## Re Possible Mental Condition of Subject RAY

On 5/2/68, CHARLES LUNDHOLM, Bureau of Viostatistics, California State Department of Mental Health, Sacramento, California, advised they had no record of subject RAY or his aliases ever having been a patient in any of the mental institutions back to 1922. This would also include committed alcoholics.

LUNDHOLM advised that this would not be a complete record for the State of Galifornia inasmuch as about 2/3 of the counties in California have their own Inpatient, Cutpatient and Rehabilitation Centers where one could go on his own volition. The names of all these individuals are not submitted to the state. We said it was possible that counties could have central indices but did not know whether the indices would be by name or file number.
