILL REID, a former officer of the Greer, South Carolina, Police Department, who now resides at Tryon, North Carolina, advised that he had observed an individual at the Tryon Plaza Motel at Tryon, North Carolina, on May 18, 1968, who fits the description of and bears a resemblance to JAMES EARL RAY. REID stated he did not know the name of this individual but he was occupying the third room east of the office at the motel.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JOHN C. HENNIGAR at Tryon, North Carolina:

On May 27, 1968, Mrs. RUTH GORDON, Tryon Plaza Motel, Tryon, North Carolina, advised that she recalls May 18, 1968, as her daughter, Mrs. THELMA BURGETT, worked part of the day on Saturday. Mrs. GORDON advised that Three doors east of the office would be Room 9 at the Tryon Plaza Motel. Mrs. GORDON advised that her registration cards reflect that Room 9 on May 18, 1968, was occupied by J. FLEETWOOD SIENIER, 148 East Seventh Street, Jacksonville, Florida, representing the Massey Company. Mrs. GORDON advised that the registration card indicates he drove a Plymouth with Florida license 2-66110.

Mrs. GORDON further advised that Room 9 was occupied by R. L. BONE, 2103 South Main Street, Greenwood, South Carolina, on May 19, 1968. This card indicated that Mr. BONE represented the Saco Lowell Shops and was driving a 1965 Chevrolet with South Carolina license E-131608. Mrs. GORDON advised that she has always been an avid detective story reader and has been following the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING very closely. Mrs. GORDON advised that she has always been anyone at the motel who resembles the photograph AGE JAMES EART BAY which appeared in the local paper.

Mrs. GORDON advised that she and her daughter Mrs. THELMA BURGETT, have talked about the assassination and no mention of any individual in the motel resembling RAY has been discussed.

On May 27, 1968, Mrs. THELMA BURGETT, Tryon Plaza Motel, advised that she recalls working part-time on Saturday, May 18, 1968. Mrs. BURGETT advised she does not recall anyone resembling the photograph of RAY registering at the motel.

Mrs. BURGETT advised there was an incident at the motel at that time as an individual had come to the motel, registering as a single and later she found out he had a woman in the room. Mrs. BURGETT advised she approached this individual and told him to come to the office, and pay the additional price for a second person in the room. Mrs. BURGETT advised that when he got to the office, she discovered he had not registered and asked him to register at that time. Mrs. BURGETT advised that this individual refused to register, stating that it was too late. Mrs. BURGETT advised that this individual was a nice-looking man; however, he did not fit the description or photograph of JAMES EARL RAY which appeared in the local paper.
