

For the information of the Laboratory, Mr. BROTON advised that the Thermo Seal tape, Lot #517, was made in November or December, 1967, but their quality control does not show the number of warp yarns in the cloth. He further noted that the face of the tape has a whitish cast because it is coated with a starch-type material. He stated the true color appearing on the garments recovered in instant case would more closely resemble the color of the underside of the tape.

It is noted that Lot #517 was found to be the lot number of tape in the possession of Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California, as furnished to Albany Office by Los Angeles Office by telephone call on 4/11/68.

The Laboratory is requested to compare the enclosed specimen of tape with the tape on the garments recovered immediately after the slaying at Memphis for identification of the tape.

The sets of type are furnished to the Laboratory for assistance in examinations being on the laundry marks.

One latent fingerprint of value was developed on label attached to a piece of wrapping paper, Q124. One latent fingerprint and five latent palm prints were developed on submitted box, Q126. No latent impressions of value were developed on piece of brown wrapping paper, Q125, shipping slip or three-inch piece of paper ripped from shipping slip, and a piece of cellophane tape.

RE ATLANTA LETTER APRIL FIFTEEN CONCERNING ITEMS FROM ROOMS IN ATLANTA.

NUMEROUS HAIRS FOUND ON TWO BED SHEETS FROM ROOM. HAIRS INCLUDE BROWN TO BLACK HEAD, PUBIC AND LIMB HAIRS OF CAUCASIAN ORIGIN AND A DARK BROWN HEAD HAIR OF NEGROID ORIGIN. THE RANGE OF CHARACTERISTICS EXHIBITED BY THE CAUCASIAN HAIRS SUGGESTS THEY ARE FROM MORE THAN ONE PERSON. SOME OF THE HAIRS ARE DETERIORATED AND DIRTY SIMILAR TO HAIRS FROM FLOOR DEBRIS. A FEW OF THE HAIRS ARE SIMILAR IN SOME MICROSCOPIC CHARACTERISTICS TO HAIRS FROM THE MUSTANG AND MEMPHIS SCENE BUT DO NOT MATCH IN ALL MICROSCOPIC CHARACTERISTICS. THE POSSIBILITY THESE HAIRS ORIGINATED FROM SAME SOURCE AS HAIRS FROM THE MUSTANG AND MEMPHIS SCENE COULD NOT BE ELIMINATED.

THE LETTERS "P" OVER "E," FOLLOWED BY A SPACE, THEN THE LETTERS "TTED," AND THE WORD "PUNCH" OR "BUNCH" WERE FAINTLY INSCRIBED ON THE SINGLE PAGE OF NEWS-PAPER SUBMITTED.

NO ROAD MAPS OF ATLANTA AREA PREVIOUSLY RECEIVED. THIS MAP AND OTHER ARTICLES RECEIVED WERE EXAMINED FOR INDENTED IMPRESSIONS AND OTHER MARKINGS BUT NOTHING OF SIGNIFICANCE NOTED.

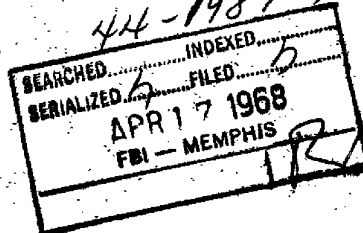

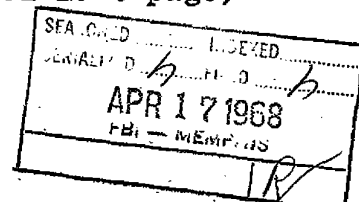

It was concluded that ANITA LOUISE KATZWINKEL, K26, did not prepare the questioned handwriting "Ginger & Anita Katzwinkel" appearing on Q118, the portion of a tissue box, previously submitted. Because of unexplained variations and insufficient comparable material, a definite conclusion could not be reached whether KATZWINKEL prepared any of the remaining questioned handwriting on Q118. It was concluded that the FLIKEID signatures appearing on the bottom of K27, were prepared by THOMAS M. FLIKEID, FBI#534039D.

Because of insufficient significant comparable handwriting and unexplained variations, a definite conclusion could not be reached whether the questioned Lowmyer signature on the gun invoice previously submitted or the writings attributable to Eric S. Galt, previously submitted, were prepared by the writer of K27. Some handwriting differences were noted in the handwriting attributable to Galt when compared with K27, however, these characteristics are not sufficiently strong to definitely eliminate FLIKEID as a possible writer of the Galt material.

The K28 and K29 maps are not identical with two maps, Q18 and Q20, previously submitted and recovered from the blue bag in Memphis.

Q139, Q140, K27 through K29 are temporarily retained. Appropriate photographs of the writing appearing on K27 have been made.

One 8 inch head hair of Caucasian origin was found inside the Q139 left shoe. This has been dyed black. No similar hairs were found in or on items previously submitted in this case. No other hairs or debris was found in Q139 or Q140.
