

After more than five minutes CORB asked who the Agent wanted to see. It is noted there sere makerous large posters, 12 x 14, pasted on the walls and desks in the office of BOBBY MUTTOM and notices or lettering on the posters "Killed by recist Dakland pigs." A number of the persons in the room were attired in the customary dress of the Black Panthers and numerous material for the Black Panthers was observed. The Agent identified himself to COBB and stated he wanted to talk to COBB briefly. He offered a chair in the room with all the others and when SA JONES suggested some privacy he said, "Lat's go on the street." In front of 2717 Sen Pablo Avenue, COBB again demanded the Agent's identification and he studiously observed the credentials, obviously aware of his audience within the building. SA JONES told COBB of his purpose in talking to COBB regarding the MARTIN LUTHER KING assassination in which he may be able to be of some help. COBB immediately said, "Let's go your car and sit down." At this point an individual stopped COBB and SA JONES on the street. This individual was dressed in a black leather jacket, a green beret, with Black Panther buttons on both beret and jacket. He stated to COBB "Let me talk to you a minute brother." COBB told him he would be back in about five minutes,

In the Eureau automobile COBB stated he did not want to talk to the FBI and felt harabsed by the FBI, stating he believed the FBI had been "following him for several weeks." SA JOHES related to COBB that the FBI had received a complaint that he, COBB, had made a statement during a series of lectures at St, John's Presbyteriam Church that HARTIN LUTHER KING would be killed soon and would be killed in Hemphis, Tennessee. COBB replied, "I made that statement on Sunday night before KING was killed on Thursday. I did say KING would be killed in Hemphis and I have good evidence to support my prediction." At this point COBB stated, "I mant to take the Fifth Amendment and I won't give any further information to the FBI." When saked for the reason for this COBB stated, "The FBI already knows the white killer of KING and has him in custody." SA JOHES then displayed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, aka ERIC STARVO GALT, to COBB and he viewed the photograph without comment.

At this point COBB stated, "The FBI knows my record and I am certain you are not here about KING but here to harmes me." 

CASE ORKER'S ANALYSIS

Carlos Lee Billings is a 35-year old, married, white male, who was committed to the U.S. Fedical Center for Federal Prisoners in Springfield, Missouri on June 1, 1967, from the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas, Little Rock; under a Title 18, Section 1216. Billings was previously incarcerated (March 16, 1967) at the Medical Center.

Billings is being charged with violation of the NMVTA. Billings claims that all he knows about his present offense is what the FBI and police officials told him. He has had difficulty over the years in remembering events that have taken place in his life. The psychiatric staff exam on April 27, 1967, did indicate that Billings was also suffering from a severe fainting disorder.

Official records indicate that Billings escaped from prison in Westchester, Pa. on March 27, 1965. He is accused of transporting interstate, a motor vehicle from Pampas, Texas to Forest City, Arkansas. Since Billings' escape, he has been involved in at least fifty cases of taking cars by theft or false pretenses. Eight of the above mentioned cars are in the process of being transferred to the Eastern District of Arkansas for a plea of guilty; apparently with Billings' consent. The U.S. Attorney; Eastern District of Arkansas, also indicated that Billings is probably guilty of numerous other biolations involving bad checks and fraud. He has managed to avoid arrest by constantly keeping on the move, trading cars, and passing bad checks. Then Billings was apprehended, he was sitting in the front seat of his car, intoxicated, and had a loaded pistol in his lap. No pre-sentence investigation has been done on the above named patient.

PRIOR RECORD

According to the FBI report, Billings has an extensive prior record which dates back to 1949 (age 17) when he was arrested in Bristol, Firginia and given a 12 month suspended jail sentence for Attempting to Pass Worthless Checks. Billings has been arrested over 20 times for lorgery, Grand Larceny, Parole Violation, Deserter (the Army), Concealed meapons, Worthless Checks, Embezzlement from I/S Shipments, etc. Billings had previously been committed to the USP, Atlanta and the USP, Lewisburg, in addition to this he had also served time at "the Pen" in Michmond, Virginia—on two different occasions. Billings has also been committed to several state, local hospitals and Army hospitals for psychiatric observation and treatment.

SOCIAL STUDY

Carlos Lee Billings (called "Rocky" and variour other aliases), was born in Piney Creek, N.C. on He is the youngest of three children and was raised by his parents until the are of 15, when he ran away from home and fraudulently enlisted in the Army. He was raised by his parents in an urban environment, fair economic conditions and adequate supervision. Billing father, Pard B. Billings, was born in Piney Creek, N.C. and has lived there most of his life until recently moving to Pennsylvania. Father is literate, in good health and does not have a police record. He is self-employed, he sperates a

furniture and grocery store. Billings mother, Virginia, was born in West Jefferson, N.C. Prior to moving to Pa., she helped her imsband at the grocery store and most of her duties were that of a house wife. Both parents attend the Baptist Church regularly.

Birth and early development were normal. At three years of age, Billings had a severe attack of influenza and since that time he has suffered from headaches and nose bleeds. Billings started school at the age of 7, but did poorly. His father states that he attend-

in comparison to his brothers and sisters and that he seemed to keep a distance from the rest of the members of the family. During his school years he had difficulty getting along with the teachers and other students. He would get involved in various fights. Billings would not obey the teachers. His mother did state that he liked various sports (football and baseball) and intended on becoming a boxer or lawyer when he was older. As was indicated, at the age of fifteen Billings ran away from home and enlisted. His first enlistment was in September. 1948. Billings was discharged for minority reasons in March, 1949. dillings again enlisted in the Army in August, 1949, and was discharged again in January 28, 1952, this time under honorable conditions. In October, 1953, he again enlisted and was discharged on August 18, 1951, under other than honorable conditions-Billings was discharged on this occasion because he enlisted under fraudulent name. In his re-enlistment in 1949, Billings was involved in a Jeep accident, According to the story there was a period of time, almost a year, that he was amnestic. He states he woke up in 1950 and found himself on a chain gang. He claims he was arrested riding in a stolen car. Apparently he "woke up" after having been hit in the head with a pick. At that time neither he, nor the authorities, realized that he was in the Army and he was It was later determined that he was military personnel and he was sent to Camp Pickett Hospital. Billings was there for

In 1954, Billings married, He had known his wife several years before the marriage. Recently Billings was worried that his wife was planning to divorce him, but apparently this has been true only insofar as Billings has been concerned. Billings was never able to hold down a job for any real length of time. Most of his jobs that he did hold were those of truck driver.

He has been working for the Sanitation Department, receiving below average work reports. His work supervisor says that this man is not very dependable and has to be shown continuously what has to be done. He was also described as "just a serry character". One of Billings' main goals is to return to court as competant to stand trial.

Recently we received a phone call that Billings' mother was very ill. Immediately we tried to return the call trying to find out the nature of the patient's mother's illness. 



REPORT OF PSYCHIATRIC STAFF *XAMINATION - 8-17-67

Carlos Lee Billings is a 35-year-old White male committed to the Medical Center as incompetent to stand trial under Section 4246, USC. He is charged with violation of NMVTA. The staffing is to evaluate the patient's competency.

In the interview itself, the patient presented in a cooperative manner and seemed somewhat more alert than at the past examination. He understood that he was charged with auto theft and had been arrested in Little Rock. He related that he had escaped from a Pennsylvania jail before he had started flights across the country. The patient showed an understanding of the court proceedings and what basically goes on. Further, he had some idea of the seriousness of the penalties possible against him. Further, he had some idea of strategy and stated that he would plead not guilty with the idea of possibly being found so on the basis of insanity. Generally, the patient seemed better motivated in terms of doing the best thing for himself than he did at the last staffing. However, there still remains some superficiality in his thinking and the patient required some help in that the Staff had to be specific in its questions and pinning him down to responding to specific things.

Billings has some experience as an auto salesman. He has also worked with heavy equipment. Institutionally he has worked as a ward orderly and in the laundry. He does not appear to have a vocation upon which he can rely upon release.


