



His occupation was listed as welder and his residence listed as 311 May Street, Montgomery, Alabama.

Mr. AVERITT advised that he has no personal recollection of this individual giving blood and is not in a position to say whether or not the individual actually showed Navy identification at the time he gave blood.

On May 3, 1968, Mr. M. L. GRIFFIN, Vice President, Radcliff Materials Company, Mobile, Alabama, advised that JAMES E. RAY, 311 May Street, Montgomery, Alabama, had worked for his company in Mobile as a welder from February 26, 1968, through March 11, 1968, voluntarily quiting. This man was a white male, born at Clanton, Alabama. He has Social Security Number RAY claimed to have served in the U. S. Navy from 1943 to 1946.

GRIFFIN advised that this individual had left this employment and had a small amount of money due him in wages which money was sent to him in care of his home address in Montgomery, Alabama. The check sent to this address was not returned to Radcliff Materials Company:

On May 3, 1968, GRIFFIN's company received a letter from this individual using a return address of Sheriff's Office, Wheatland, Wyoming, asking that money due him from his employment, be sent to him in care of the Sheriff's Office at Wheatland, Wyoming.

She furnished the following information: The address 166 5th Avenue, New York City, is a mailing operation utilized by Modern Photo Bookstore a division of Amphoto. That company's office is actually located at 915 Broadway, New York City. Mrs. KOENIG searched her files and located a coupon which coupon requested that book number 633 be. sent to ERIC S. GALT, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama. The coupon indicated that a money order in the amount of \$8.95 was enclosed. Mrs. KOENIG stated that this coupon was undoubtedly clipped from an issue of Modern Photography because this is the only magazine in which Modern Photo Bookstore advertises. She presumed that the coupon was clipped from the September, 1967, issue of the magazine which probably would have been on the news-stands in late August, 1967. Mrs. KOENIG located a letter which is set forth in its entirety as follows: "9-26-67 "Dear Sir: "I recently order a Book from your store titled FOCAL ENCYLOPEDIA-No. 633 for \$8.95. "If you have not allready mailed the book (PLEASE DO NOT MAIL IT) I am moving and will shortly send you my correct address Thanks SEARCHED_ SERIALIZED_ New York, New York SA JOHN F. SHANLEY/tp _Date dictated_ This document cantains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency;

Book number 633 distributed by Modern Photo Bookstore is entitled "The Focal Enclyclopedia of Photography." The book jacket for this book described it as a one volume photographic library. It consists of 2,000 entries written by 197 experts from 23 countries and covers every aspect of photography, photographic science, industrial photography, cinematography, portraiture, equipment, history and current activities of workers in foreign countries.

Mrs. KOENIG stated that during a routine review of the company's files the coupon and accompanying letter of ERIC S. GALT was revealed. The company did not believe that it had shipped the requested book to GALT prior to receiving his letter. A follow up the company wrote to GALT by letter dated April 29, 1968, asking him what action he wished the company to take regarding the \$8.95. This letter is set for in full as follows:

Mrs. KOENIG stated that Amphoto has received no further communications from ERIC S. GALT since his letter of September 26, 1967. She stated that any further communications from GALT would be referred immediately to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Mr. USIAN furnished telephonic authority to an employee, Mrs. RUTH KOENIG, to furnish the original of any documents from his files that might be requested by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).


