Mr. JAECH pointed out that Rocky Mt. does not have insurance agencies in Texas, but some possible holder who has moved to Texas, or was passing through that state, might have called Seattle on some type of claim.

Mr. JAECH pointed out that there are only two persons in the Claims Division of Rocky Mt. who handle calls on claims. Mr. JAECH personally contacted these two persons and neither could recall receiving such a telephone call from Texas, but they pointed out such a call from Houston, Texas might have been received in December and they cannot now remember such a call.

They said that if the name of the caller were known, if it pertained to a claim, the call could be verified through their Claims Index Records.

According to PANKLA DOMENSTRIN, she has an uncle, a brother of her mother, named NORMERT VILLAFLOR, who formerly resided at Grange Street, Vidor, Texas. Hiss DOMER-STRIN recalls the family received a telephone call from NORMERT VILLAFIOR during the middle of December, 1967.

The present thereshouts of MUNICIPY VILLATION are unknown to Hiss DOMERSTRIN and her family since he has departed Vicor, Texas.

She further stated that her brothers, JOHE and RICHARD CARRILLO, ages 17 and 19, and her sister, NARIA, age 21, also reside at her parents' residence.

on 5/7/58, EVA CARRILLO advised she is unable to speak English and consequently was interviewed with the masistance of her daughter, SOLERAN CONZALEZ. Hrs. CARRILLO stated that she generally is the only individual in the homeshold during daylight hours and that she is unable to recall having received a telephone call from Texas in December, 1967. She stated, however, that it is possible that she did receive such telephone call and is unable to

recall it. She further advised that if the caller had spoke in English, she would have been unable to correspond and would have consequently quickly terminated the conversation and probably not recall it. Also, that if the caller had disled a wrong number, she probably would not recall this.

All the members of the CAMMILLO household consisted of JOSE, RICHARD, MARIA, and Mr. MATTHEW CARRILLO were interviewed and all advised that they have no resolvention of receiving a telephone call from Texas in December, 1967. When questioned resolving friends, relatives, and associates possibly residing in the state of Texas, they all advised they have relatives residing in El Paso, but that since they are on an extremely low sconomic level, they do not believe they would have attempted to telephone them.

MARTA CARRILLO, upon interview, stated that during the latter part of Recember, 1967, including Recember 17, 1967, her brother, ANTONIO CARRILLO, a Catholic priess from Maxico, was visiting with her and her family and that the possibility exists that he reserved the telephone call. She stated he is currently residing at Casa Parroquial, Tenajapa, Chiapas, Maxico.

An additional copy of this mirtel in being furnished the Berman for transmittal to Legat, Marico, so that Mather, AMTONIO CAMPILLO, presently residing at Case Parroquial, Yemsjapa, Chiapas, Mexico can be contacted to determine if he received a telephone call during the middle of December from the state of Texas while visiting his sister at Valley Centre, California.

The following investigation was conducted by SAR. GERARD ROBINSON:

On May 7, 1968, Mr. WALTER FRIDAY, Administrator, Choctaw General Hospital, Butler, Alabama, advised that telephone number 459-2461 has been assigned to that hospital for several years. He said that he has no knowledge concerning any telephone calls received at this hospital from Orange, Texas, or any out-of-state calls in December 1967, as such calls received by the hospital are not centrally recorded. He said that he could not recall any patient at the hospital who might logically have received any telephone calls from Orange, Texas. FRIDAY advised that he checked with several clerical employees of the hospital who served at varying times on telephone duty but none could recall any long distance calls from the State of Texas.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT D. CAMPBELL:

On May 8, 1968, Mr. CHARLES B. STEPHENS, Semmes Nursery, Semmes, Alabama, advised that he has had telephone number 342-1435 for a long time and that during the middle of December 1967, he had received a call at the Nursery from a customer by the name of PATFIELD, who called from Houston, Texas. On May 9, 1968, Mrs. FRANCES PATRONAS, Apartment 140, Bel Air Apartments, advised that she recalls receiving no telephone calls at Captain Pete's Restaurant and Lounge from the State of Texas during December 1967 and could furnish no information concerning any such calls.

MARGARET GRIFFIN and MARY WEATHERELL, waitresses at Captain Pete's Restaurant and Lounge during December 1967, were located through Mrs. PATRONAS. MARGARET GRIFFIN could recall no telephone calls from the State of Texas. MARY WEATHERELL advised she recalls a man who had been a customer at this Lounge on a number of occasions, name not recalled, and she seems to recall that this customer had received a phone call one night from a girl friend from Texas. The call she has recollection of was definitely a personal call from a girl friend. She said that this man is a traveling salesman who had been coming through Mobile on a number of occasions in the past and had frequently stopped in at this Lounge.

These persons were shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY but could not identify any of the photographs as being similar to anyone seen by them in the past.

Mrs. BOBBY W. (PEGGY) BURROW advised that she has subscribed to telephone number 293-4542 since around September, 1967. Her husband is currently serving in the United States Armed Forces in Vietnam. She employs a babysitter by the name of Mrs. HORACE WISER.

Mrs. WISER's daughter, who is also named PEGGY, is married to JIM RALPH POMEROY, who is from Houston, Texas. Mrs. BURROW recalls that in December of 1967, she could not remember the exact dates, three or four telephone calls were made to her home by JIM RALPH POMEROY who was trying to reach his wife, PEGGY, who was living with Mrs. BURROW at that time. These are the only long-distance telephone calls she has ever received from Houston, Texas.

POMEROY's father and mother live in Houston, but she does not know their name or address and neither does Mrs. WISER know their name or address. Mrs. BURROW pointed out that there is a considerable amount of domestic difficulty between POMEROY and his wife and that POMEROY often leaves home and is gone for weeks or even months without anyone knowing where he is. She said that Mrs. WISER recently told her that POMEROY is currently in jail somewhere in Illinois, but she does not know where it is.
